This year the action begins. I'm delighted with the way CensusAtSchool is progressing. The web pages (www.abs.gov.au) provide an invaluable resource for schools. Students will be able to engage with real data about themselves and that they are part of and improve their statistical skills in the process. Your students can now go online and complete a CensusAtSchool Questionnaire.

Already over 2100 schools have registered to participate. I'm pleased to say that there is strong representation from all states and territories. I look forward to seeing many more schools become involved. The more schools that are involved the richer the database will be for students to use when the data usage phase begins on 11 July 2006.

I would like to take this opportunity to restate the aim of CensusAtSchool, our school project for the 2006 Census of Population and Housing, in August this year. CensusAtSchool is a facility, provided by ABS, to enable schools to improve the statistical literacy of their students. Statistical literacy is the ability to interpret and critically evaluate data and information. It is a very important life skill. It assists students in understanding the world around them and in making sensible, informed decisions when they reach adulthood.
