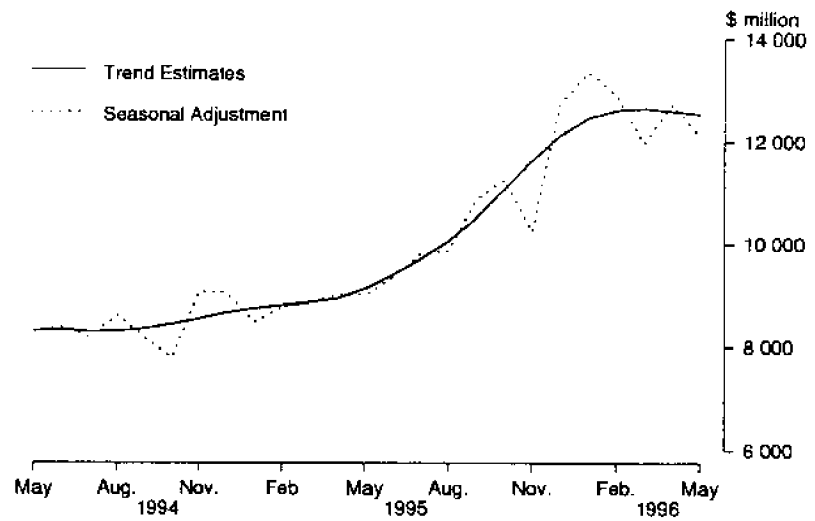
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## MAIN FEATURES

## COMMERCIAL FINANCE, AUSTRALIA, MAY 1994 – MAY 1996



- 1** The provisional trend estimate for commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders in May 1996 totalled \$12 533.0 million, a decrease of \$63.0 million (0.5%) on April 1996 but an increase of \$3 400.7 million (37.2%) on May 1995.
- 2** Seasonally adjusted commercial finance commitments totalled \$12 105.6 million in May 1996, a decrease of \$622.7 million (4.9%) on April 1996 but an increase of \$3 098.9 million (34.4%) on May 1995.
- 3** In original terms commercial finance commitments in May 1996 totalled \$12 895.2 million, an increase of \$1 491.8 million (13.1%) on April 1996 and an increase of \$3 329.8 million (34.8%) on May 1995.
