## MAIN FEATURES

## CALENDAR YEAR 1980

Permanent and long-term movements Permanent arrivals (settlers) increased 30.9 per cent from 72,200 in 1979 to 94,500 in 1980

Australian residents departing permanently fell 11.0 per cent to $\mathbf{2 0 , 8 0 0}$.

Australian residents departing intending to stay abroad for twelve months or more fell 6.5 per cent to $\mathbf{5 0 , 7 0 0}$.

Overseas visitors arriving for stays in Australia of twelve months or more fell 7.2 per cent to $\mathbf{3 1 , 0 0 0}$.

## Short-term movements

The numbers of overseas visitors rose 14.0 per cent from 793,300 in 1979 to 904,600 in 1980.
The numbers arriving from Asia increased 24.9 per cent to $\mathbf{1 3 8 , 7 0 0}$; the largest proportional increases being from Malaysia, Indonesia and Hong Kong.
Overseas visitor arrivals from America, Europe and Oceania, including New Zealand, rose 16.4, 12.9 and 11.3 per cent respectively. New Zealand remained the largest source of visitor traffic followed by the U.K. and the U.S.A.
The number of Australian residents going abroad for short-term visits increased 2.4 per cent from 1,175,800 in 1979 to $1,203,600$ in 1980. Asia grew in importance as a destination, increasing 32.8 per cent to 315,500. The number of travellers to Europe $(349,100)$ was 11.2 per cent below the 1979 level.

Months of November and December 1980
There was an increase over November/December 1979 of 35.4 per cent in the number of settler arrivals, to 19,700 . The number of residents departing permanently decreased 10.0 per cent.
The number of overseas visitors arriving for shortterm visits increased 4.6 per cent while the number of A ustralian residents leaving for such trips abroad increased 1.0 per cent over the corresponding two months in 1979.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Introduction

This series of publications comes out at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available provisional and final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for November and December 1980.
2. Overseas arrivals and departures statistics are obtàined from passenger cards completed by travellers. Provisional estimates, based on early counts of cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, are shown in these publications if they are available and not yet superseded by final estimates.
