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## NOTES ON THE ESTIMATES

### MAIN FEATURES

**NOTE:** Changes in individual quarters are necessarily subject to the uncertainties discussed in the Explanatory notes under interpretation of quarterly estimates, and furthermore some may be substantially revised as firmer data come to hand. This applies particularly to the estimates for the two most recent years for gross operating surplus, the income of companies and non-farm unincorporated enterprises, depreciation, and therefore to the estimated magnitude of change in gross non-farm product.

In current price seasonally adjusted terms, wages, salaries and supplements rose by 2.2 per cent in December quarter 1984, following a rise of 1.2 per cent in the previous quarter, while gross operating surplus of trading enterprise companies rose 3.0 per cent after falling by 0.7 per cent in the September quarter 1984.

The following notes are provided to aid analysis of the estimates for recent quarters.

**Release of this publication has been delayed by approximately three weeks as a consequence of the implementation of major changes to the Public Finance data system. These changes are referred to below and discussed in paragraph 6 of the Explanatory notes.**

#### Changes and revisions in this issue

Significant changes affecting the full period covered by this publication have been made to a number of aggregates in the domestic production account.

These changes have arisen as a result of:

- conceptual and classificatory changes made to the Public Finance data system; and
- a new item 'real estate transfer expenses' introduced on the expenditure side of the domestic production account as a component of private gross fixed capital expenditure. (See paragraphs 3 to 5 of the Explanatory notes.)

The major aggregates affected by the changes are:

- Private final consumption expenditure
- Government final consumption expenditure
- Gross fixed capital expenditure — private dwellings, private non-dwelling construction, general government and public enterprises

- Increase in stocks — farm, public marketing authorities and other public authorities
- Statistical discrepancy
- Gross operating surplus — public trading enterprises
- Indirect taxes less subsidies

Estimates for all aggregates, particularly in respect of more recent periods, have been revised in accordance with revised annual estimates which will be published shortly in "Australian National Accounts, National Income and Expenditure 1983-84, Summary" (5201.0). Seasonally adjusted estimates have also been revised following the normal annual reanalysis of all adjusted series.

#### Government final consumption expenditure

The current price value of this aggregate is estimated using data from public authority accounts, which record cash flows. The estimates therefore reflect the effects of pre-payment of salaries over holiday periods, back pay associated with award changes, etc. It is not always possible to identify all these effects when compiling the deflators used to derive constant price estimates. Therefore, quarter-to-quarter movements in the constant price seasonally adjusted estimates for this aggregate should be

treated with caution. The percentage changes for September and December quarters 1984 are also affected significantly by the inclusion of the full value (\$280 million in current prices) of a frigate delivered to the Australian Navy in July 1984.

#### Gross fixed capital expenditure — Sales of public sector assets

The national accounts attribute gross fixed capital expenditure to sectors on the basis of legal ownership. Since 1980-81 a number of major sales of public sector assets to the private sector on a sale/leaseback basis have occurred. For information regarding such transactions up to June quarter 1984 reference should be made to the September quarter 1984 issue of this publication — see 'Notes on the estimates' (page 1). No quantitative information is available yet concerning the September and December quarters 1984.

#### Stocks

In seasonally adjusted terms, private non-farm stocks at constant prices recorded a larger increase than in September quarter 1984, continuing the restocking which began in March quarter 1984. The increase in stocks contributed 0.5 percentage points to growth in gross domestic product (GDP) in December quarter 1984.

Despite the build-up in stocks in recent quarters, the constant price private non-farm stocks to sales (a) ratio fell marginally to a new record low level in December quarter 1984. The private non-farm stocks to sales ratio in recent quarters is as follows:

(a) Constant price sales are defined as gross non-farm product plus imports of goods and services (excluding petroleum, civil aircraft and government imports) less changes in private non-farm stocks. (All these variables are at average 1979-80 prices.)

#### Statistical discrepancy

The statistical discrepancy represents the difference between the sum of the estimates of gross domestic product (GDP) and imports of goods and services on the one hand and the sum of the estimates of components of gross national expenditure and exports of goods and services on the other hand. Conceptually these two totals are the same. The inclusion of the statistical discrepancy on the expenditure side of the domestic production account is a convention and does not necessarily imply that the sum of the income components more accurately measures GDP than the sum of the expenditure components.

As indicated above the statistical discrepancy has been affected by significant changes introduced in this issue. For more recent periods data revisions have also had a significant impact on the statistical discrepancy.

