Monthly figures of oversea arrivals and departures are shown in the tables below. The figures for the latest month are obtained from a preliminary count and are subject to revision. Final figures for this month will be shown in the next issue of these statistics. More detailed statistics are available on a quarterly basis (see Oversea Arrivals and Departures, Part 1: Permanent and Long-Merri Movement; and Part 2: Total and Short-term Movement). These statistics were formerly included in issues of the Australian Demographic Review but appear now as separate series.

"Permanent Movement" relates to persons arriving who state their intention to settle permanently in Australia, and residents departing who state their intention to reside permanently abroad. "Long-term Movement" relates to the arrival of visitors or temporary departure of residents who state their intention to stay (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors or return of residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more. "Short-term Movement" relates to all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay.

Further information regarding the basis of these statistics is given in the quarterly publications.

Supplement to Oversea Arrivals and Departures - May, 1965 (Preliminary)

STATE OR TERRITORY OF INTENDED RESIDENCE OF SETTLERS ARRIVING : AUSTRALIA, 1963 AND 1964

The following table shows the number of settlers arriving in Australia, according to State or Territory of intended residence. "Settlers" are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. (They are asked, on or before arrival, the State or Territory of Australia in which they next intend to stay for twelve months or more.) The allocation to States and Territories in the table is based on these statements, except that settlers proceeding to the migrant reception centre, Bonegilla, Victoria, are allocated, as far as is practicable, to the State or Territory of their placement from the centre. THE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE SETTLERS' INTENTIONS AT THE TIME AND MAY NOT BE REALIZED. THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

Statistics on the basis provided in this supplement are not available for periods prior to 1963. The latest available figures will be published in future quarterly issues of Oversea Arrivals and Departures, Part I - Permanent and Long-term Movement.
