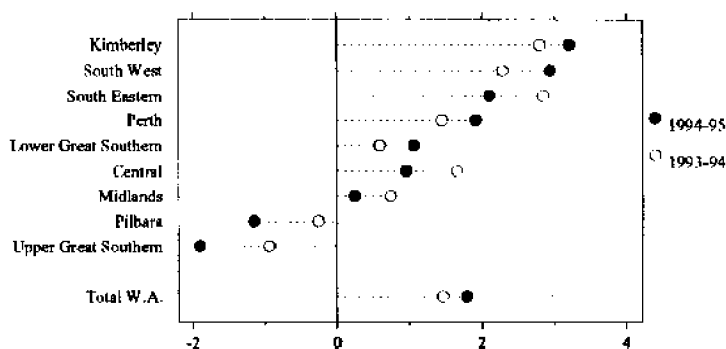

MAIN FEATURES

SUMMARY

- At 30 June 1995 the Estimated Resident Population of Western Australia was 1,731,723 persons, an increase of 30,659 or 1.80% from 30 June 1994.
- The population of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 23,727 persons (1.92%). The other main area of growth was the South West Statistical Division which increased by 4,676 persons (2.94%).
- Growth was recorded in the South Eastern, Kimberley, Lower Great Southern, Central and Midlands Statistical Divisions, but the populations declined in the Upper Great Southern and Pilbara Statistical Divisions.

1993-94 and 1994-95

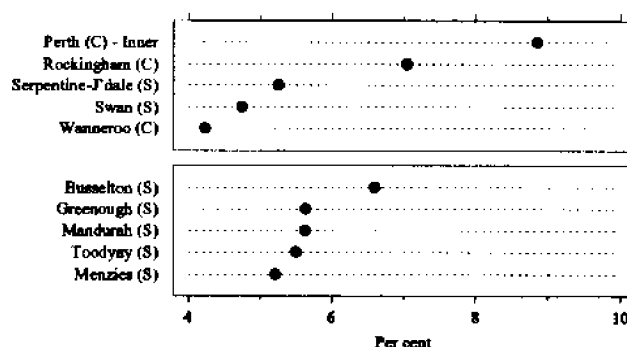


- The Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) with the greatest population growth were Wanneroo (8,341 persons), Rockingham (3,788), Swan (3,055), Cockburn (2,152) and Mandurah (2,008). These five SLAs contributed 63% of the State's population increase.
- The SLAs with the greatest percentage increase in the population were Perth - Inner (8.85%), Rockingham (7.05%), Busselton (6.60%), Greenough (5.64%), Mandurah (5.63%), Toodyay (5.50%) and Serpentine-Jarrahdale (5.26%).
- Decreases were recorded in many of the SLAs in the Wheatbelt and mining/pastoral areas.

PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

- The increase of 23,727 persons in the population of the Perth Statistical Division represents 77.39% of the total increase of the State.
- The proportion of the State's population resident in the Perth Statistical Division increased marginally from 72.83% at 30 June 1994 to 72.91% at 30 June 1995.
- The SLAs in the Perth Statistical Division with the greatest population increases were Wanneroo (8,341 persons), Rockingham (3,788), Swan (3,055), Cockburn (2,152) and Gosnells (1,277). These five SLAs contributed over 78% of the population increase in the Perth Statistical Division.

- Small decreases were recorded in the SLAs of Cottesloe, Bayswater, East Fremantle and Melville.

REST OF THE STATE

- There were population increases in 13 out of 16 SLAs in the South West Statistical Division. Growth rates were highest in Busselton (6.60%), Mandurah (5.63%) and Bunbury and surrounding areas (2.23%). Growth rates in the Shires of Harvey, Dardanup and Capel averaged 3.35% compared with only 1.16% in the City of Bunbury.
- Populations generally decreased in the remainder of the agricultural area, but with some growth in the Albany region, the Geraldton region (mainly the Shire of Greenough which increased by 5.64%) and in several of the SLAs surrounding the Perth Statistical Division (notably the Shires of Toodyay, Gingin, Northam, York and Chittering).
- There was little population growth in the mining/pastoral areas. The main exceptions were Kalgoorlie/Boulder, which increased by 3.43%, and the SLAs of the Kimberley Statistical Division, which increased by an average of 3.21%.
- There was also some population growth in several of the coastal and tourist centres, such as the SLAs of Carnarvon, Exmouth, Shark Bay and Esperance.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- INTRODUCTION**
- 1** This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia at 30 June 1995. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1994 are included for comparison.
- METHODOLOGY**
- 2** The estimated resident population is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.
- 3** The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1991 for each SLA is based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.
- 4** For intercensal years, the estimated resident population at 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1986 and 1991). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1991), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.
- 5** Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.
- AREA STATISTICS**
- 6** ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, Edition 2.3* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle and Stirling are comprised of a number of SLAs. However estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.
- 7** SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1995.
- BOUNDARY AND NAME CHANGES**
- 8** From 1 July 1994 the City of Perth became four separate local government areas. One area retained the name Perth and the others were named the Towns of Cambridge, Victoria Park and Vincent. The estimated resident population for each of the four local government areas has been calculated for the years 1991 to 1994.
- REVISIONS**
- 9** The estimates for 30 June 1991 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 are preliminary and subject to revision.
- RELIABILITY**
- 10** Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

