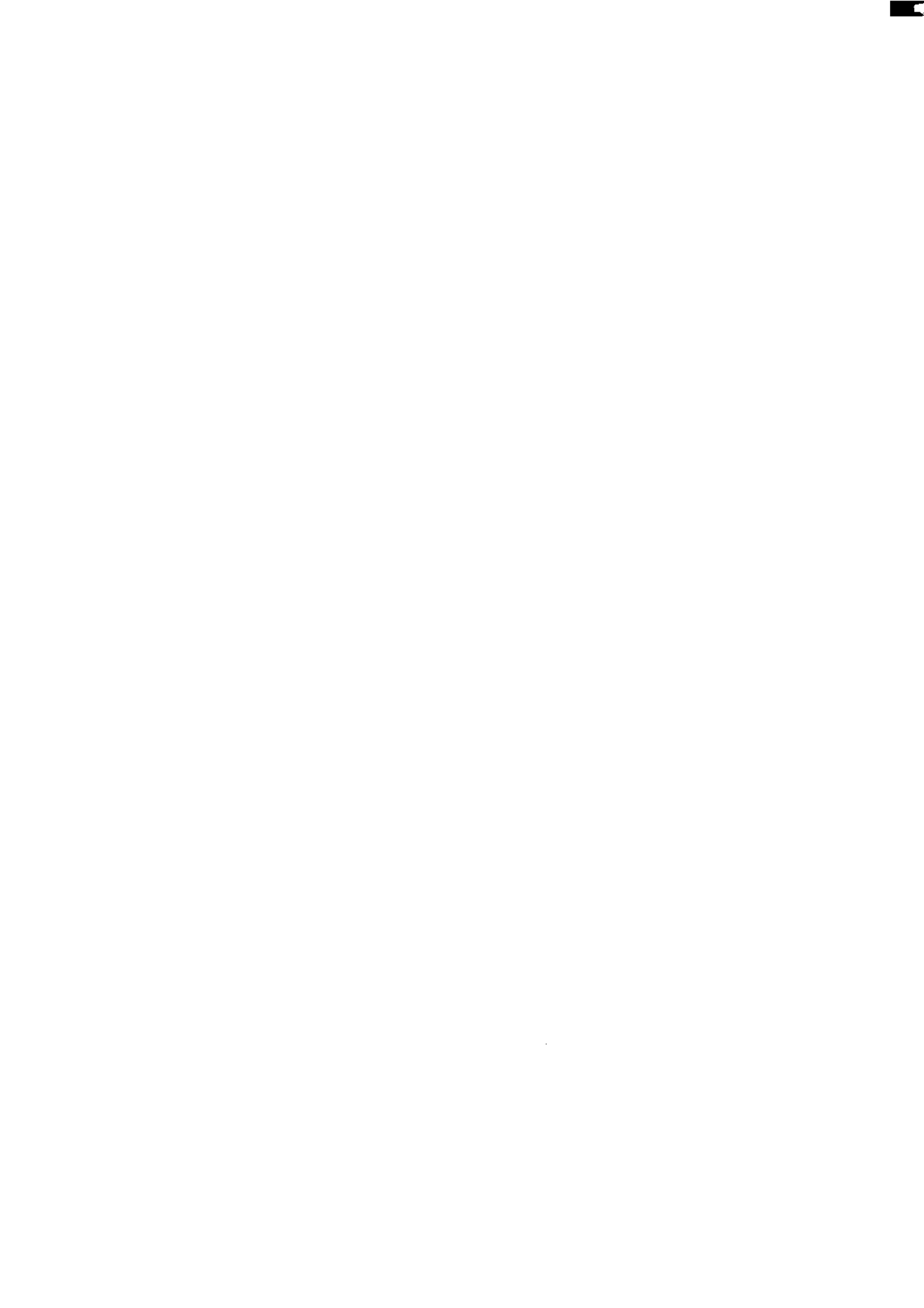

## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

### Value of building activity at average 1989-90 prices, seasonally adjusted, September quarter 1993

Changes in the value of building activity in the September quarter 1993 compared with the previous quarter and a year previously are summarised below (seasonally adjusted, at average 1989-90 prices):

