30 June 1993**



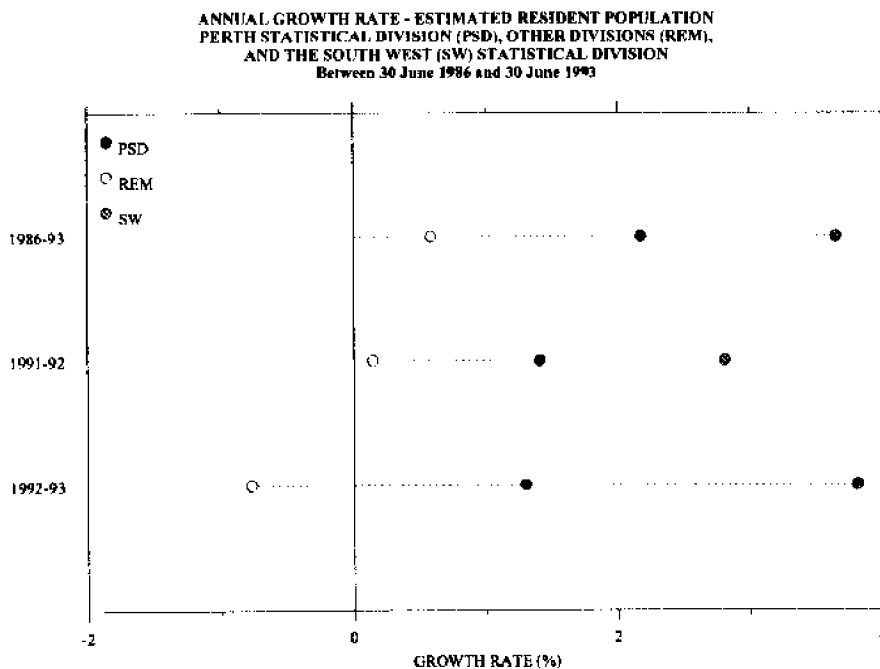

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MAIN FEATURES

- The Estimated Resident Population (ERP) of Western Australia at 30 June 1993 was 1,676,341. This is an increase of 18,991 persons, or 1.15 percent from 30 June 1992.
- During this time, the proportions of the State population usually residing in the Perth Statistical Division increased to 72.8 percent and decreased in the Rest of the State to 27.2 percent.
- Between 30 June 1986 and 30 June 1993 the South West Statistical Division had a faster average annual growth rate than either the Perth Statistical Division or the other Divisions combined (3.65% compared with 2.18% and 0.59% respectively). At 30 June 1993, the South West Statistical Division had grown 3.81 percent in twelve months. This is compared with a growth of 1.30 percent for the Perth Statistical Division and a decline of 0.76 percent for the remaining Divisions over the same period.



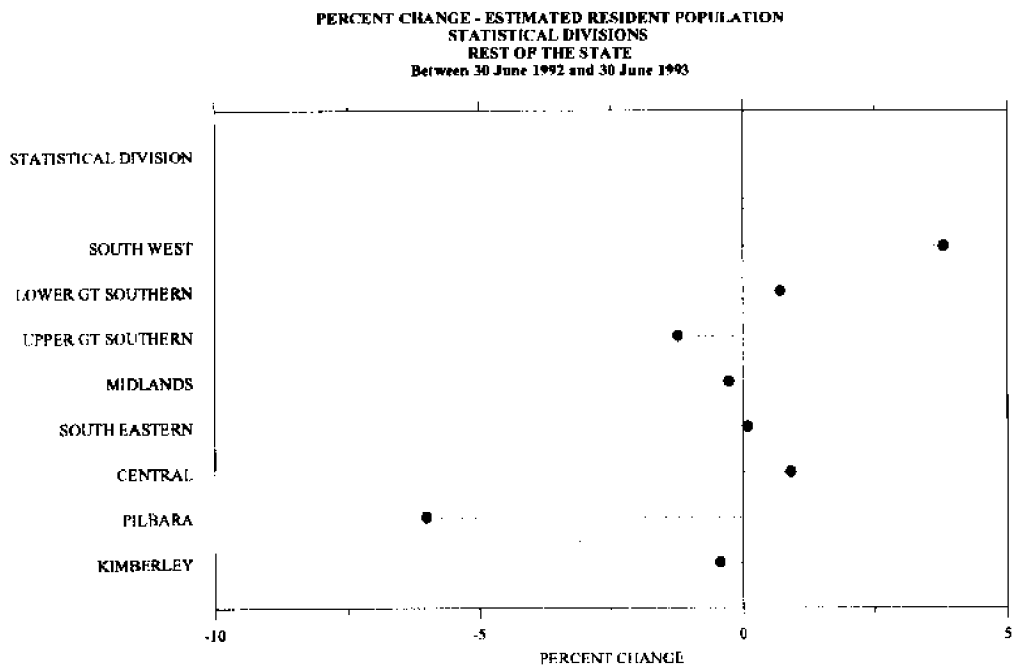
PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

