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## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

### ALL FUNDS

#### Long term debt

- Gross indebtedness increased by 2.2 per cent from \$2,824.5m in 1991-92 to \$2,886.6m in 1992-93. Debt redemption for 1992-93 amounted to \$179.4m.

#### Revenue and loan receipts


- Local government revenue and loan receipts of \$3,049.9m in 1992-93 increased by 7.1 per cent from \$2,848.6m in 1991-92.
- Rates and charges are the major source of funds for local government authorities, amounting to \$1,799.6m in 1992-93, an increase of 6.4 per cent over the figure in 1991-92.
- Rates and charges represented 59.0 per cent of total revenue and loan receipts in 1992-93.

- Loan receipts decreased by 2.5 per cent from \$290.9m in 1991-92 to \$283.7m in 1992-93.
- Government grants increased by 12.8 per cent from \$372.7m in 1991-92 to \$420.5m in 1992-93.

#### LOCAL AUTHORITIES: TOTAL RECEIPTS OF ALL FUNDS, QUEENSLAND




## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS — *continued*

### Expenditure


- Local government expenditure for 1992–93 of \$2,849.2m increased by 5.5 per cent from \$2,700.1m for 1991–92. Current expenditure on goods, services and land increased by 6.1 per cent from \$1,254.2m in 1991–92 to \$1,331.3m in 1992–93 and capital expenditure increased by 9.4 per cent from \$912.9m in 1991–92 to \$998.5m in 1992–93.

**LOCAL AUTHORITIES: CURRENT AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURE AS A PROPORTION OF TOTAL EXPENDITURE ON GOODS, SERVICES AND LAND, QUEENSLAND**



- Expenditure on ordinary services accounted for the major proportion of total expenditure on goods, services and land being 72.3 per cent in 1992–93, while water supply services represented 13.6 per cent, sewerage services 9.6 per cent and other services 4.6 per cent.
- Total expenditure for 1992–93 on debt charges amounted to \$464.0m, a decrease of 1.6 per cent from 1991–92.

**LOCAL AUTHORITIES: DEBT CHARGES BY SERVICE, QUEENSLAND**




## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS — *continued*

### ORDINARY SERVICES

#### Revenue and loan receipts

- Total local government receipts for ordinary services amounted to \$2,002.5m in 1992–93, an increase of 6.3 per cent over the 1991–92 figure.
- The major source of funds was from the collection of rates which comprised 42.1 per cent of total revenue. Rates receipts increased from \$720.4m in 1991–92 to \$770.8m in 1992–93.
- Of revenue receipts, licences, fees and fines recorded the largest increase of 21.6 per cent from \$88.2m in 1991–92 to \$107.2m in 1992–93.
- Loan receipts decreased by 13.5 per cent from \$196.1m in 1991–92 to \$169.6m in 1992–93.

#### Expenditure

- Total expenditure on ordinary services in 1992–93 increased by 7.0 per cent from the 1991–92 level. Current expenditure on goods, services and land rose by 6.4 per cent and capital expenditure increased by 11.2 per cent. Debt charges decreased by 2.9 per cent.



## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS — *continued*

### WATER SUPPLY SERVICES

- Revenue and loan receipts** • Rates and charges increased by 2.7 per cent from \$420.7m in 1991–92 to \$432.2m in 1992–93. Government grants decreased by 27.1 per cent from \$10.1m in 1991–92 to \$7.4m in 1992–93, while loan receipts increased by 7.5 per cent in 1992–93.
- Expenditure** • Expenditure on goods, services and land increased by 6.6 per cent from \$296.5m in 1991–92 to \$316.1m in 1992–93.



### SEWERAGE SERVICES

- Revenue and loan receipts** • Rates and charges increased by 8.9 per cent from \$284.7m in 1991–92 to \$310.0m in 1992–93. Loan receipts increased by 29.3 per cent from \$39.6m in 1991–92 to \$51.2m in 1992–93.
- Expenditure** • Expenditure on goods, services and land increased by 3.4 per cent from \$216.2m in 1991–92 to \$223.5m in 1992–93.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### **Introduction**

The figures shown in this publication, except for area and estimated population, have been compiled from annual returns and annual financial statements supplied by each local authority to the Local Government Grants Commission and to the ABS.

2. The Brisbane City Council is governed by the Local Government Act only where its own City of Brisbane Act is silent or where an ordinance has not been issued altering the application of the Local Government Act to the Brisbane City Council.