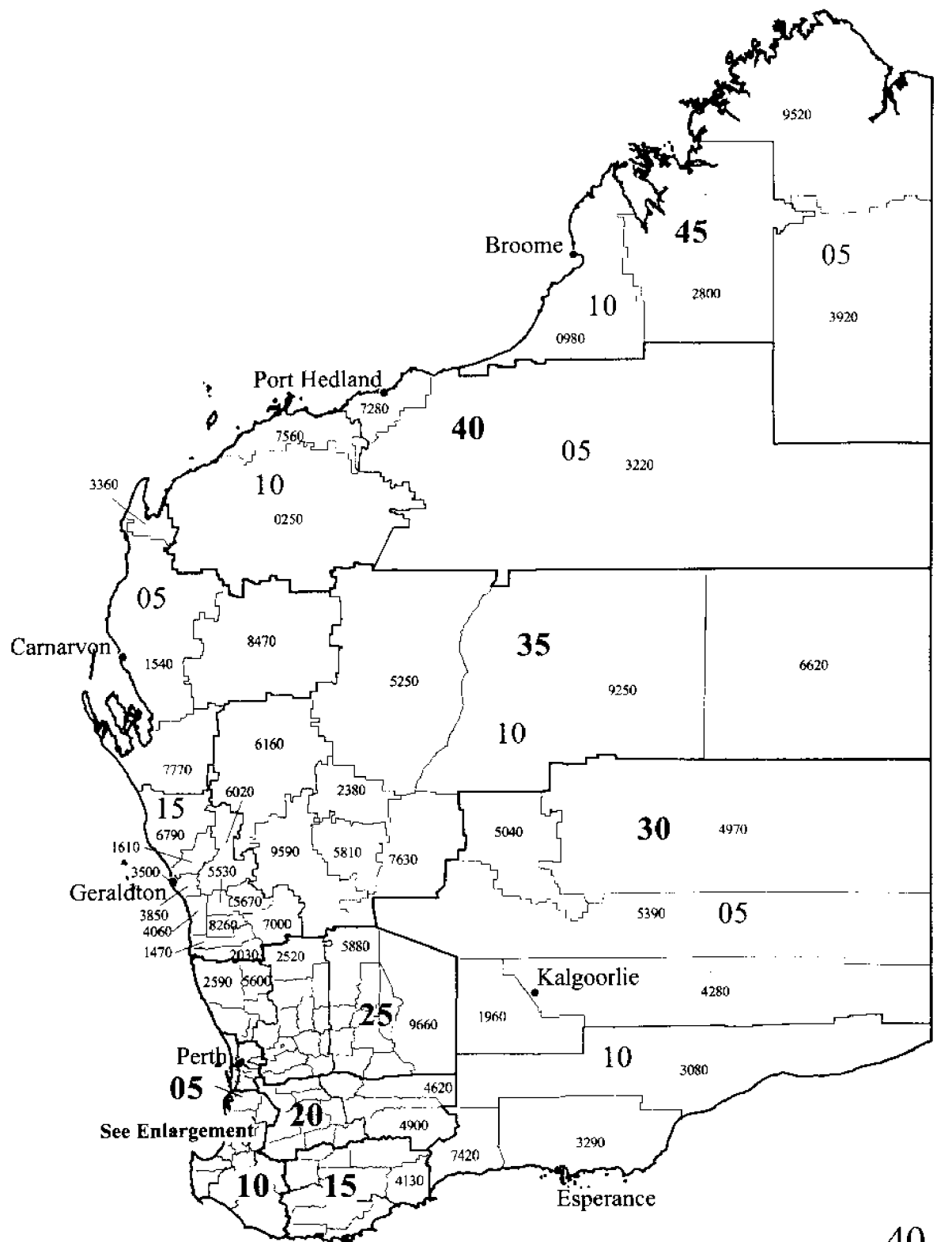

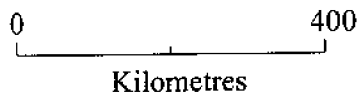

Statistical Divisions and Statistical Local Areas



