QUARTERLY ESTIMATES OF NATIONAL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

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The quarterly implicit price deflators (IPDs) published in Table 42 (continued) on page 39 were in error for exports of goods and services, imports of goods and services, and expenditure on gross domestic product. The implicit price deflators shown in Table 9 on page 13 and the underlying historical data shown in Tables 33 and 35 on pages 29 and 31 are correct. The correct historical IPDs are contained in the replacement page overleaf which should be substituted for page 39 in the publication.
