MAIN FEATURES

Secured housing finance commitments (excluding alterations and additions) made by significant lenders in November 1988 totalled \$2,335.6 million, an increase of \$467.8 million (25.0%) over October 1988 and \$804.4 million (52.5%) over November 1987. In seasonally adjusted terms November 1988 was 7.5% higher than October 1988 and 34.8% higher than November 1987.

First mortgage or equivalent finance was provided for 37,044 dwelling units in November 1988, 6,977 dwelling units (23.2%) more than October 1988 and 8,429 dwelling units (29.5%) more than November 1987.

In recent years the banking industry has experienced a number of changes such as the establishment of new banks and the deregulation of various banking practices. These changes appear to have affected the variability of the banking data. Users are warned, therefore, that care should be taken in the interpretation of monthly movements in both the original and seasonally adjusted series as they contain irregular and unusual influences whose variability is increasing. Trend estimates, which generally remove both seasonal and irregular effects, are being developed and are expected to be relatively unaffected by the presence of such variability. These trend estimates will be available for publication in the near future.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

1. This publication presents statistics of secured housing finance commitments made by significant lenders to individuals for the construction or purchase of dwellings for owner occupation. For detailed information on the scope and coverage of these statistics and definitions of data items refer to the July 1986 issue of this publication.

2. While the statistics are described as being for calendar months, it should be noted that:

- (i) in the case of *trading banks* and some of the larger savings banks, the data relate to a month ending on the last Wednesday; and
- (ii) in the case of *other lenders*, some have accounting periods which do not correspond exactly to a calendar month and their figures are used without adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment

3. Details of methods used in seasonally adjusting original series are available on request.
4. Large fluctuations in series as a result of irregular influences are not removed by seasonal adjustment. Particular care should therefore be taken in interpreting individual month-to-month movements.

Unpublished data

5. More detailed classification of the data in this publication may be made available on request. Generally a charge is made for providing this information. Inquiries should be made to the officer named in the Phone Inquiries section of the inquiries box at the front of this publication or by writing to Private Finance Section, ABS, P.O. Revisions

6. Revisions to previously published statistics are included in issues of this publication as they occur.

Commitments not advanced at end of period

7. In principle, commitments not advanced at end of period presented in Table 2 are derivable by adding total commitments less cancellations of commitments less commitments advanced during the period to the balance of commitments at the end of the previous period. In practice, however, revisions and other adjustments may mean that such a derivation is inexact.
