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
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

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PREFACE

This publication presents a range of social and housing statistics produced from the 1996 Census of Population and Housing for suburbs in the region that generally comprises the Perth metropolitan area and urban areas in the City of Mandurah, and for postal areas in Western Australia. Together with population counts, it includes tables of selected census data which describe the characteristics of people living in each area and their housing arrangements.

Refer to the glossary for a more detailed description of the geographic areas.

The data presented in the publication relates to where people were enumerated on census night. They should not be confused with the official Estimated Resident Population (ERP) figures, which are based on census counts by place of usual residence (UR). ERP figures are derived by including in the census UR counts the following:

- estimates of Australians overseas;
- an adjustment for estimated underenumeration; and
- adjustments for births, deaths and migration, between 30 June and 6 August 1996.

ERP figures are only calculated for statistical local areas and higher geographic levels. They are not calculated for suburbs and postal areas.

Census data presented in this publication represents only a selection of the full range of statistics that could be derived from the census. For further information about other census or ABS data refer to Appendix B – Census Products and Services or the *Directory of Census Statistics* (2910.0). Concepts and definitions used in this publication are explained in the Glossary and more detailed information is available in the *Census Dictionary* (2901.0). A full list of ABS products and services can be found in the *ABS Catalogue of Publications and Products* (1101.0).

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

SUBURBS OVERVIEW

[The 'Perth/Mandurah region' is a term used in this overview to describe the region that is the sum of all the defined suburbs. See Table 1 for the set of defined suburbs]

POPULATION

In the 1996 Census of Population and Housing, suburb populations varied widely - from more than 22,000 people to less than 100 people.

The 10 suburbs with the highest populations were Thornlie (22,292 people), Armadale (20,535), Morley (18,621), Ballajura (18,198), Dianella (18,189), Willetton (18,118), Gosnells (16,907), Duncraig (16,224), Kingsley (14,244) and Leeming (12,421).

SEX

Overall there were slightly more females than males counted in the Perth/Mandurah region, comprising 51.0% females and 49.0% males. At the suburb level, there were some significant differences in the proportions of females to males.

Suburbs with a notably higher proportion of females than males were Peppermint Grove (57.1% females), Bentley (56.9%), Menora (56.2%), Joondanna (56.1%), Claremont (56.0%) and Palmyra (55.2%).

Suburbs with a greater proportion of males were Casuarina (72.5% males), Wooroloo (61.8%), East Perth (59.0%) and Perth City (57.7%).

AGE

For the Perth/Mandurah region, the median age was 33 years and the proportion of people aged 65 years and over was 11.0%.

Some of the suburbs with the highest median ages were in the City of Rockingham, for example, East Rockingham (56 years), Peron (54) and Shoalwater (50); and in the City of Mandurah, for example, Dudley Park (45), Mandurah (45) and Dawesville (41). In Perth, the longest established suburbs generally had high median ages , with the highest recorded at Kings Park and Menora (47 each), Carmel (43) and Myaree and Woodlands (42 each).

To some extent, suburbs with high median ages and high proportions of people aged 65 years and over also reflect the presence of nursing homes/hostels and retirement villages in those particular areas.

The lowest median ages were primarily located in the newer suburbs, for example, Beeliar (median age of 24 years), Stratton (25), Leda (25) and Clarkson (25); or where there were residential colleges attached to tertiary or other educational institutions, for example, Murdoch (23) and Crawley (25).

INDIGENOUS ORIGIN

In the Perth/Mandurah region, 1.4% of the population reported being of Indigenous origin.

Suburbs with highest percentages of people who reported being of Indigenous origin were Cullacabardie (98.0%), Koongamia (11.1%), Casuarina (10.1%), Midvale (8.2%) Beeliar (7.8%), Medina (7.6%), Lockridge (7.4%) and Coolbellup (7.1%).

INDIGENOUS ORIGIN *continued*

Suburbs with the highest numbers of people who reported being of Indigenous origin were Armadale (686), Balga(576), Gosnells (415) and Girrawheen (413).

OVERSEAS-BORN

Nearly one-third (32.0%) of the people counted in Perth/Mandurah region were born overseas. Of these, more than half (51.3%) were from the United Kingdom, Ireland and New Zealand.

The highest proportions of overseas-born people were reported in the suburbs of Highgate (53.0%), Iluka (51.9%), Murdoch (49.9%), Karawara (49.5%) and Crawley (48.2%).

Of the 30 suburbs with 25% or more of their populations from UK, Ireland and New Zealand, 18 suburbs were in the City of Wanneroo and 6 were in the City of Rockingham.

LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH

In the Perth/Mandurah region, 12.5% of the people aged 5 years and over spoke a language other than English at home.

Of these, the highest proportions were in the suburbs of Stirling (44.6%), Karawara (39.0%), Balcatta (38.7%), Murdoch (37.9%), Beaconsfield (37.6%), Highgate and Mirrabooka (37.4% each).

INCOME

The median personal weekly income for the Perth/Mandurah region was \$304.

Suburbs with the the highest median personal weekly income were Ellen Brook (\$500), Atwell (\$478), City Beach (\$451), Dalkeith (\$450), Rottnest Island (\$448), Peppermint Grove (\$446) and Cottesloe (\$444).

Suburbs with the lowest median personal weekly income were Cullacabardie (\$174), East Rockingham (\$186), Karawara (\$191), Mandurah (\$192), Wooroloo and Two Rocks (\$193 each).

TENURE TYPE

In the Perth/Mandurah region 37.0% of occupied private dwellings were reported as being fully owned.

There were 45 suburbs (15.1%) in the Perth/Mandurah region where the proportion of full ownership was fifty percent or more. The suburbs with the highest level of full home ownership were East Rockingham (74.4%), Dalkeith (63.0%), City Beach (62.3%), Stirling (61.7%) and Canning Mills (61.0%).

In 47 suburbs (15.8%) in the Perth/Mandurah region, the proportion of full ownership was 25% or less. Suburbs with the lowest levels of full ownership were Stratton (9.1%), Clarkson (9.3%), Karawara (10.6%) and Merriwa (11.3%).

The proportion of occupied private dwellings being purchased in the Perth/Mandurah region was 31.9%.

TENURE TYPE *continued*

Suburbs which had the highest proportions of dwellings being purchased included Atwell (76.3%), Tamala Park (75.6%), Leda (73.3%) and Secret Harbour (72.2%). More than half the suburbs had less than 35% of dwellings being purchased. The suburbs with the lowest proportion of dwellings being purchased were East Rockingham (4.8%), East Perth (5.4%), Crawley (5.7%), Northbridge (6.2%) and West Perth (8.2%).

In the Perth/Mandurah region, 26.8% of occupied private dwellings were being rented.

Suburbs which reported having the highest percentage of dwellings being rented included Karawara (72.0%), East Perth (71.3%), West Perth (65.0%), Crawley (64.9%) and Kings Park (60.2%).

Suburbs with a low percentage of dwellings being rented included Iluka (3.7%), Parklands (5.8%), Tamala Park and Oakford (6.7% each) and Casuarina (7.2%).

HOUSING LOAN REPAYMENTS

The median monthly housing loan repayment for the Perth/Mandurah region was \$758.

Thirty three (11.3%) suburbs had median housing loan repayments of \$1000 or more, while 27 (9.1%) had repayments of \$600 or less. Suburbs with high median monthly housing loan repayments included Peppermint Grove (\$2348), Northbridge (\$1800), Dalkeith (\$1733), Mt Claremont and Nedlands (\$1300 each) and City Beach (\$1250).

Suburbs with the lowest median monthly housing repayments were East Rockingham (\$286), Wangara (\$374), Medina (\$434), Coolbellup (\$459) and Balga (\$477).

RENT PAYMENTS

In the Perth/Mandurah region the median weekly rent payment was \$120.

Dalkeith and Northbridge, which were amongst the suburbs which had the highest median housing loan repayment, also had some of the highest median weekly rent payments (\$250 and \$195 respectively). Other suburbs with high median weekly rent payments were City Beach and Winthrop (\$220 each), Iluka (\$190) and Murdoch (\$185).

Suburbs with the lowest rent payments were Bentley (\$55), Calista (\$56), Coolbellup (\$58) and Lockridge (\$59).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SCOPE AND COVERAGE

