The CensusAtSchool project will result in a unique student centered learning opportunity. Over the past three months we have been busy testing all areas of the web site with teachers and developing materials to communicate the project clearly to our audience.

The CensusAtSchool team conducted useability testing with teachers throughout May this year. This testing provided valuable feedback about what teachers require from CensusAtSchool and how the web site will be used by teachers and students in the classroom. Overall, feedback was positive and provided some constructive insights about the web site and accompanying materials.

Promotional activities have also been a focus over the past three months, with materials soon to go to print. We are well on track to developing an innovative and exciting resource for schools.