The aspect of the statistical discrepancy which is of most concern in the quarterly context is the magnitude of change from one quarter to the next. In some quarters there are quite significant movements in the seasonally adjusted constant price statistical discrepancy. A useful way of examining the significance of the statistical discrepancy is to compare the change in gross non-farm product as published with the result which would be obtained using the expenditure aggregates excluding the statistical discrepancy. The following table shows such a comparison for the last 6 quarters.

#### Household saving ratio

Present estimates indicate that, on a seasonally adjusted basis, the proportion of household disposable income devoted to consumption in the December quarter was 85.8 per cent while household saving, which is derived as a balancing item, represented 14.2 per cent. Both of these ratios are affected by any deficiencies or inconsistencies in the estimation and seasonal adjustment of household income and expenditure.

The household saving ratio in recent quarters is as follows:

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### **Introduction**

This publication provides estimates of the components of gross domestic product and national expenditure and supporting tables for the December quarter 1984, together with comparative estimates for the eight previous quarters and the four years 1980-81 to 1983-84. In addition, seasonally adjusted estimates of the major aggregates and some selected series are provided for the December quarter 1984, together with comparative estimates for the twelve previous quarters. Tables 32-42 provide time series, in both original and seasonally adjusted terms, for the period from September quarter 1969 for the aggregates contained in the domestic production account (at both current and average 1979-80 prices), some selected income aggregates and implicit price deflators.

### **Concepts, definitions, sources and methods**

2. A basic guide to the Australian national accounts entitled *Australian National Accounts, Concepts, Sources and Methods* (5216.0) is available. It outlines major concepts and definitions, describes sources of data and methods used to derive annual and quarterly estimates for major aggregates at current and constant prices and discusses the accuracy and reliability of the national accounts. The concepts, definitions, sources and methods applicable to the estimates contained in this publication are as described in 5216.0 but with the changes outlined below in 'Changes in this issue' and in Appendix A, *Australian National Accounts, National Income and Expenditure, 1982-83* (5204.0).

### **Changes in this issue**

3. A major new item 'real estate transfer expenses' has been included for the first time in this publication. The item, which in 1983-84 amounted to more than \$2 billion, is shown as a component of private gross fixed capital expenditure. Real estate transfer expenses comprise the various fees which are incurred by either the buyer or seller of real estate viz legal fees on transfer, real estate sales commissions, stamp duties on transfer and other government charges. The estimates do not include the value of work performed 'in house' e.g. conveyancing performed by an enterprise's own legal staff. It should be noted that estimates of real estate transfer expenses are not separately identified for the public sector. In any event transfer expenses of public authorities are relatively insignificant because the majority of public authorities are exempt from stamp duty, they frequently use their own staff to undertake the associated legal work and they make only limited use of real estate agents.

4. Although the treatment of all real estate transfer expenses as gross fixed capital expenditure involves some conceptual compromises, especially in respect of speculative transactions in real estate (which, it could be argued, should be treated as intermediate consumption), it is regarded as a reasonable and practical convention. Such a treatment is also in line with that recommended in the United Nations 'A System of National Accounts' (SNA) and with the practices generally adopted in the national accounts of other countries.

5. The inclusion of real estate transfer expenses removes a major area of understatement affecting the expenditure side of the domestic production account.

The income side of the domestic production account has always included the corresponding operating surplus of lawyers and real estate agents, while stamp duties have been included in indirect taxes and other government charges have been offset against government final consumption expenditure.

6. A number of significant changes have been made in this publication as a result of incorporating data from the redesigned Public Finance collection and processing system. As a consequence some new aggregates have been introduced while the definitions of some existing aggregates have been modified. The major changes arising from this redesign are:

- (i) A clearer distinction has now been made between transactions involving the general government sector and those involving the public trading enterprise sector. Consequently, some aggregates within the general government income and outlay accounts have been revised to avoid the previous consolidation of certain public trading enterprise transactions with those of general government.
- (ii) Contributions to public enterprises to offset recurring losses have in the past been treated as negative transfers of income between the public enterprises and general government sectors. However, the SNA treats contributions to cover losses which result from a deliberate policy of maintaining prices at a level which does not cover current costs of production as subsidies (paragraph 7.36). Therefore contributions by general government to public enterprises to offset recurring losses have now been classified as subsidies.
- (iii) The treatment of transactions associated with public superannuation schemes has been rationalised. The new methodology clearly distinguishes between schemes involving general government employees and those involving public enterprise employees. Major changes have been made to the treatment of transactions involving the Defence Forces Retirement Benefits Scheme (DFRBS) and the Commonwealth Superannuation Scheme. The former transfer items 'Unfunded employee retirement benefits' and 'unfunded employee retirement benefit contributions' (an element of 'other direct taxes, fees, fines etc'), which mainly related to the DFRBS, are no longer considered appropriate and have been discontinued. For general government enterprises the net recurring cost of superannuation to government is now included in government final consumption expenditure and as supplements to wages and salaries. In the case of public enterprises the total employer contribution to superannuation, whether paid to Consolidated Revenue or to a superannuation fund, is classified as supplements to wages and salaries and deducted in the calculation of public enterprises' gross operating surplus.
- (iv) Public sector gross fixed capital expenditure on dwellings formerly included expenditure by housing authorities on construction of dwellings for rental purposes less the book value of

previously rented dwellings sold to tenants. Commencing with this publication the actual sales price will be used in this calculation rather than the book value. In general, the effect of this change in treatment will be to lower both public capital expenditure on dwellings and gross operating surplus of public trading enterprises.

- (v) Estimates of public gross fixed capital expenditure (GFCE) have been revised to fully reflect both purchases and sales of second hand non-dwelling construction and equipment by the public sector. This change was foreshadowed in previous issues of this publication, most recently in paragraph 3 of the Explanatory Notes to the March quarter 1984 issue of 5206.0. (From the March quarter 1982 issue to the September quarter 1984 issue of 5206.0 an interim treatment was adopted in which major sales of public sector assets to the private sector were deducted from public GFCE and included in private GFCE.)
- (vi) In previous issues of this publication current grants to private non-profit institutions were included in government final consumption expenditure. In this issue current grants by both general government and public trading enterprises to private non-profit institutions are recorded as transfer payments with the subsequent consumption expenditure by these institutions being included in private final consumption expenditure.
- (vii) Income taxes paid by public enterprises were formerly recorded as income transfers. However these taxes are now explicitly recorded as income taxes in the relevant general government income and outlay accounts.
- (viii) Payroll tax paid by general government enterprises has until now been netted off payroll tax receipts. The revised treatment is to include payroll tax paid by general government in both government final expenditures and payroll tax receipts.
- (ix) The previous practice of netting certain property income payments by general government off the corresponding receipts item has been discontinued. The gross flows are now shown.
- (x) Seigniorage on coins was previously included in the item 'income transferred from public financial enterprises to general government'. Under the new system seigniorage is recorded as an element of property income paid by public financial enterprises to general government.

For a more detailed discussion of the nature of most of the changes outlined above, reference should be made to paragraphs 38 to 50, "Classifications Manual for Government Finance Statistics, Australia" (1217.0).

7. In addition to the changes noted in the previous paragraph the coverage of public marketing boards, which are classified as public trading enterprises, has been expanded in this publication although a number of small public marketing authorities have not yet been included.

#### Interpretation of quarterly estimates

8. Estimating for a period of less than one year presents special problems in that it is often difficult to adhere strictly to definitions and concepts used in annual estimates. The measurement of income for a quarterly period is particularly difficult since it is not always possible to match the value of production for a quarter with the cost incurred in that production. This problem occurs, for example, in estimating the income of farm unincorporated enterprises in each quarter, and results in considerable variation of the estimates for this series, and for gross farm product, from quarter to quarter. Difficulties are also experienced in obtaining detailed data for short periods and in preparing consistent estimates from various sources where different accounting procedures and periods are used.

9. These problems inevitably affect the consistency and reliability of the current price estimates, and similarly affect the constant price estimates based on the current price estimates. Accordingly, these factors as well as the approximations and assumptions necessarily made in the revaluation of flows to constant prices should be borne in mind when interpreting or using the estimates, for example, in attempting to draw precise quantitative inferences relating to quarter-to-quarter changes in gross domestic product or its components, or in productivity.

10. Analysis of trends requires allowance for these uncertainties in estimation. The effects are in some measure indicated by the change in the statistical discrepancy for corresponding periods. Uncertainty in trends arises also from the likelihood of revisions as more information becomes available and from the irregularity of short-term movements. The inclusion of the statistical discrepancy on the expenditure side of the accounts is a convention and does not necessarily imply that the sum of the income components more accurately measures GDP than the sum of the expenditure components (plus exports less imports). As household and other saving are estimated as balancing items in their respective accounts, care should be exercised in their interpretation.