- 1** The 1996 Census of Population and Housing was held on 6 August 1996. The first census was held in 1911 and since 1961 a census has been taken every five years, a frequency which is specified in the *Census and Statistics Act 1905*. The objective of the census is to measure accurately the number and key characteristics of people in Australia on census night, and the dwellings in which they live.
- 2** The census aims to count every person who spent census night in Australia. This includes Australian residents in Antarctica and people in the territories of Jervis Bay, Cocos (Keeling) Islands and Christmas Island. The other Australian External Territories, Norfolk Island and minor islands such as Heard and McDonald Islands, are outside the scope of the Australian Census. The only group of people who spend census night in Australia but are excluded from the census are foreign diplomats and their families.
- 3** The census includes people on vessels in or between Australian ports, on board long distance trains, buses or aircraft and on oil or gas rigs off the Australian coast. People entering Australia before midnight on census night are counted while people leaving an Australian port for an overseas destination before midnight on census night are not. Visitors to Australia are included regardless of how long they have been in the country or how long they plan to stay. However, for people who will be in Australia less than six months only basic demographic data were obtained. The census includes people camping out and the homeless.
- 4** All private dwellings, except diplomatic dwellings, are included in the census, whether occupied or unoccupied. Caravans in caravan parks, manufactured homes in manufactured home estates and self-care units in accommodation for the retired or aged are counted only if occupied. Occupied non-private dwellings, such as hospitals, prisons, hotels, etc. are also included.
- 5** Details about the 1996 Census content, collection operations, confidentiality and privacy protection, processing and evaluation activities are contained in *1996 Census of Population and Housing: Nature and Content of the Census* (2008.0).

ABS POPULATION ESTIMATES

- 6** This publication contains population counts based on where people were counted on census night, which may not have been where they usually live. They should not be confused with the official ABS population estimates called Estimated Resident Population (ERP), which are based on census counts by place of usual residence (UR). ERP figures are derived by including in the census UR counts the following:
 - estimates of Australians overseas;
 - an adjustment for estimated underenumeration; and
 - adjustments for births, deaths and migration, between 30 June and 6 August 1996.
- 7** The adjusted census count is then updated quarterly using demographic statistics. These are statistics on births, deaths, and overseas and internal migration.
- 8** ERP figures are only calculated for statistical local areas and higher geographic levels. They are not calculated for suburbs and postal areas.
- 9** ERP population estimates are published in *Regional Population Growth - 1996 Census Edition* (3218.0), *Australian Demographic Statistics* (3101.0), produced quarterly, and in *Estimated Resident Population by Age and Sex* (3201.0) produced annually.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

10 The ABS also provides projections (based on different assumptions as to future fertility, mortality and migration) of the resident population of Australia, States and Territories. These projections are published biennially in *Projections of the Populations of Australia, States and Territories* (3222.0).

DATA LIMITATIONS

11 Census data are subject to a number of inaccuracies resulting from errors by respondents or mistakes in collection or processing of the data. Whilst some of these are corrected by careful processing procedures, some still remain. The effect of the remaining errors is generally slight, although it may be more important for small groups in the population. The main kinds of error to keep in mind are:

- Partial non-response: In some cases where an answer was not provided to a question an answer was imputed (often from other information on the form). In other cases a 'not stated' code was allocated.
- Processing error: While such errors can occur in any processing system, quality management is used to continuously improve the quality of processed data, and to identify and correct data of unacceptable quality.
- Random adjustment: Table cells containing small values are randomly adjusted to avoid releasing information about particular individuals, families, or households. The effect of random adjustment is statistically insignificant.
- Respondent error: Because processing procedures cannot detect or repair all errors made by people in completing the form, some remain in final data.
- Undercount: Although the census aims to count each person, there are some people who are missed and others are counted more than once. The data in this publication are not adjusted for the net undercount.

12 Further information on data quality will be provided progressively in *Census Update* and in *1996 Census Data Quality Working Papers*.

OVERSEAS VISITORS

13 Data for overseas visitors (who will be in Australia for less than 6 months) are restricted to age, sex and marital status. In this publication overseas visitors contribute only to the male, female and total person counts.

CALCULATIONS OF PROPORTIONS

14 When calculating the proportions of the population with a particular characteristic 'Not stated' responses are included in the denominator. For example, the proportion of people born overseas is calculated by dividing the number of persons who stated that they were born overseas by the total population (including those who did not report their Birthplace) and expressing the result as a percentage.

CALCULATION OF MEDIANs

15 A median is a measure of central tendency, it is a mid value which divides a population distribution into two, with half the observations falling below it and half above it. Unlike averages (means) medians are not skewed by extreme observations.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

16 There are a number of issues to be aware of:

- The categories 'Not stated', 'Overseas visitor', and 'Not applicable' are not included in the calculation of medians.
- If a median falls into a category that has a text only label then the median will be set to 0. For this publication this is only relevant to the calculation of median personal income, as the income classification includes the categories 'Nil income' and 'Negative income'.
- If the median is calculated on a classification containing ranges and a range is open-ended and the median falls within that category, the median is set to the number in the label. For example, in the calculation of median personal income, if the median falls in the last range '\$1,500 or more', \$1,500 will be allocated as the median.

