#### OVERVIEW

INTRODUCTION

This information paper provides details about the release of microdata from the 2001 Survey of Education, Training and Information Technology (SETIT). The data will be released as a Confidentialised Unit Record File (CURF) on CD-ROM, with the approval of the Australian Statistician.

The CURF will enable purchasers to tabulate, manipulate and analyse data to their own specifications.

More detailed information to assist in using the CURF, and in interpreting the data, is provided in the Technical Paper, which will accompany the file.

ABOUT THE SURVEY

The SETIT was conducted as a special supplementary survey throughout Australia from April to August 2001. All persons aged between 15 to 64 years who were in scope for the survey were asked a set of questions relating to their education and training experience. One person per household was asked about their, and the household's, access to and use of information technology. The CURF only contains one data item from the information technology component.

The survey collected detailed information on:

- socio-demographic characteristics (such as age, sex and birthplace).
- employment characteristics (such as labour force status, occupation and industry).
- educational qualifications obtained.
- recent study for educational qualifications.
- access to education and training.
- details of training courses completed (covering aspects such as time spent and employer support).
- use of information technology.

Estimates from the survey as well as more information on the survey sample, conceptual framework, definitions and methodology, Explanatory Notes and Glossary were published in *Education and Training Experience, Australia, 2001* (cat. no. 6278.0). Results of previous Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) surveys on this topic were published in *Education and Training Experience, Australia, 1997* (cat. no. 6278.0), *Training and Education Experience, Australia, 1993* (cat. no. 6278.0) and *How Workers Get Their Training, Australia, 1989* (cat. no. 6278.0). Information about CURFs from previous education and training surveys can be obtained from the Contact Officer.

Information from the survey about the use of information technology will be published in *Household Use of Information Technology, Australia* (cat. no. 8146.0).

SCOPE

The target population for the survey was persons aged 15 to 64 years who were usual residents of private dwellings. Private dwellings include houses, flats, home units and any other structures used as private places of residence at the time of the survey. 'Special' dwellings such as hotels, motels, hostels, hospitals and short-stay caravan parks were not included in the survey.

#### **OVERVIEW** continued

SCOPE continued

The survey was conducted in both urban and rural areas in all states and territories. However, people living in sparsely settled parts of Australia were excluded. The exclusion of these people will only have a minor impact on any aggregate estimates that are produced for individual states and territories, with the exception of the Northern Territory where such people account for over 20% of the population.

The following groups were excluded from the survey:

- certain diplomatic personnel of overseas governments, customarily excluded from the Census and estimated resident population figures.
- persons whose usual place of residence was outside Australia.
- members of non-Australian defence forces (and their dependants) stationed in Australia.
- visitors to private dwellings.

DATA COLLECTION
METHODOLOGY

The survey was conducted over fourteen weeks, from the end of April to the start of August 2001. Information was collected via face-to-face personal interviews conducted by trained interviewers who asked members of each household detailed questions about their education and training experience.

ABOUT THE MICRODATA

The data will be released under the *Census and Statistics Act 1905* which has provision for the release of data in the form of unit records where the information is not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation. Accordingly, there are no names or addresses of survey respondents on the CURF and some other steps have been taken to protect confidentiality, such as not including all data items that were collected and suppressing the detail of some other data items.

The SETIT CURF contains 24,377 confidentialised respondent records from the survey. A list of the data items and a range of predefined populations to assist in analysing data in the CURF, are provided as appendices to this paper.

Subject to the limitations of sample size and the data classifications used, it is possible to manipulate the data, produce tabulations and undertake statistical analyses to individual specifications.

Further information about the file and how to use the data is provided with the CURF in the Technical Paper and various information files.

Estimation

As the survey was conducted on a sample of all households in Australia, it is important to take account of the method of sample selection when deriving estimates from the CURF. This is particularly important as a person's chance of selection in the survey varied depending on the state or territory or, in some cases, area of state/territory in which they lived. One of the fields on the CURF contains a 'weight' for each person in the sample. This 'weight' reflects a person's probability of selection in the sample and the estimation procedure used.

Where estimates are derived from the CURF, it is essential that they are calculated by adding the weights of persons in each category and not just by counting the number falling into each category. If each person's 'weight' were to be ignored, then no account would be taken of the fact that a person's chance of being selected in the survey varied from region to region, and the resulting estimates would therefore be seriously biased.

