SUMMARY OF VITAL AND POPULATION STATISTICS SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1973

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The estimated population for Australia as a whole takes account of natural increase and net overseas migration since the latest census.

2. The estimate for each State or Territory represents the population ascertained at the census plus recorded natural increase and net gain from overseas migration for that State or Territory; gains and corresponding losses that result from movements between States and Territories are also taken into account in so far as they are recorded as transfers of State of residence under child endowment procedures or Commonwealth electoral procedures or are indicated in other ways such as the results of any special count. As records of migration by State or Territory are not complete the estimated State and Territory populations so derived are approximate and are subject to revision when the population of each State is ascertained at the next census.

3. Holiday, business and other similar short-term movements between States and Territories are not taken into account in the quarterly calculations. However such movements do affect the estimates in so far as people who were on holiday or other short-term interstate travel at the time of the census are counted in the population of the State or Territory where they spent census night. On the other hand, changes in the populations of States and Territories due to visitors from overseas and Australians travelling overseas are reflected in all estimates.

4. This issue contains two additional tables relating to the population at 30 June 1973. Table 3 shows the estimated age distribution of the population of Australia at 30 June 1973 by single years of age and sex. The age distribution is based on the ages of persons enumerated at the census of 30 June 1971, but adjusted for inaccuracies in statements of age, natural increase derived from records of births and recorded ages at death, and details of overseas migration. The estimates are subject to revision in the light of the results of the next census. Ages are shown in the table in units without being rounded to tens or hundreds; it is to be understood that accuracy down to the unit is not claimed and should not be assumed. Corresponding figures for the States and Territories will appear in a separate publication, Reference No. 4.15.

5. Table 4 shows the estimated populations, at 30 June 1973 and the two previous years, of the Statistical Divisions and Districts for the capital cities and other major cities. The boundaries circumscribe the areas which are now, or expected to be, socially and economically oriented towards the urban centres. The areas in respect of State capital cities are designated "Statistical Divisions", those in respect of other cities with a population of 75,000 or more at the time of the census (Canberra, Newcastle, Wollongong and Geelong) are designated as "Statistical Districts". Population estimates for other major urban centres will be published separately, Reference No. 4.18.

6. Quarterly figures and rates for marriages, births and deaths reflect seasonal influences and may also be influenced by varying delay in registration. A variation in rates based on small numbers of events may reflect transitory changes which can average out in variations in rates based on larger numbers. Quarterly figures for the Northern Territory are especially affected by variations in the delay of registration. For quarters up to June quarter 1972, registrations of events can be compared with the occurrence of the events. For instance, death rates in the Northern Territory, based on occurrence, were 8.07 in the June quarter 1971 and 5.48 in the June quarter 1972, compared with 6.48 and 7.06 based on registrations. Quarterly divorce figures, particularly the numbers of dissolutions granted, are affected by such administrative factors as the occurrence of law vacations and the availability of Judges.

NOTE. (i) Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables are due to rounding.

(ii) Birth and death figures in this bulletin (i.e. Tables 1, 7, 8 and 9) do not include stillbirths.