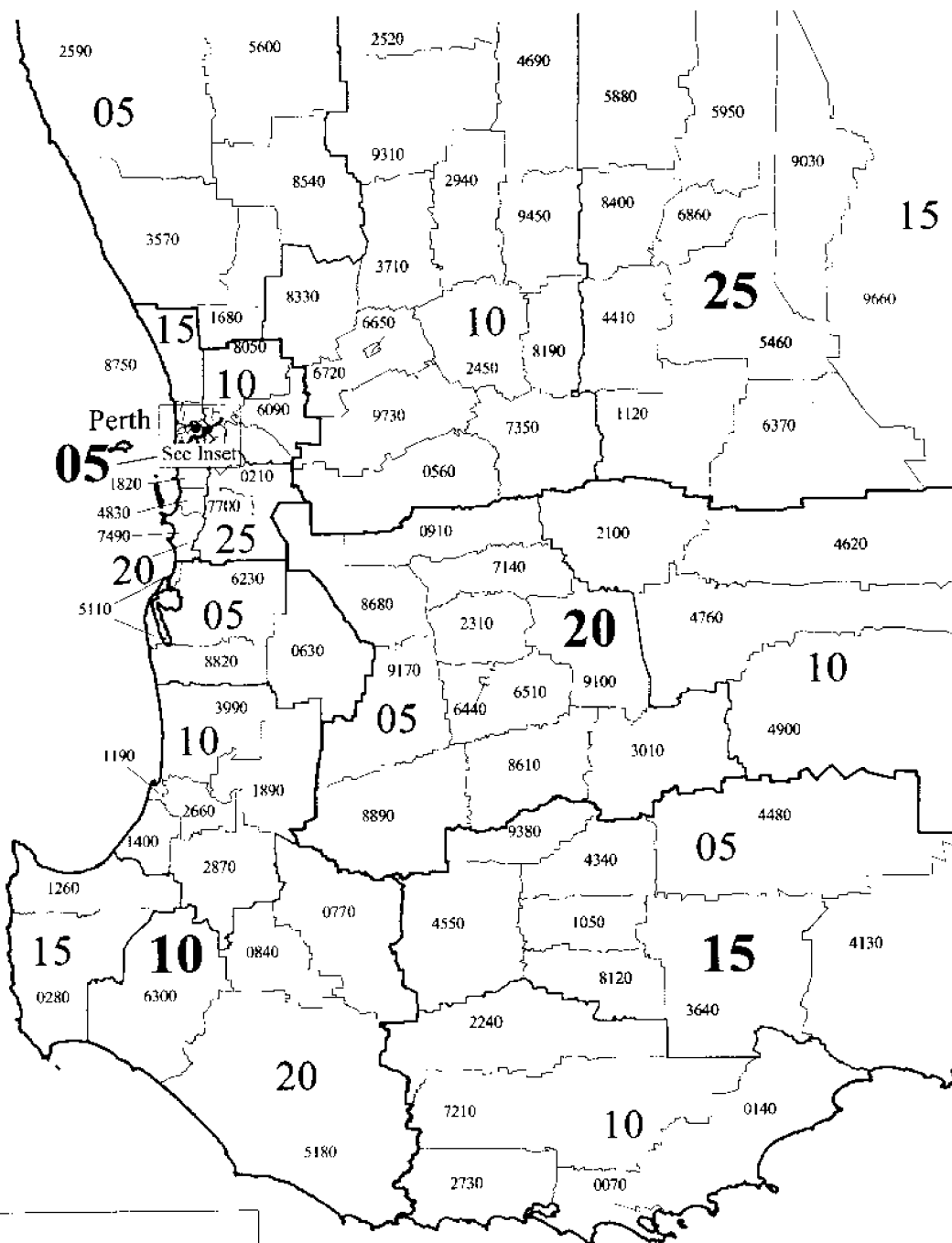

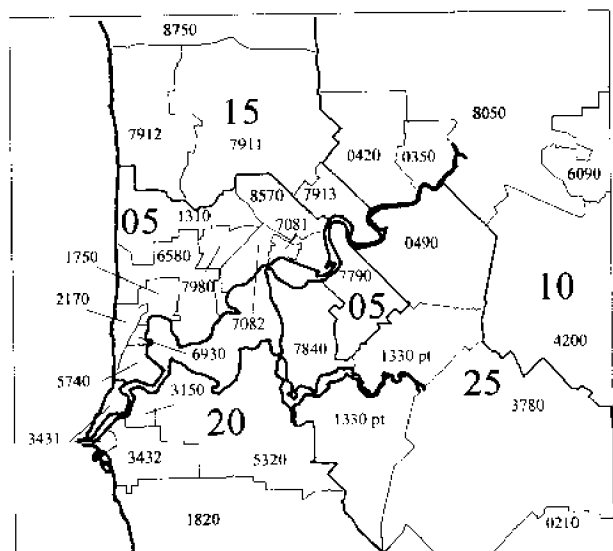


Western Australia - Enlargement
