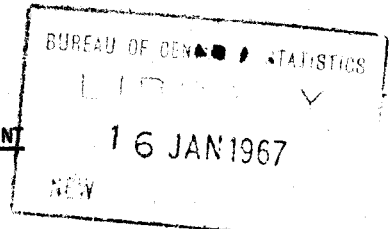

Explanatory Notes

This publication provides statistics of overseas arrivals and departures classified as permanent and long-term movement during the September quarter 1966. Table 1, however, gives a short summary of all overseas arrivals and departures including those classified as short-term movement. Statistics of country of birth of arrivals and departures classified as permanent and long-term movement, and of age and marital status of permanent arrivals and departures, are prepared for six-monthly periods, the latest being for the half year ended June, 1966, published in the June quarter issue of this publication.

2. More detailed statistics of short-term movement and of total movement will appear in Part 2 of this publication, to be entitled "Overseas Arrivals and Departures, September Quarter 1966, Part 2. - Total and Short-term Movement". Preliminary monthly figures of overseas arrivals and departures, classified into permanent, long-term and short-term movements, are also issued, the latest being in respect of September, 1966 (See "Overseas Arrivals and Departures - September, 1966 (Preliminary)" issued on 4 November, 1966.
3. The statistics of overseas arrivals and departures exclude passengers passing through Australia on board the same ship or on the same flight (variously called direct transit passengers or "through" passengers), passengers on a short pleasure cruise in the South West Pacific commencing and finishing in Australia on a ship not engaged in a regular voyage, and all air crew and ships crew.
4. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on the purpose of travel stated by the traveller on arrival in or departure from Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. MANY TRAVELLERS SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.
5. Permanent movement consists of persons arriving with the stated intention of settling permanently in Australia, and Australian residents departing with the stated intention of residing permanently abroad. Settlers are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. Former Settlers are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more, and were now departing permanently.
6. Long-term movement consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with the stated intention of staying (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more.
7. Short-term movement consists of all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay.
