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This statement contains preliminary results of the 1971 Census of Population and Housing. It shows, for each Commonwealth electoral division as determined at the 1968 re-distribution, the population enumerated in 1971 together with comparative figures from the 1966 Census. The figures have been compiled during the taking of the Census by field personnel and are subject to amendment when final figures become available.

At the 1966 Census, in conformity with Section 127 of the Constitution, Aborigines were not included in the published figures of the population. In 1967 the Constitution was altered to remove this provision, and the 1971 Census population figures therefore include Aborigines. In order to provide comparability between the two Censuses, the 1966 populations in this statement have been amended to include Aborigines.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Populations of electoral divisions shown in this publication have been determined by allocating each Census collector's district to an electoral division. The boundaries of electoral divisions, however, occasionally do not coincide with the boundaries of collector's districts. In such cases, the total population of the collector's district has been attributed to the electoral division in which the greater part of the collector's district is situated. Thus in the compilation of the figures in this publication, a small degree of approximation has sometimes been necessary.

In using the figures in this publication, it is important to remember the "de facto" nature of the Census. The total population shown for each division is therefore the number of persons in that division on the night of 30 June, including temporary visitors to Australia and persons enumerated at other than their usual place of residence.