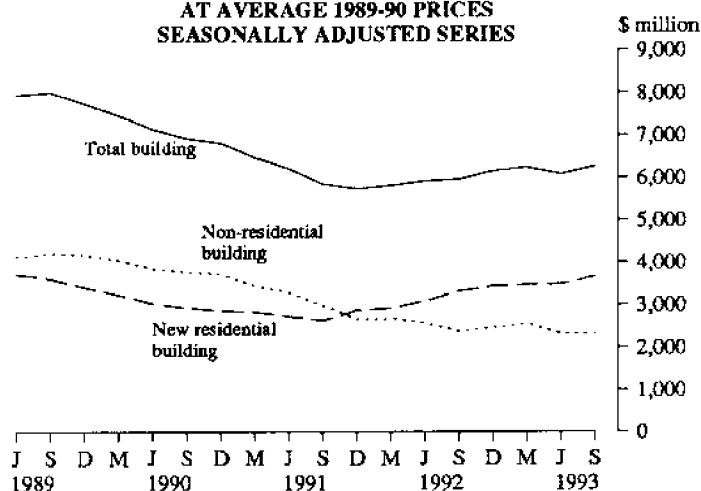

The value of total *building work done* in the September quarter 1993 increased by 3.1 per cent when compared with the June quarter 1993. An increase of 5.3 per cent in the value of new residential work done more than offset small decreases in the value of non-residential building work done (-0.3%) and the value of work done on alterations and additions to residential buildings (-0.5%). The value of work done on new residential building has in-

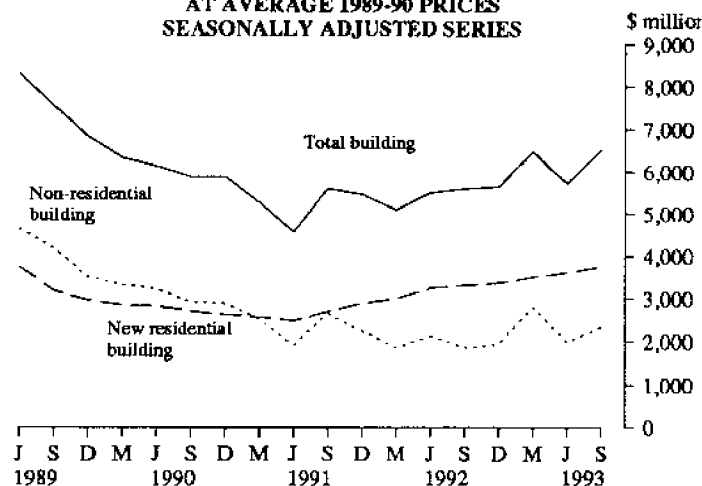
creased in each successive quarter since the September quarter 1991 and was 10.6 per cent above the level of activity in the September quarter 1992. Work done on new residential building represented 55.9 per cent of total building work done, the highest this proportion has been since the March quarter 1977.

The value of total *building work commenced* in the September quarter 1993 increased by 13.8 per cent over the June quarter 1993 estimate, to its highest level since the December quarter 1989. The value of new residential building work commenced, which has been rising continuously for more than two years, rose a further 4.3 per cent in the September quarter 1993 and is now less than 3 per cent below the previous quarterly peak in new residential building commencements in the March quarter 1989. The value of new house commencements and new other residential (flats, townhouses, apartments, etc.) commencements rose by 6.9 per cent and 0.6 per cent respectively in the September quarter 1993. In the September quarter 1993, the value of non-residential building commenced rose by 17.8 per cent over the June quarter 1993 estimate and was 25.4 per cent above the level recorded twelve months ago. The value of work commenced on alterations and additions to residential buildings in the September quarter 1993, increased by 3.0 per cent over the June quarter 1993 estimate.

### Value of building activity at current prices (original terms)

In **original terms**, there was \$6,447.2m of building work done in the September quarter 1993, 58 per cent on new residential building, 33 per cent on non-residential building with the remaining 9 per cent of work done on alterations and additions to residential buildings. Of the \$3,749.9m worth of work done on new residential building, \$883.4m (or nearly one quarter) was spent on the construction of medium density type developments. The \$2,133.3m worth of non-residential work undertaken during the September quarter was a slight increase on the previous two quarters, mostly as a result of increased work in the shops category.

There was \$6,255.3m worth of building work commenced in the September quarter 1993, 62 per cent of it on new residential building. Of building work commenced in the September quarter, 90 per cent was by the private sector, the highest proportion of quarterly commencements since the September quarter 1988.

The total value of *building work under construction* at the end of the September quarter 1993 was \$17,120.7m, 4.5 per cent below the June quarter 1993 estimate of \$17,919.9m and at its lowest level since the March quarter 1987. The value of non-residential work under construction at the end of the September quarter 1993 was \$8,775.6m, the lowest quarterly estimate since the September quarter 1985.

