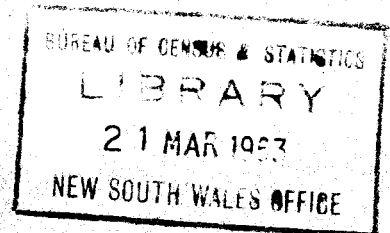

AUSTRALIAN DEMOGRAPHIC REVIEW NO. 160 : OVERSEA ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES, JUNE, SEPTEMBER AND DECEMBER QUARTERS, 1962

INTRODUCTION

For a number of years overseas travellers have been classified for statistical purposes into "permanent and long-term movement" and "short-term movement", the latter being divided into movements of Australian residents and overseas visitors. Table 1 of this Review contains statistics of travellers classified in this way for recent years and quarters.

2. In July 1958, the range of particulars obtained from travellers was revised to enable the "long-term and permanent movement" to be divided into "permanent movement" (settlers arriving and Australian residents departing permanently) and "long-term movement", the latter being further divided into long-term movements of Australian residents and overseas visitors. The first publication of statistics according to the extended classification was in Review No. 143, issued on 1st May, 1962.

3. In this issue of the Review:-

Table 2 contains particulars of the number of travellers in the new categories of the long-term and permanent movements from March quarter, 1959 to December quarter, 1962:

Tables 3 to 5 contain particulars of nationality (including country of citizenship of persons of British nationality); country of last (or intended future) residence; and occupation - for June, September and December quarters, 1962:

Tables 6 and 7 contain particulars of birthplace and age and conjugal condition, which are published only for half-yearly periods - for the six months ended June and December, 1962.

4. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on the purpose of travel stated by the traveller on arrival in or departure from Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. MANY TRAVELLERS SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

5. Permanent movement consists of persons arriving with stated intent to settle permanently in Australia, and Australian residents departing with stated intent to reside permanently abroad.

6. Long-term movement consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with stated intent to stay (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors and the return of Australians who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more.

7. Short-term movement consists of all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay. Air crew and ships' crew are excluded.

8. Settlers are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. Former Settlers (see column 5 of Table 2) are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more and were now departing permanently. Persons who stated a period of less than twelve months are classified to "visitors departing, short-term movement". Information relating to other aspects of permanent overseas migration was given in Part II of Demographic Review No. 113.
