## SUMMARY OF COMMONWEALTH DEMOGRAPHY.

### PREFACE.

The present Bulletin contains in a condensed form various tables of the Population and Vital Statistics of the Commonwealth and the individual States for the period of the seven years, 1901 to 1907, which has elapsed since the inauguration of Federation.

Since the publication on 11th June, 1907, of the preceding summary of Commonwealth Demography (Population and Vital Statistics Bulletin No. 2), the method of estimating the effect produced on the population of the several States by inter-state and oversea migration has received special consideration, with the result that in preparing the estimates of population for 1907 it has been considered necessary to depart from the method previously in force for estimating migration. Under that method, which was decided upon by the Statistical Conference of 1903 and approved by the Conference of 1906, provision was made for allowances for unrecorded departures by sea from the several States, based on the number of recorded departures by sea. In the case of Tasmania this allowance was 12½ per cent., for Queensland 10 per cent., for New South Wales and Victoria 9 per cent., for South Australia proper 7 per cent., and for Western Australia and the Northern Territory 5 per cent.

A further allowance for unrecorded arrivals and departures by land was agreed upon, such allowance to consist in each case of 10 per cent. of the recorded arrivals and departures by rail.

On combining the migration statistics of the several States for 1907 to obtain the net results for the Commonwealth as a whole, it was found that, notwithstanding the considerable allowance above referred to, which had been made for unrecorded departures, the results bore unmistakable evidence of being still in excess of the true state of affairs. By this method the net immigration to the Commonwealth for 1907 worked out at 15,907, whilst for the same period the recorded gain shewn by the returns of the several States from places outside the Commonwealth totalled only 10,897, a difference by no means negligible, and one which could not be passed over.

In addition to the State returns of arrivals and departures, returns during 1907 were furnished to the Commonwealth Bureau monthly by the Customs authorities in the various ports, shewing the number of passengers brought or taken away by vessels which have made that port the first port of arrival in, or the last port of departure from, the Commonwealth, but not distinguishing the States to which such passengers were bound or to which they had departed. These shewed for 1907 a net gain to the Commonwealth population by immigration amounting to 12,514.

If, during 1907, no allowance had been made in the State returns for unrecorded arrivals and departures, the discrepancy would have been still more marked, as the net immigration would have been shewn as no less than 37,420. This fact, viz., that the combination of the unadjusted State returns furnishes a result about three times (2·99) that afforded by taking account only of oversea arrivals into and departures from the Commonwealth, shews the grave unreliability of the method now abandoned.

An examination of the *data* served to shew that the main source of error was to be found in the records of inter-state migration by sea. Thus, from the returns of inter-state migration furnished by the several States, it appears that the aggregate number of inter-state arrivals by sea in the various States during 1907 amounted to 210,779, while the aggregate number of recorded inter-state departures by sea, which should be practically identical with the number of arrivals, was only 184,787. The number of inter-state departures by sea, which went unrecorded during 1907 must, therefore, represent approximately not less than 14 per cent. of the number recorded, and the agreed allowances were thus shewn to be unsatisfactory.

Another anomaly resulting from the old system occurs in connexion with the sex distribution of the 1907 migration, which, under that system, worked out at a gain of 18,769 males and a loss of 2,862 females. Such a result is evidently incorrect. The old system was therefore inherently defective in two ways, viz., (i) it overstated the net gain to the Commonwealth, and (ii) it misrepresented the relative migration of the sexes.

After a very careful consideration of the various aspects of the question it was decided to abandon the old method of computing migration statistics and to substitute for it the following, viz.:—

- (a) Collect from the several States records of the arrivals therein by sea from other States of the Commonwealth.
- (b) Treat such records of arrivals as furnishing records of departures from the States from which the arrivals have been derived.
- (c) For purposes of computing population ignore records of Inter-State departures by sea.
- (d) Obtain through the Railway Departments of the several States records of passengers passing through border stations.
- (e) Estimate, as before, migration by road as 10 per cent. of migration by rail.
- (f) Proportionately adjust oversea migration recorded by the several States, so that the aggregate arrivals and departures shall be respectively identical with the results obtained by the Commonwealth returns furnished at first port of arrival and last of departure.

The population has now been computed for 1907 by the method above outlined, and this method will furnish migration results possessing a much greater degree of accuracy than has yet been attained.

The application of the new method for 1907 has the effect of giving New South Wales, Victoria, and Tasmania somewhat higher, and Queensland, South Australia, and Western Australia somewhat lower, populations than would be obtained under the old system. The amounts by which the populations of the three first-mentioned States were increased through the change of method were New South Wales 1,957, Victoria 2,587, and Tasmania 2,383; while the amounts by which the populations of the three remaining States were diminished were Queensland 4,701, South Australia 3,342, and Western Australia 2,277.

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