The value of non-residential building work under construction, which has been falling continuously since the June quarter 1990, fell a further 11.7 per cent in the September quarter 1993, to its lowest level since the September quarter 1985. The value of non-residential building work completed has exceeded the value of non-residential building work commenced in each quarter since the September quarter 1989.

### Dwelling unit commencements and completions

In **seasonally adjusted terms**, there were 44,256 dwelling units commenced in the September quarter 1993, an increase of 4.7 per cent over the June quarter 1993 estimate of 42,270, and 12.8 per cent above the September quarter 1992 estimate. The September quarter 1993 estimate of 44,256 is the highest quarterly estimate recorded since the December quarter 1988 (44,792), the previous peak in quarterly dwelling unit commencements. Private sector house commencements rose by 6.6 per cent to 30,835 in the September quarter 1993 and is the highest quarterly estimate recorded since the June quarter 1989 (31,407).

There were 42,163 dwelling units completed in the September quarter 1993, an increase of 4.6 per cent over the June quarter 1993 estimate of 40,296. This was the highest recorded estimate since the September quarter 1989 and the second highest quarterly estimate since the series began in 1965.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED SERIES

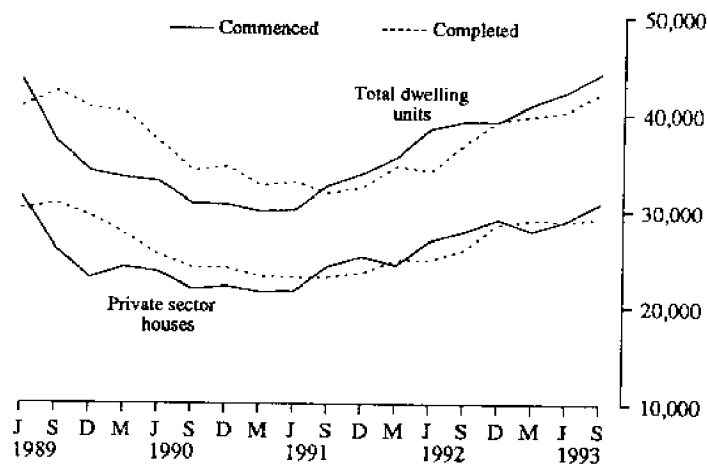

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### Introduction

This publication contains detailed results from the quarterly Building Activity Survey.

2. The statistics were compiled on the basis of returns collected from builders and other individuals and organisations engaged in building activity. The quarterly survey consists of two components:

(a) A sample survey of private sector jobs involving new house construction or alterations and additions valued at \$10,000 or more to houses;

(b) A complete enumeration of jobs involving construction of new residential buildings other than private sector houses, all alterations and additions to residential buildings (other than private sector houses) with an approval value of \$10,000 or more, and all non-residential building jobs with an approval value of \$50,000 or more.

3. From the September quarter 1990, only non-residential building jobs (both new and alterations and additions) with an approval value of \$50,000 (previously \$30,000) or more are included in the survey.

4. The use of sample survey techniques in the Building Activity Survey means that reliable estimates of private sector house building activity, including alterations and additions to houses are generally only available at the State/Territory and Australia levels. However, dwelling unit commencement data for regions below State/Territory level are shown in the monthly series of dwelling unit commencements compiled by the ABS. Data from this series, unlike that compiled from the Building Activity Survey, are based on information reported by local and other government authorities.

### Scope and coverage

5. The statistics relate to *building* activity which includes construction of new buildings and alterations and additions to existing buildings. Construction activity not defined as building (e.g. construction of roads, bridges, railways, earthworks, etc.) is excluded.

6. Building jobs included in each quarter in the Building Activity Survey comprise those jobs selected in previous quarters which have not been completed (or commenced) by the end of the previous quarter and those jobs newly selected in the current quarter. The population list from which jobs are selected for inclusion comprises all approved building jobs which were notified to the ABS (refer paragraph 2) up to but not including the last month of the reference quarter (i.e. up to the end of August in respect of the September quarter survey). This introduces a lag to the statistics in respect of those jobs notified and commenced in the last month of the reference quarter (i.e. for the month of September in respect of the September quarter survey). For example, jobs which were notified as approved in the month of June and which actually commenced in that month are shown as commencements in

the September quarter. Similarly, building jobs which were notified in the month of September and which actually commenced in that month are shown as commencements in the December quarter.

### Definitions

7. A *building* is defined as a rigid, fixed and permanent structure which has a roof. Its intended purpose is primarily to house people, plant, machinery, vehicles, goods or livestock. An integral feature of a building's design, to satisfy its intended use, is the provision for regular access by persons.