- Between 30 June 1992 and 30 June 1993, the ERP of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 15,642 to 1,221,181, an increase of 1.30 percent.
- Within the Perth Statistical Division, Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) showing strong growth are in the outer metropolitan areas of Rockingham (C) (8.68%), Swan (S) (7.00%), Wanneroo (C) (5.13%), Serpentine-Jarrahdale (S) (4.26%) and Kwinana (T) (3.78%).

- Twenty-two of the thirty-three SLAs in the Perth Statistical Division showed a decline in ERP between 30 June 1992 and 30 June 1993. All the SLAs in the Central Metropolitan Statistical Subdivision showed a decline.

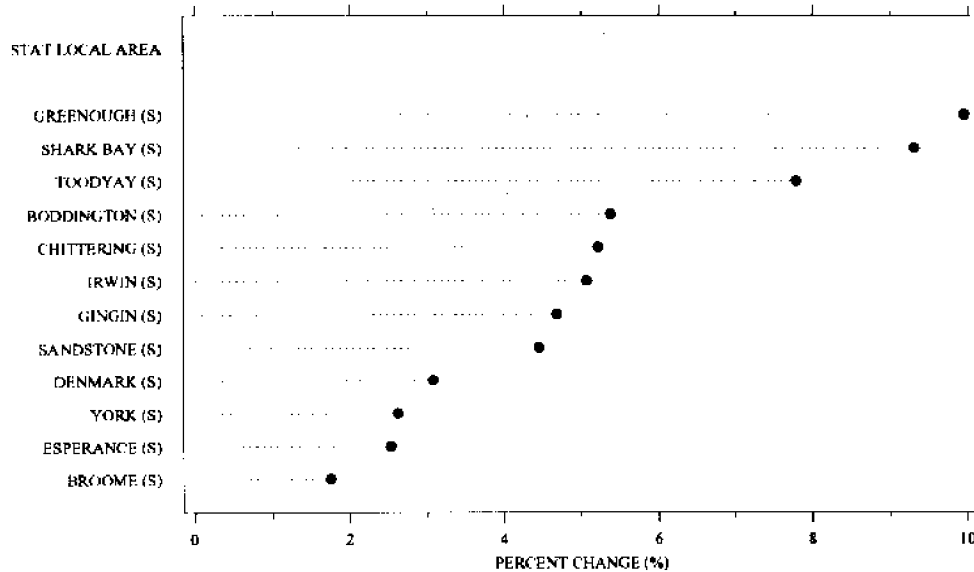
REST OF THE STATE

- Between 30 June 1992 and 30 June 1993, the ERP of the Rest of the State increased by 3,349 or 0.74 per cent to 455,160.



- Major declines occurred in the Pilbara Statistical Division which showed a 6 percent decrease in ERP since 30 June 1992.
- The South West Statistical Division is the fastest growing Division in Western Australia with twelve of the fifteen SLAs showing growth. Significantly growing SLAs are Mandurah (C) (8.83%), Augusta-Margaret River (S) (6.41%), Harvey (S) (5.10%), Busselton (S) (4.41%), Dardanup (S) (4.39%), and Capel (S) (4.25%)