11. Estimates of national income and expenditure are necessarily prepared from a wide range of statistical information, some of which is available quickly and some only with a delay of several years. For this reason most figures should be regarded as subject to revision as more complete and more accurate information becomes available. The revisions will be of two main types-those made to the most recent quarters as firmer quarterly or monthly data come to hand and those which are a consequence of revisions to annual totals and are distributed to the quarters approximately in accordance with existing quarterly patterns.

12. No simple measure is available of the accuracy of the major summary national accounting aggregates. However the following example illustrates the sensitivity of quarter to quarter growth to the timing of recording a transaction. If, in the latest year, the timing of recording a transaction were delayed by one quarter and if the transaction had an impact on constant price gross domestic product of +\$33 million then the measure of the rate of growth would be affected in three adjoining quarters (centred on the quarter in which the transaction

was recorded) by -0.1, +0.2, and -0.1 percentage points respectively. Of course the percentage impact of such a timing delay on relevant sub-aggregates would be greater.

13. The quarterly implicit price deflators (IPDs) shown in Tables 9 and 42 are derived by dividing seasonally adjusted current price estimates by the corresponding seasonally adjusted constant price estimates. Movements in the levels of individual implicit price deflators can be greatly affected by changes in the physical composition of the aggregates and their components. Generally, it is considered that IPDs derived from seasonally adjusted data are more reliable than those obtained by using original (i.e. unadjusted) series, because the former are less likely to be affected by compositional change than are the latter. However the seasonal adjustment process is itself a source of possible distortion, especially to the extent that it is not possible to identify, in a fully consistent way, the seasonality of the current price estimates and of the constant price estimates. A discussion of the limitations involved in using IPDs as measures of pure price change is contained in Appendix B of *Australian National Accounts, Concepts, Sources and Methods* (5216.0).

#### **Seasonal adjustment**

14. As most series are affected to some extent by seasonal factors, allowance should be made for normal seasonal variation. In Tables 6, 8, 9, 13, 17, 19, 22, 23, 33, 35 and 37 to 42, *seasonally adjusted* values are presented for selected series. Series which show substantial irregularities in the original or adjusted series should be treated with some reserve. As different methods of seasonal adjustment tend to produce different results, it is necessary to bear in mind the methods by which they have been derived and the limitations to which those methods are subject. It should also be noted that the methods of seasonal adjustment used by the ABS do not force the sum of the seasonally adjusted estimates for each quarter of a financial year to equal the original annual total.

15. The general methods used in the ABS for making seasonal adjustments are described in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia, 1983* (1308.0). However, special methods have been used to adjust some of the components of gross farm product which were not amenable to seasonal adjustment by the usual methods. To obtain the seasonally adjusted estimates, the estimated values of production of wheat, other grain and sugar cane, for any financial year, are distributed equally over the four quarters of the year ended June. One effect of these methods is that changes in the annual production of these commodities first enter into the seasonally adjusted figures in the September quarter.

16. Where there is no apparent seasonality in their implicit price deflators, constant price estimates are seasonally adjusted using the same factors as are used for adjusting the corresponding current price estimates. As far as possible the remaining constant price estimates have been adjusted using methods similar to those for the corresponding current price estimates.

#### **Analysis of contributions to growth table**

17. Table 3 presents an analysis of the contribution provided by each major aggregate to the percentage change in seasonally adjusted gross domestic product at constant prices. The formula used to calculate the contribution of each aggregate to the growth in GDP is:

$$\frac{A(t)-A(t-1)}{GDP(t-1)} \times 100.0$$

where  $A(t)$  = value of aggregate A in quarter under consideration

$A(t-1)$  = value of aggregate A in preceding quarter

$GDP(t-1)$  = value of GDP in preceding quarter

All these values are seasonally adjusted constant price estimates. It should be noted that the figures in this table are additive within each quarter, unlike the percentage change tables shown elsewhere in this publication.

#### **Rounding of figures**

18. Although percentage changes are given to one decimal place in this publication, this does not imply that they can be regarded as accurate to the last digit shown. The figures after the decimal point are given to avoid distortions which may occur in rounding off the figures to the nearest half or whole number.

19. The procedures used in preparing this publication may occasionally result in rounding differences between figures in this publication and corresponding figures in other publications.

20. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals.
