### **MAIN FEATURES**

Total overseas arrivals in the September quarter 1979 are provisionally estimated at 536,700, about 12 per cent higher than in the September quarter 1978, almost entirely due to a substantial increase in overseas short-term (less than one year) arrivals.

Total departures are provisionally estimated at 497,000, about 15 per cent above the September quarter 1978 figure.

Settler arrivals in the September quarter were 17,800, an increase of 6 per cent over the September quarter 1978.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

#### Introduction

This publication contains the latest available provisional estimates of overseas arrivals and departures as obtained from counts of passenger cards made by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, together with preliminary and final figures for earlier periods. Provisional estimates are expected to be superseded quickly by better based statistics. Preliminary estimates are produced at a later stage of processing and are subject to minimal revision. More detailed statistics for

the months of October, November and December 1978 are shown overleaf. It is hoped to overcome the delay in the availability of these details in the months to come.

OVERSEAS ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES: REVISED MONTHLY PUBLICATION

A survey of users of overseas arrivals and departures statistics was conducted by the ABS in June 1979. Although the response rate was disappointing (18% of questionnaires were returned), the survey indicated that a majority of responding users require only broad groupings of data on a monthly basis, but require these as soon as possible after the end of the month. The publication attached has therefore been revised to provide the latest available figures in an abridged form. While this version shows less detail than previous monthly publications, the ABS will still produce, in computer printout and microfiche form, a wide range of cross-classified tables on a monthly basis. These tabulations can be made available to users requiring more detail, and enquiries should be directed to the address shown at the head of the publication. A charge may be made for the supply of unpublished tables depending on the complexity of the request.

Future quarterly publications will include some monthly time-series data, but these publications will continue to come out well after the latest month included in the publication.

Your comments on the revised format of the monthly publications are invited. The current delays in the publication of data (caused by the increased volume of processing in the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs and the ABS) are now being overcome, and it is likely that by mid-1980, the current backlog of processing will be cleared and the delays substantially reduced.