8. A *dwelling unit* is defined as a self-contained suite of rooms, including cooking and bathing facilities and intended for *long term* residential use. Units (whether self-contained or not) within buildings offering institutional care, such as hospitals, or temporary accommodation such as motels, hostels and holiday apartments, are not defined as dwelling units. The value of units of this type is included in the appropriate category of non-residential building.

9. A *residential building* is defined as a building predominantly consisting of one or more dwelling units. Residential buildings can be either *houses* or *other residential buildings*:

(a) A *house* is defined as a detached building predominantly used for long term residential purposes and consisting of only one dwelling unit. Thus, detached 'granny flats' and detached dwelling units (such as caretakers' residences) associated with non-residential buildings are defined as houses for the purpose of these statistics;

(b) An *other residential building* is defined as a building which is predominantly used for long term residential purposes and which contains (or has attached to it) more than one dwelling unit (e.g. includes townhouses, duplexes, apartment buildings, etc.).

10. The number of dwelling units created by alterations and additions to existing buildings, and through the construction of new non-residential buildings, is not included in the tables but is shown as a footnote to Table 1.

11. *Commenced*. A building is defined as commenced when the first physical building activity has been performed on site in the form of materials fixed in place and/or labour expended (this includes site preparation but excludes delivery of building materials, the drawing of plans and specifications and the construction of non-building infrastructures, such as roads).

12. *Under construction*. A building is regarded as being under construction at the end of a period if it has been commenced but has not been completed, and work on it has not been abandoned.

13. *Completed.* A building is defined as completed when building activity has progressed to the stage where the building can fulfil its intended function. In practice, the ABS regards buildings as completed when notified as such by respondents to the survey.

#### Valuation of building jobs

14. The value series in this publication are derived from estimates reported on survey returns as follows:

- (a) *Value of building commenced or under construction* represents the anticipated completion value based, where practicable, on estimated market or contract price of building jobs excluding the value of land and landscaping. Site preparation costs are included. Where jobs proceed over several quarters the anticipated completion value reported on the return for the first (commencement) quarter may be amended on returns for subsequent (under construction) quarters as the job nears completion;
- (b) *Value of building completed* represents the actual completion value based, where practicable, on the market or contract price of jobs including site preparation costs but excluding the value of land and landscaping.
- (c) *Value of building work done during the period* represents the estimated value of building work actually carried out during the quarter on jobs which have commenced;
- (d) *Value of building work yet to be done* represents the difference between the anticipated completion value and the estimated value of work done on jobs up to the end of the period.

#### Building classification

15. *Ownership.* The ownership of a building is classified as either *public sector* or *private sector* according to the sector of the intended owner of the completed building as evident at the time of approval. Residential buildings being constructed by private sector builders under government housing authority schemes whereby the authority has contracted, or intends to contract, to purchase the buildings on or before completion, are classified as public sector.

16. *Builder type.* Houses are classified according to the type of builder as follows:

- (a) *Contractor-built houses.* Those constructed by a private recognised building contractor, either under contract, or in anticipation of sale or rental;
- (b) *Houses built by other than contract builders.* Those constructed by an owner (other than a recognised building contractor) or under his direction, without the services of a single contractor responsible for the whole job. Houses built by businesses (other than recognised building contractors) and public sector organisations are also included in this category.

17. *Functional classification of buildings.* A building is classified according to its intended major function. Hence a building which is ancillary to other buildings or forms a part of a group of related buildings is classified to the function of the building and not to the function of the group as a whole. An example of this can be seen in the treatment of building work approved for a factory complex. In this case a detached administration building would be classified to Offices, a detached cafeteria building to Shops, while factory buildings would be classified to Factories. An exception to this rule is the treatment of group accommodation buildings where, for example, a student accommodation building on a university campus would be classified to Educational.