 Between 30 June 1992 and 30 June 1993



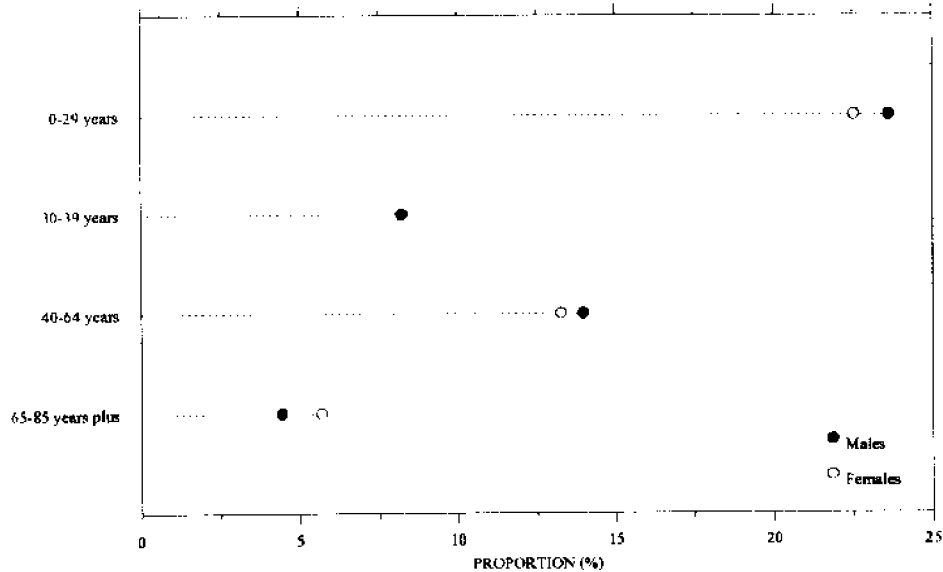
- The remaining Statistical Divisions are mainly in decline, although growth is occurring in SLAs surrounding major urban centres, and in SLAs where tourism is important. ERP in mining areas fluctuate as mines are opened or closed.

AGE AND SEX OF ERP IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

At 30 June 1993...

- There were 842,444 (50.25%) males and 833,897 (49.75%) females in Western Australia.
- Males, as a proportion of the State population, outnumber females in age groups 0-29 years (396,230 or 23.64% compared with 377,946 or 22.55% females), and 40-64 years (234,105 or 13.97% compared with 222,558 or 13.28% females).
- The number of males and females in the age group 30-39 years are almost equal (137,929 or 8.23% males compared with 138,233 or 8.25% females).
- Females outnumber males in age groups 65 years and over (95,160 or 5.68% females compared with 74,180 or 4.43% males).

Since 30 June 1986...

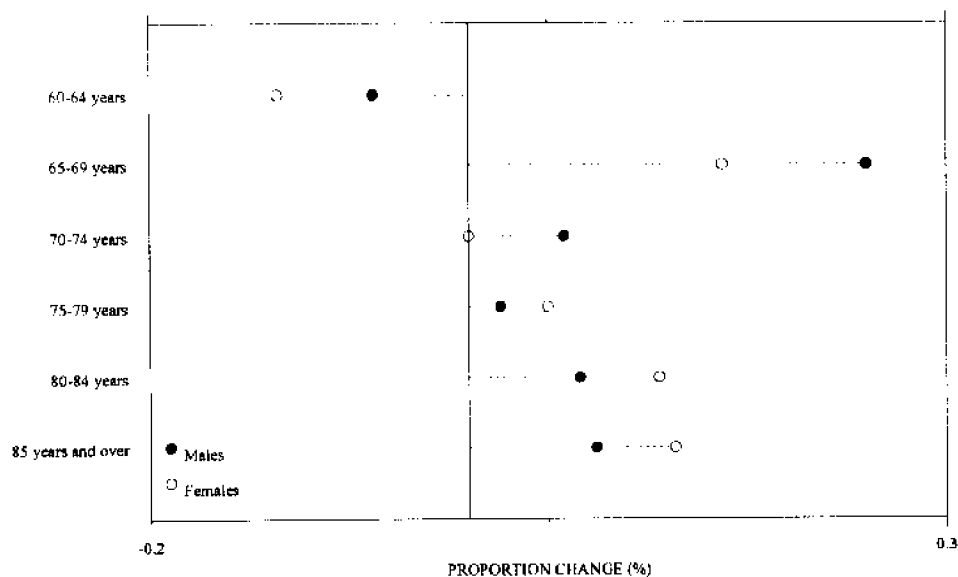
- There has been a decrease of 3.67 percentage points in the proportion of the ERP aged 0-29 years (from 49.85% to 46.18%). Although males outnumber females in this age group, males as a proportion have declined more than females (1.88% compared with 1.79% for females).
- The age group 30-39 has decreased slightly as a proportion of the ERP from 16.66 percent to 16.47 percent. Males as a proportion of this age group have declined by 0.23 percentage points whereas females have increased slightly by 0.04 percentage points.
- All age groups over 40 years have increased as a proportion of the ERP. In the age group 40-64 years, females have increased more than males (1.51 compared with 1.43 percentage points males), but in age group 65-85 years and over males have increased slightly more than females (0.47 compared with 0.45 percentage points females).

Seniors in Western Australia

Since 30 June 1986...

- The age group 60-64 years has decreased 0.19 percentage points as a proportion of the ERP from 3.90 percent to 3.71 percent. Females as a proportion of ERP in this age group have declined twice that of males (0.12 compared with 0.06 percentage points males).

