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South Australia has an area of 985,335 square kilometres. The estimated population at June 2005 was 1,542,033. The Gross State Product of South Australia was \$58,186m in 2004–05, which was 6.8% of Australia's Gross Domestic Product.

Significant elements of the South Australian economy are agriculture and horticulture (including wine) products, machinery, mineral resources, aquaculture and fisheries. This brochure provides a general overview of South Australia.
