## EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Introduction

This publication contains a selection of final population and vital statistics, superseding preliminary data published in Population and Vital Statistics (Preliminary) (3211.0). The quarterly issue of this bulletin was interrupted, no issue being published since August 1976 when the bulletin covering September and December quarters 1975 appeared. It is now intended to resume publication on a quarterly basis. Annual publications containing corresponding statistics in greater detail are listed below under the heading related publications.
2. The interruption in the quarterly issue of this bulletin was due to the need to revise population estimates in the light of results of the Census of Population and Housing of 30 June 1976. It was necessary to examine the implication of the census results on continuity of demographic statistics in general, to review the methods used for making quarterly estimates, and to make substantial changes to population estimates back to 1971.
3. Final population estimates from June 1971 to June 1977 were published for the first time in the preliminary bulletin (3211.0) issued on 11 November 1977, and are repeated here. Crude rates (births, deaths, etc. per 1,000 of mean population) for each year from 1971 onwards have been recalculated and the revised rates are shown in this bulletin for the first time. Population estimates have not been revised for dates before 1971. However, advice can be given if a continuous series of estimates is required from before 1971.

## Population estimates

4. The population statistics for 30 June 1976 are the Census results adjusted for underenumeration. (The methods of estimating the level of underenumeration are outlined in a Census Bulletin, Population of States and Territories adjusted for Underenumeration (Ref. No. 2.02.10, issued in March 1977). Estimates for later dates are derived from these by the addition of natural increase and net migration gain (which now excludes overseas movement for less than a year). For the States and Territories account is also taken of estimated interstate movements involving a change of residence. Thus, both for Australia and for the States and Territories, the population movement from 30 June 1976 measures changes in the resident population.
5. For dates before 30 June 1976 the estimates for Australia are made retrospectively from the figures for 30 June 1976 by deduction of natural increase and net migration gain (on the new definition which excludes movement for less than a year) with a further small deduction to allow for the number aged 0-4 years in the adjusted 1976 Census results in excess of the number accountable for by natural increase and net migration. (The results for 30 June 1971 are slightly higher than the 1971 Census figures adjusted for underenumeration as measured by the 1971 post enumeration survey). The quarter to quarter and year to year movement between 1971 and 1976 refers therefore to changes of Australian population identified as resident.
6. For the States and Territories the estimates for dates before 30 June 1976 are made in the same way as for Australia, with the further deduction of net interstate migration, and adjustments needed to make the estimate for each State and Territory balance with the corresponding estimate for 30 June 1971. This estimate for 30 June 1971 for each State and Territory is made from the 1971 Census results, with an augmented adjustment for underenumeration to make the total balance with the estimate for Australia made retrospectively from the 1976 Census. In effect, the year to year and quarter to quarter movements in the estimates between 1971 and 1976 reflect changes in the resident population of the States and Territories or for Australia as a whole, but they also reflect differences in the distribution of interstate visitors in 1971 and 1976.
7. Although these population figures are designated as final, it is possible that the whole series or any part of it will be revised in the light of future census results.

## Temporary population movements

8. As indicated above, holiday, business and other similar short term movements are not taken into account in the quarterly calculations. More specifically, overseas migration refers to permanent and long term movement, and interstate migration refers to changes of place of residence estimated from records of transfers of electoral enrolments and address changes for payment of family allowances, supplemented by data from periodic surveys of internal migration. However, as pointed out above, the benchmark figures for 30 June 1976 reflect the results of short term movement, insofar as people who were on holiday or other short term travel at the time of the 1976 Census are counted in the population of the State or Territory where they spent Census night, or if overseas, are excluded from the Census.

## Mean population and quarterly rates

9. Mean population estimates are calculated for twelve month period to provide an average basis for calculation of annual rates requiring allowance for the continuous change in population figures. The mean population has been calculated by the formula:

$$
\text { mean population }=\frac{a+4 b+2 c+4 d+e}{12}
$$

where $a, b, c, d$ and $e$, respectively, are the populations at the end of the quarter immediately preceding the year and at the end of each of the four succeeding quarters; e.g. in the case of a calendar year 31 December of the preceding year, and 31 March, 30 June, 30 September and 31 December of the year under consideration. Rates for quarters are equivalent annual rates calculated by multiplying the number of, say, registrations for the quarter by four and dividing by the estimated population at the end of the quarter (expressed as a rate per 1,000 of the average popu!ation).

## Seasonal and other effects on quarterly figures

10. @arterly figures and rates for marriages, births and deaths reflect seasonal influences and may also be influenced by varying delays in registrations due to administrative and other factors which may affect the month of registration. A variation in rates based on small numbers of events may reflect transitory changes which can average out in variations in rates based on large numbers. Divorce figures, particularly the numbers dissolutions granted, are affected by such administrative factors as the occurrence of law vacations and the availability of judges, and, from 1975, by the introduction of the new legislation.

NOTE: The population statistics for June 1976 embodied, for the first time, an addition to the recorded Census figures for under enumeration. This made it necessary to amend the previously published 1971 Census results, and the amended figure was estimated, for Australia, by the steps indicated in the last column. To appreciate the nature of this amendment, both for Australia and the States and Territories, the table should thercfore be read from bottom to top. For the States and Territories there was an additional step. apart from the deduction of net interstate migration. This is shown by the line called "adjustment (e)". It was made necessary by the fact that while the Australian amended total for June 1971 as estimated retrospectively from June 1976 incorporated only changes in the resident population (because short term visitor movement was excluded from the deduction for overseas migration), the amended 1971 total for each State and Territory reflected the intercensal changes in the distribution of interstate visitors as well.