Between 30 June 1986 and 30 June 1993

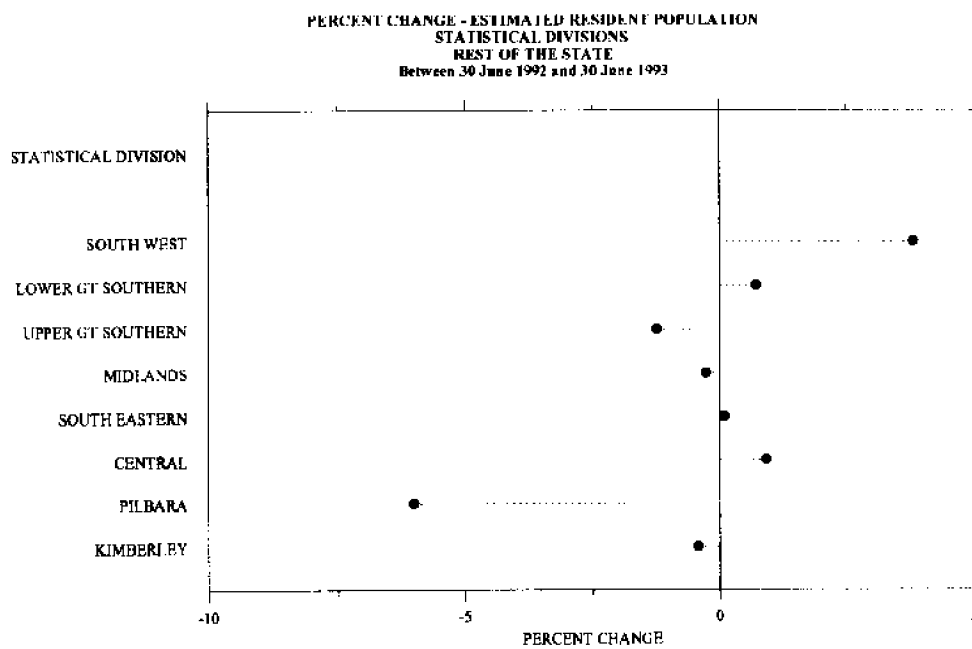


- The remaining age groups have increased as a proportion of the ERP by 0.41 percentage points in age group 65-69 (from 2.99% to 3.40%), 0.05 percentage points in age group 70-74 (from 2.62% to 2.67%), 0.07 percentage points in age group 75-79 (from 1.83% to 1.90%), 0.19 percentage points in age group 80-84 years (from 1.07% to 1.26%), and 0.20 percentage points in age group 85 years and over (from 0.68% to 0.88%).
- Males have increased as a proportion of the age group 65-69 years (0.25 compared with 0.16 percentage points females). In the 70-74 year age group, the proportion of males has increased 0.06 percentage points but there has been no change in the proportion of females in this age group.
- In the age groups 80 years and over, the proportion of the female ERP has grown more than male: 0.12 compared with 0.06 percentage points males in age group 80-84 years; and 0.12 compared with 0.08 percentage points males in age group 85 years and over.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1993. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1992 are included for comparison.

2. The estimated resident populations (ERPs) contained in this publication are the official Australian population estimates. They are derived from the 1986 and 1991 Censuses of Population and Housing.

Methodology

3. The ERP is the official population estimates series compiled according to place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper *Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (Catalogue No. 3216.0) issued on 29 March 1982.

4. The ERP at 30 June 1991 for each SLA is based on usual residence counts, adjusted for census under-enumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

5. For intercensal years, the ERP for each SLA at 30 June is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1986 and 1991). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1991), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

6. Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information provided by each local government authority on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

Area statistics

7. ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, Edition 2.2* (Catalogue No. 1216.0). Figures previously published for LGAs, Statistical Subdivisions and Divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle and Stirling are comprised of a number of SLAs. However estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

8. SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations used in this publication are as they existed at 30 June 1993.

Boundary and name changes

9. There were no significant boundary changes affecting population between 1 July 1992 and 30 June 1993.

Revisions

10. The estimates for 30 June 1991 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1992 and 30 June 1993 are subject to revision when data from the 1996 Census of Population and Housing become available.

