

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## MAIN FEATURES

### LEASE FINANCE, AUSTRALIA, JANUARY 1995 – JANUARY 1997



- 1** The provisional trend estimate for lease finance commitments made by significant lenders in January 1997 was \$653.2 million, an increase of \$16.3 million (2.5%) on December 1996 and an increase of \$4.6 million (0.7%) on January 1996.
- 2** Seasonally adjusted, lease finance commitments were \$761.7 million in January 1997, an increase of \$174.5 million (29.7%) on December 1996 and an increase of \$108.8 million (16.7%) on January 1996.
- 3** In original terms lease finance commitments in January 1997 were \$558.8 million, a decrease of \$74.2 million (11.7%) on December 1996 but an increase of \$80.5 million (16.8%) on January 1996.
