Information Paper: Census of Population and Housing: Link Between First and Second Editions of Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO), 1996 (\$10.00)

Describes the link between the First and Second Editions of ASCO and provides a set of basic statistical tables for comparative analysis. It also explains the link file, developed by the ABS to facilitate the comparision of occupation data, which shows the quantitative relationship between the two editions. Occupation data from the 1996 Census of Population and Housing were coded to both editions of ASCO.

Census of Population and Housing: Link File Between First and Second Editions of Australian Standard Classifications of Occupations (ASCO), 1996 (\$110.00)

A link file has been developed by the ABS to facilitate the comparison of occupation data between the First and Second Editions of ASCO. Occupation data from the 1996 Census of Population and Housing were coded to both editions of ASCO. This formed the basis of the link file which shows the quantitative relationship between the two editions.

The file, available on floppy disk, is accompanied by an information paper which also includes a number of basic tables illustrating the relationship between First and Second Edition at the broadest (Major Group) level of the classification. Also included is a hierarchical listing of ASCO First Edition and Second Edition occupations.

Census of Population and Housing: Population Growth and Distribution, Australia, 1996 (\$28.00)

Provides information about the demographic changes that have taken place in Australia, focussing on the 1991 and 1996 Census years.

Includes information on the growth, location and mobility of the population at national, State and regional levels. A major emphasis is on the characteristics and volume of interstate and intrastate movements between 1991 and 1996. Final estimates at the Statistical Local Area level for all of Australia are also provided.

4189.0

National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey: Law and Justice Issues, 1994 (\$19.50)

The result of a joint project between the ABS and the Australian Institute of Crime. It analyses the law and justice data from the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey conducted in 1994 and presents its findings in both commentary and tabular presentation.

Contains statistics showing the level of private health insurance in Australia, and selected characteristics of those with and without cover.

4702.0 Occasional Paper: Overweight and Obesity, Indigenous Australians, 1994 (\$19.50)

Reports on the distribution of relative weight among Indigenous Australian children and adults and compares them to what has been found in other populations. The socioeconomic, demographic and cultural factors associated with body mass index and with non-measurement in adults is also examined.

Detailed presentation of national accounts for the last 12 years. Tables are grouped under the following headings: summary tables and productivity, consolidated accounts, income components of gross domestic product, corporate trading enterprises, financial enterprises, households, general government, overseas, capital. Includes estimates at current and average 1989-90 prices.

8147.0 Use of the Internet by Householders, Australia, February 1998 (\$16.50)

> Presents a range of statistics on the use of the Internet by Australian householders. Some of the statistics presented include: number of persons accessing the Internet by place of access; Internet activities (including purchasing activities done over the Internet). Data are cross-classified by a range of demographic variables such as age, sex, ethnicity, occupation and labour force status.

9201.6 Transport Patterns and Preferences, Tasmania, October 1997 (\$16.00)

> Provides summary details of transport arrangements that people in Tasmania use for their usual household shopping trip, child's journey to school/educational institution, and journey to work or place of education. Information includes mode of transport usually used, why public transport used (or not used), and approximate time the journey usually takes. There is also information on people who were unable to attend an activity because of transport concerns.