Reliability

11. Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

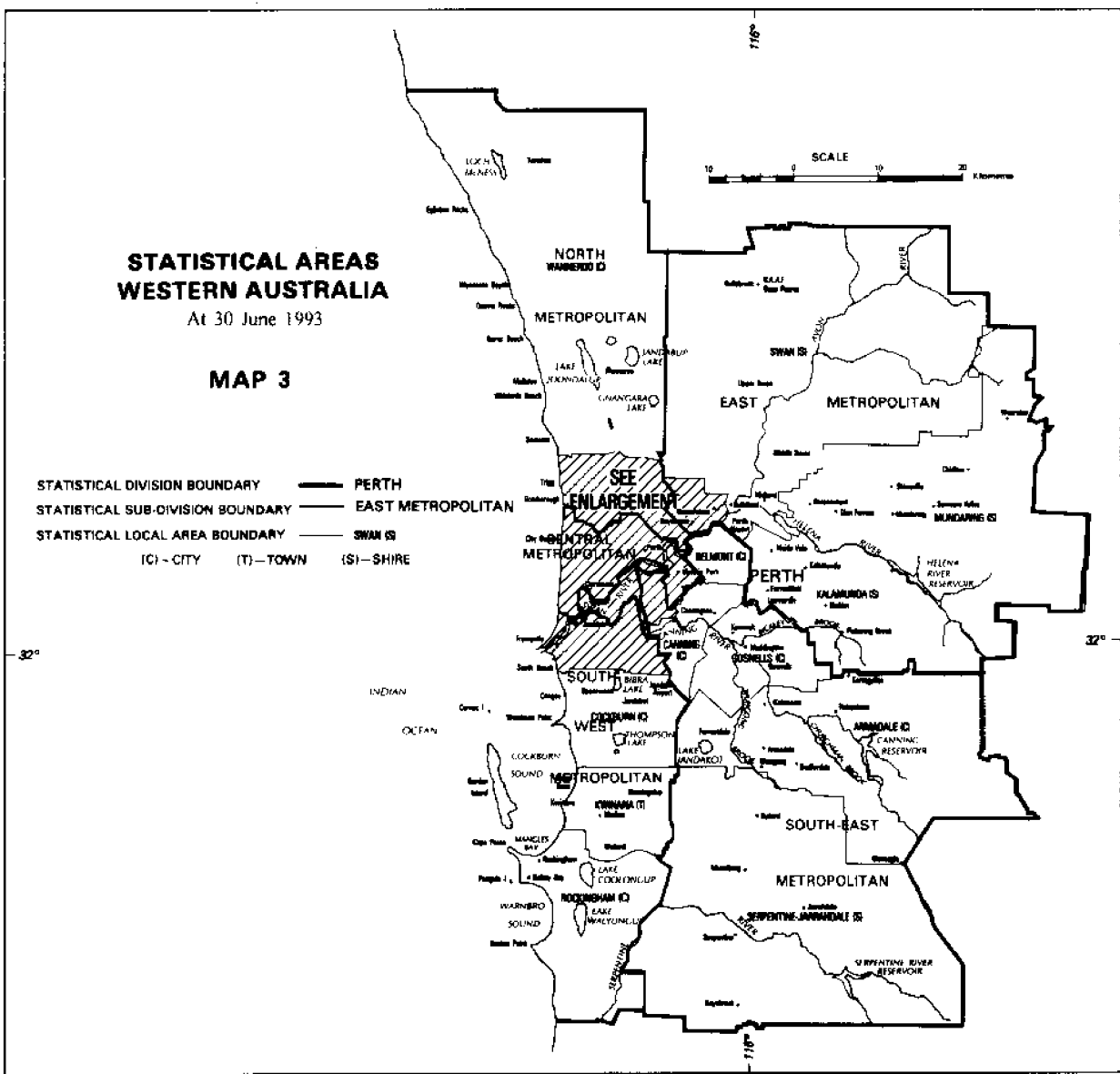

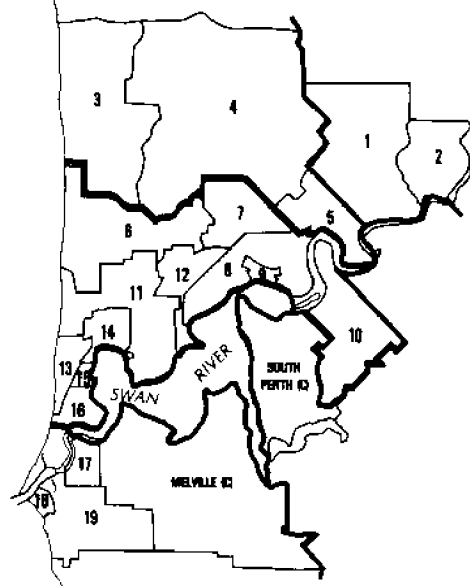
