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MAIN FEATURES

YEAR 1981

Permanent and long-term movement

Permanent arrivals (settlers) increased 25.6 per cent from 94,500 in 1980 to 118,700 in 1981. Overseas visitors arriving for long term stays in Australia also rose by 11.4 per cent to 34,600.

Australian residents departing permanently decreased 4.7 per cent to 19,900, and Australian residents departing for long term visits abroad fell 7.8 per cent to 46,700.

Short-term movement

The number of overseas short-term visitors rose 3.6 per cent from 904,600 in 1980 to 936,700 in 1981.

The number arriving from Asia increased 16.8 per cent to 162,100 the largest proportional increases being from the Philippines, Thailand and Singapore.

Overseas visitor arrivals from America and Europe rose 4.0 and 9.2 per cent to 151,900 and 266,100 respectively. Oceania remained the largest source of visitor traffic, although visitors from Oceania fell 6.6 per cent to 335,700 in 1981. Most of the fall was due to a decline in visitors from New Zealand.

The number of Australian residents going abroad for short-term visits increased 1.1 per cent from 1,203,600 in 1980 to 1,217,300 in 1981. Asia continued to grow in importance as a destination, increasing 14.9 per cent to 362,300. The number of travellers to Europe (301,700) was 13.6 per cent below the 1980 level and 23.3 per cent below the total for 1979.

January 1982

The provisional estimate of permanent arrivals for January 1982 is 11,400, 14.3 per cent higher than for January 1981. Short-term visitor arrivals also increased to 87,000 in January 1982, a 25.1 per cent increase on the January 1981 total.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This series of publications is released at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available provisional and final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for November and December 1981, and provisional estimates for January 1982.

Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. Provisional estimates, based on early counts of cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, are shown in these publications if they are available and not yet superseded by final estimates.