MAPS OF SUBURBS AND POSTAL AREAS

17 Maps of the 'census defined' suburbs and postal areas have not been included in this publication.

18 Boundaries of gazetted suburbs and official Australia Post postcodes for the Perth/Mandurah region can be referenced in most commercial street directories.

19 If a specific map(s) displaying suburbs and/or postal areas is required, ABS Client Services Section can provide a customised mapping service.

GLOSSARY

General descriptions of terms and concepts used in this publication are provided below. Detailed definitions of classifications and concepts are available in the *1996 Census Dictionary (2901.0)*.

Geographic areas The tables in this publication are at Suburb and Postal Area levels. Suburbs have been defined for the region that generally comprises the Perth metropolitan area and urban areas in the City of Mandurah. In precise terms, the region comprises only the set of defined suburbs listed in Table 1. Postal Areas have been defined for the whole of Western Australia.

A Suburb is formed by aggregating whole collection districts (CDs) that fall within physical boundaries of a gazetted suburb on a best fit basis. The series excludes some gazetted suburbs which, because of the application of the 'best fit' principle, do not get a CD allocated to them.

A Postal Area is formed by aggregating whole collection districts (CDs) that fall within physical boundaries of an Australia Post postcode on a best fit basis. The series excludes non-mappable Australia Post postcodes e.g. post office box postcodes, some postcodes which are delivery routes which are also covered by other postcodes (a situation which often occurs in rural areas) and some postcodes which, because of the application of the 'best fit' principle, do not get a CD allocated to them.

Dwelling A dwelling is a building or structure in which people live. This can be a building, such as a house; part of a building, such as a flat; or it could be a caravan or tent, humpy or park bench. Houses under construction, derelict houses, vacant caravans and tents, or converted garages, are not counted in the census.

There are private and non-private dwellings.

A private dwelling is normally a house, flat, part of a house, or even a room; but can also be a house attached to, or rooms above, shops or offices; an occupied caravan or unit in a caravan park or craft in a marina; occupied dwelling in a Manufactured Home Estate; occupied self-care unit in Accommodation for the Retired or Aged; a houseboat; or tent if it is standing on its own block of land. An occupied caravan situated on a residential allotment is also classed as a private dwelling. Private dwellings can be either occupied or unoccupied.

Non-private dwellings are those dwellings not included above, that provide a communal or transitory type of accommodation. These dwellings include hotels, motels, guest houses, prisons, religious and charitable institutions, defence establishments, hospitals and other communal dwellings. Only occupied non-private dwellings were included in the census.

Income People aged 15 years or more were asked to state their usual gross weekly income, which is the income before tax, superannuation, health insurance, or other deductions are made. Gross income includes family allowance, family allowance supplement, pensions, unemployment benefits, student allowances, maintenance (child support), superannuation, wages, salary, overtime, dividends, rents received, interest received, business or farm income (less operation expenses) and worker's compensation received.

GLOSSARY *continued*

Indigenous origin A person is defined to be of Indigenous origin if he or she identified themselves as being of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander origin.

Overseas-born Overseas-born people are those who stated that they were born in a country other than Australia, those born at sea, and those whose responses were classed as 'Inadequately described' or 'Not elsewhere classified'.

This Profile is available for all standard census geographic areas, Commonwealth and State Electoral Divisions (CED, SED), Postal Areas, and Suburbs, for the States/Territories and Australia.

Time Series Community Profile will contain 21 tables of variables from the Basic Community Profile comparing data from the 1986, 1991 and 1996 Censuses where the classifications are comparable.

Usual Residents Profile will contain 25 tables based on the usual residents of SLAs. This is the only Community Profile based on place of usual residence.

Expanded Community Profile will contain 38 tables available for SLAs and larger areas, comprising more detailed versions of some of the basic profile tables, plus new tables.

Working Population Profile will contain 17 tables of labour force and related characteristics of people who work and are counted in SLAs within the journey to work (JTW) study areas - usually capital cities. JTW areas are non-contiguous urban areas within each state and are therefore available only at the SLA level.

Indigenous Profile The Summary Indigenous Profile will contain selected characteristics of Indigenous people in 2 tables which are available at the Indigenous Location level. The Detailed Indigenous Profile provides 26 tables available for Indigenous Areas, ATSIC Regions, States and Territories.

CDATA96

CDATA96 is a CD-ROM product which provides a large volume of tabulated census data, digital boundaries and base map data. It includes software capable of producing tables, maps and graphs of the data.


