## MAIN FEATURES

## Settler arrivals

It is estimated that $\mathbf{3 0 , 7 0 0}$ settlers arrived in the four months to September 1980, 28 per cent more than in the corresponding four months of 1979.

In the year ending June $1980,80,700$ settlers arrived, 20 per cent more than in the year ending June 1979.

## Short term movement

It is estimated that $\mathbf{1 0}$ per cent more short term visitors arrived in the four months to September 1980 than in the corresponding four months of 1979. The bulk of the increase arrived in June and July.

For June and July, the principal sources of increased visitor traffic were New Zealand, Japan and SouthEast Asian countries.

There was no significant change in the total number of residents departing for short-term visits. However, there was an increase in the number of residents going to Asia and the Pacific, and a decrease in the number visiting Europe.

The proportion leaving for shorter durations under one month increased, while the number travelling for more than one month decreased.

Fewer residents specified visiting relatives as the reason for overseas travel, while a greater proportion of overseas visitors specified this as the main reason for visiting Australia, compared to the same period (June-July) in 1979.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction
This publication contains provisional estimates for August and September 1980 and final estimates for June and July 1980. The provisional estimates are based on early counts of passenger cards made by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs and are expected to be superseded shortly by final estimates.
