

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## MAIN FEATURES

- The Estimated Resident Population (ERP) of Western Australia at 30 June 1994 was 1,701,064. This is an increase of 24,723 persons, 1.47% from 30 June 1993.
- The proportion of the State population residing in the Perth Statistical Division was 72.8% at 30 June 1994. This figure has fluctuated by less than one per cent since 1986 and prior to this had risen slowly from 68.2% in 1971.
- The South West Statistical Division has the second highest ERP after the Perth Statistical Division. Since 30 June 1991 the South West Statistical Division has experienced a higher overall growth rate (9.17%) than either the Perth Statistical Division (4.21%) or the other Divisions combined (0.52%). Over the past twelve months the South West Statistical Division has grown by 2.29% compared with 1.45% in the Perth Statistical Division and 1.17% in the remaining Divisions.

1991-92 to 1993-94**




### PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

- Between 30 June 1993 and 30 June 1994 the ERP of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 17,661 persons to 1,238,842 an increase of 1.45%.
- Within the Perth Statistical Division, the Statistical Local Area (SLA) of Perth (C) - Inner has shown a rapid increase in ERP of 12.40% in the year ending 30 June 1994. This is in contrast to a decline of 1.76% the previous year. The increase in ERP for Fremantle (C) - Inner was 4.00% in the current year, following a 1.90% increase in the year ending 30 June 1993.
- Other Statistical Local Areas where strong growth occurred in the year ending 30 June 1994 were Rockingham (C) (4.63%), Swan (C) (4.18%), Serpentine-Jarrahdale (S) (4.02%), and Wanneroo (C) (3.27%). All of these SLAs grew at a slower rate than in the previous year.

- Wanneroo (C) is the most populous Local Government Area (LGA) in the Perth Statistical Division (PSD) with 197,040 residents. Stirling (C), with 179,063 persons, is the only other LGA in the PSD with a population in excess of 100,000.
- Peppermint Grove with 1,546 persons is the least populated of all LGAs in the PSD.


**ANNUAL GROWTH RATE - ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

#### REST OF THE STATE

- Between 30 June 1993 and 30 June 1994, the ERP of the Rest of the State increased by 7,062, 1.55%, to 462,222.
- The ERP of the South Eastern Statistical Division increased by 2.85% to 53,040, making it the fastest growing Division in the State since 30 June 1993. This was mainly due to growth in the SLAs of Leonora (S) (6.35%), Kalgoorlie/Boulder (C) (3.81%) and Coolgardie (S) (3.16%).
- The Pilbara Statistical Division recorded a decrease in ERP of 0.26% to 30 June 1994, compared with a decline of 6.00% in the previous year.
- Greenough (S) with a 6.56% increase in ERP during 1993-94 again had the largest growth rate of any SLA outside the Perth Statistical Division.
- The South West Statistical Division continued to grow steadily with fourteen of the sixteen SLAs showing increased population. Significant growth occurred in the SLAs of Nannup (S) (5.10%), Busselton (S) (4.85%), Mandurah (C) (4.31%) and Dardanup (S) (3.59%).

**AGE AND SEX OF ERP IN  
WESTERN AUSTRALIA**

- There were 854,636 males and 846,428 females in Western Australia as at 30 June 1994.
- Males outnumber females in all Statistical Divisions except Perth where there are 11,676 more females.
- The Statistical Divisions which have the greatest percentage of males are the mining areas of Pilbara (55.36%) and South Eastern (54.09%).
- Females outnumber males in all age groups over 64 years of age and make up 64.81% of the population aged 80 years and over.
- The median age of Western Australia's population has gradually increased from 30.09 years in 1986 to 32.59 years as at 30 June 1994. The median age of males was 32.07 years and females, 33.10 years.

**Seniors**

- Seniors (60 years and over) total 236,409 persons, 13.90 % of the total ERP of Western Australia, as at 30 June 1994. This proportion has increased by 0.81 percentage points since 1986.

- The Statistical Divisions of South West and Lower Great Southern have the highest proportion of seniors with 16.87% and 16.08%, respectively.


- Seniors make up only 2.53% of the Pilbara Statistical Division and 5.34% of the Kimberley Statistical Division.

**Young People**

- The number of persons in all age groups below 40 has decreased as a proportion of the total population since 1986.
- 38.07% of the ERP in Western Australia is aged under 25 years. This has decreased from 41.13% in 1986.

- Kimberley, Pilbara and South Eastern are the Statistical Divisions with the highest percentage of young people (under 25 years), with 47.15%, 42.25% and 42.17%, respectively. The 0-4 year age group in these Divisions is well above the State average (7.36%) with 11.48%, 10.05% and 9.86%, respectively.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### INTRODUCTION

1 This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1994. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1993 are included for comparison.

### METHODOLOGY

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

3 The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1991 for each SLA is based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

4 For intercensal years, the estimated resident population at 30 June 1993 and 30 June 1994 for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1986 and 1991). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1991), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

5 Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

### AREA STATISTICS

6 ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, Edition 2.3* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle and Stirling are comprised of a number of SLAs. However estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

7 SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1994.

### BOUNDARY AND NAME CHANGES

#### Statistical Local Areas

8 From 1 July 1993 the Shire of Wiluna became two separate local government areas. One area retained the name Wiluna and the other was named the Shire of Ngaanyatjarraku. The estimated resident population for each of the two local government areas has been calculated for the years 1991 to 1993.

#### Statistical Divisions and Subdivision

9 The SLA of Boddington has been moved from the Subdivision of Hotham, Statistical Division of Upper Great Southern to the Subdivision of Dale in the South West Statistical Division.

### REVISIONS

10 The estimates for 30 June 1991 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1993 and 1994 are preliminary and subject to revision.