18. Example of the types of individual buildings jobs included under each main functional heading are shown in the following lists:

- (a) *Houses.* Includes 'cottages', 'bungalows', detached caretakers'/managers' cottages, rectories;
- (b) *Other residential buildings.* Includes blocks of flats, home units, attached townhouses, villa units, terrace houses, semi-detached houses, maisonettes;
- (c) *Hotels, etc.* Includes motels, hostels, boarding houses, guest houses, holiday apartment buildings;
- (d) *Shops.* Includes retail shops, restaurants, cafes, taverns, dry cleaners, laundromats, hair salons, shopping arcades;
- (e) *Factories.* Includes paper mills, oil refinery buildings, brickworks, foundries, power-houses, manufacturing laboratories, workshops as part of a manufacturing process;
- (f) *Offices.* Includes banks, post offices, council chambers, head and regional offices;
- (g) *Other business premises.* Includes warehouses, storage depots, services stations, transport depots and terminals, electricity sub-station buildings, pumping station buildings, telephone exchanges, mail sorting centres, broadcasting stations, film studios;
- (h) *Educational.* Includes schools, colleges, kindergartens, libraries, museums, art galleries, research and teaching laboratories, theological colleges;
- (i) *Religious.* Includes churches, chapels, temples;
- (j) *Health.* Includes hospitals, nursing homes, surgeries, clinics, medical centres;
- (k) *Entertainment and recreational.* Includes clubs, theatres, cinemas, public halls, gymnasiums, grandstands, squash courts, sports and recreation centres;
- (l) *Miscellaneous.* Includes law courts, homes for the aged (where medical care is not provided as a nor-

mal service), orphanages, gaols, barracks, mine buildings, glass houses, livestock sheds, shearing sheds, fruit and skin drying sheds, public toilets, and ambulance, fire and police stations.

#### Reliability of the estimates

19. Since the figures for private sector house building activity (including alterations and additions) are derived from information obtained from a sample of approved building jobs they are subject to sampling error; that is, they may differ from the figures that would have been obtained if information for all approved jobs for the relevant period had been included in the survey. A measure of the likely difference is given by the relative standard error of each estimate. There are about two chances in three that a sample estimate will differ by less than one standard error from the figure that would have been obtained if all approved jobs had been included, and about nineteen chances in twenty that the difference will be less than two standard errors. Relative standard errors of the estimates are shown in Tables 23 and 24.

20. An example of the use of standard errors is as follows: If the number of new private sector houses commenced is 25,000 and the associated standard error is 1.5 per cent, there are about two chances in three that the value which would have been derived if information had been obtained about all approved private sector house hobs would have been within the range 24,625 to 25,375 and about nineteen chances in twenty that the value would have been within the range 24,250 to 25,750.

21. The imprecision due to sampling variability, which is measured by the relative standard error, should not be confused with inaccuracies that may occur because of inadequacies in the source of building approval information, imperfections in reporting by respondents, and errors made in the coding and processing of data. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to as non-sampling error, and may occur in any enumeration whether it be a full count or only a sample. Every effort is made to reduce the non-sampling error to a minimum by the careful design of questionnaires, efforts to obtain responses for all selected jobs, and efficient operating procedures.

#### Seasonal adjustment

22. Seasonally adjusted building statistics are shown in Tables 4 and 5. In the seasonally adjusted series, account has been taken of normal seasonal factors and the effect of movement in the date of Easter which may, in successive years, affect figures for different quarters. Details regarding the methods used in seasonally adjusting the series are available on request.

23. Since seasonally adjusted statistics reflect both irregular and trend movements, an upward or downward movement in a seasonally adjusted series does not necessarily indicate a change of trend. Particular care should therefore be taken in interpreting individual quarter to quarter movements. Each of the component series shown has been seasonally adjusted independently. As a consequence, while the unadjusted components in the original

series shown add to the totals, the adjusted components may not add to the adjusted totals. Further, the difference between independently seasonally adjusted series does not necessarily produce series which are optimal or even adequate adjustments of the similarly derived original series. Thus the figures which can be derived by subtracting seasonally adjusted private sector dwelling units from the seasonally adjusted total should not be used to represent seasonally adjusted public sector dwelling units.

#### Estimates at constant prices

24. Estimates of the value of commencements and work done at average 1989-90 prices are presented in original terms for each State and Territory, and in original and seasonally adjusted terms for Australia.

25. Constant price estimates measure changes in value after the direct effects of price changes have been eliminated. The deflators used to revalue the current price estimates in this publication are derived from the same price data underlying the deflators compiled for the dwellings and non-dwelling construction components of the national accounts aggregate 'Gross fixed capital expenditure'.

26. Estimates at constant prices are subject to a number of approximations and assumptions. Further information on the nature and concepts of constant price estimates is contained in Chapter 4 of *Australia National Accounts: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (5216.0).

27. The factors used to seasonally adjust the constant price series are identical to those used to adjust the corresponding current price series.

#### Unpublished data and related publications

28. The ABS can also make available certain building approvals and activity data which are not published. Where it is not practicable to provide the required information by telephone, data can be provided in the following forms: microfiche, photocopy, computer print-out, floppy disk and clerically extracted tabulation.