#### **OVERVIEW** continued

Estimation continued

The application of weights will ensure that the subsequent estimates conform to an independently estimated distribution of the population by age and sex, rather than to the age and sex distribution within the sample itself.

Due to differences in the scope and sample size of this survey and that of the Labour Force Survey (LFS), the estimation procedure may lead to some small variations between labour force estimates from this survey and those from the LFSs conducted during April to August 2001.

Sampling error

Sampling error is the difference between the published estimate and the value that would have been produced if all dwellings in scope of the survey had been included. For more information see the Technical Note in *Education and Training Experience*, *Australia*, *2001* (cat. no. 6278.0).

Seasonal factors

The estimates are based on information collected over the reference period, and due to seasonal effects they may not be representative of other time periods in the year.

ABOUT THE FILES

The CD-ROM contains both SAS and SPSS versions of the SETIT dataset. If your analysis software is neither SAS nor SPSS, you may require the services of a computer programmer to use the ASCII file version of the data. Full details of the files on the CD-ROM are given in the Technical Paper supplied to CURF purchasers.

Four types of files relating to SETIT 2001 data are provided on CD-ROM:

- Data an ASCII data file holding 24,377 person records;
- SAS user files including a SAS version of the dataset and the SAS programs that generated the SAS-formatted version;
- SPSS user files including a SPSS version of the dataset and the SAS programs that generated the SPSS-formatted version; and
- Information files including several in Adobe Acrobat format, metadata files that document the data file (provided both in plain text file for reading, and in a more restricted format for ease of processing with a computer program), and a text file describing the content of the CD-ROM.

ORDERING TABLES

Access to the full detail from the survey (including data items deleted from the CURF) is only available through tables produced by the ABS. Requirements for these tables should be discussed with the Contact Officer.

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

The CURF is released in accordance with a Ministerial Determination (Clause 7, Statutory Rules 1983, No. 19) in pursuance of section 13 of the *Census and Statistics Act 1905*. As required by the Determination, the CURF has been designed so that the information on the file is not likely to enable the identification of the particular person or organisation to which it relates.

CURF purchasers are required to sign a binding Undertaking to abide by the legislative restrictions on use. The Australian Statistician's approval is required for each release of the CURF. Clause 7 of the Determination requires the purchaser of the file to undertake that in using the data:

- $\,\blacksquare\,$  no attempt will be made to identify particular persons or organisations.
- the information will be used only for statistical purposes.

## CONDITIONS OF RELEASE continued

- no attempt will be made to match the information with any other unit level list of persons or organisations.
- the information will not be disclosed, either directly or indirectly, to any other person or organisation.
- a register will be maintained of all persons who have access to the information, and this will be provided to the ABS on request.
- the information will be returned to the ABS when it is no longer required.
- the ABS will be allowed access to the necessary documents and information for the purpose of conducting a compliance audit.
- if the signatory to the undertaking changes or if the Department/authority/organisation is no longer responsible for the custody of the information, a new undertaking is signed or all copies of the information are returned to the ABS, within three months.

Use of the data for statistical purposes means use, by persons covered by the Undertaking, to produce information of a statistical nature. Examples of statistical purposes are:

- manipulation of the data to produce means, correlations or other descriptive or summary measures.
- estimation of population characteristics from sample data.
- use of data as input to mathematical models or for other types of analysis (e.g. factor analysis).
- providing graphical or pictorial representations of the characteristics of the population or subsets of the population.

Additionally, there are strict Licence Conditions which apply to the use of the CURF.

Use of the data for unauthorised purposes may render the purchaser liable to severe penalties. Advice about the propriety of any particular intended use of the data is available from the Contact Officer.

Under no circumstances may data in the form of unit records be disclosed by the purchaser to any other person or organisation.

The CURF is not available to overseas customers.

#### SECONDARY PROVIDERS

The term 'secondary provider' applies to any person or organisation who obtains data from the ABS and then disseminates products to a third party where the major component of such products is statistical data obtained from the ABS. Persons or organisations preparing consultant or research reports that rely on ABS data are not usually regarded as secondary providers where research and analysis are the major components of the reports.

PRICE

The price for the 2001 SETIT CURF, as at August 2002, is \$8,000, including freight and handling charges.

PRICE continued While the utmost care is taken in handling each CURF, deterioration may occur between

the time of copying and receipt of the file. Accordingly, if the CD-ROM is unreadable on receipt and this is reported to the ABS within 30 days of receipt, it will be replaced free

of charge.