3. The powers of local authorities include the levying of taxation in the form of rates, based on the unimproved value of land, and the borrowing of money to enable them to perform their functions. Chief among these are the provision and maintenance of roads, footpaths and community facilities, e.g. health services and recreational and cultural facilities. Most authorities also operate trading activities, the most common being water supply and sewerage services. A small number of authorities are also involved in gas, electricity and transport services.

4. Although the services provided by local authorities are financed primarily from rates, charges and loan raisings, financial assistance is also received from the Commonwealth and State Governments in the form of grants and subsidies.

### **Comparability**

5. The statistics shown in this publication have been prepared using a uniform local government accounting approach, presenting details of receipts and disbursements of funds maintained by each authority. Wherever possible, steps have been taken to eliminate the effects of inter-fund transfers in an attempt to present details of net revenue and expenditure patterns of each authority.

6. On occasions, details reported by some local authorities may not be strictly comparable from year to year or between authorities. In recent years such differences have appeared mostly in the statistics shown in Table 11, Lengths of Roads Normally Open to Traffic, because of re-alignments, changes in the classification of surface types and revisions to lengths reported by authorities resulting from a detailed definitional check conducted by the Local Government Grants Commission of Queensland.

7. In editions of this publication prior to 1989-90 Table 2 has presented a detailed analysis of Local Authority Loan Liabilities. This presentation has been replaced by showing the total gross indebtedness of each Local Authority in Table 1. Gross indebtedness is a broader concept of long-term liabilities through the addition of finance lease, time payment and deferred liabilities.

8. A change in accounting practice by Brisbane City Council in 1990-91, whereby the council has ceased the allocation of general administration overheads to subprograms, means that certain figures are no longer comparable with those of previous years.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES — *continued*

9. From 1 July 1991, the Commonwealth has recorded its funding of local authority roads as 'identified general purpose' grants. The 1991-92 edition of this publication reflected this treatment.

A subsequent review of this classification has indicated that the transactions are more appropriately recorded as specific purpose payments while they are separately identified. This edition reflects this recommendation.

### **Definitions**

10. Terms used in this bulletin are described here in brief.

**Rates:** the actual amount of rate revenue collected during the year plus pensioner subsidies and penalties less remissions.

**Charges:** income from sales of goods or services or rent on properties. Includes household and other garbage charges, sanitary charges, parking fees (but not fines), caravan parks and camping grounds fees and other fees for which a direct service is provided.

**General purpose grants:** funds distributed by the Commonwealth Government and the State Government in the tax sharing scheme and other assistance not tied to specific purposes.

**Specific purpose grants:** funds distributed by the Commonwealth Government and the State Government to assist with nominated expenditure programs.

**Reimbursements:** amounts received as payment for work done by the council, acting as an agent for other government bodies and property owners. This item includes reimbursements paid by Department of Transport.

**Loan receipts:** the amount actually taken up from loans or new long term debt incurred during the year. Conversion loans are excluded.

**Licences, fees and fines:** income received from licences and fees usually associated with the granting of a permit or privilege or regulation of an activity, and not designed primarily to raise revenue. These receipts are distinguished from charges in that they are compulsory payments where no direct tangible benefit accrues to the payer. These include dog registration, town planning, sub-division, building, registration of premises, health inspection, dumping, scavenging and refuse tip fees; and parking fines and penalties.

**Contributions and donations:** amounts paid by ratepayers or owners of non-rateable properties in payment of a proportion of the cost of specific projects (e.g. roads, footpaths, etc.), where the service is of benefit to them.

**Capital expenditure:** expenditure on new fixed assets (e.g. construction of roads, bridges, parks and buildings, and purchase of new plant and equipment), purchase of land and second-hand fixed assets.

**EXPLANATORY NOTES — *continued*****Definitions — *continued***

***Current expenditure:*** expenditure on purchases of goods and services. That is, cost of providing services, wages and salaries, and repair and maintenance of roads, bridges, buildings, etc.

***Interest paid:*** comprises interest paid on all debt, including bank overdrafts.

***Redemption:*** comprises principal repaid on long-term debt.

***Levies paid to government:*** relate to grants and compulsory payments to governments. Includes agricultural precepts and river improvement trust precepts.

**Australian Standard Geographical Classification**

11. The data are presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 2.3.

12. The legal local government area structure has been cross-classified with the statistical division level of the main structure. The use of this cross-classification requires the combination of the Brisbane and Moreton Statistical Divisions, as some legal local government areas cross the contiguous boundary of these two statistical divisions.

13. *Legal local government areas* (LGAs), as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

14. *Statistical divisions* (SDs), which are groupings of the whole or part of legal LGAs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture and Moreton.




