## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

\*\*\*\*\*

### POPULATION GROWTH

The estimated resident population (preliminary) of Victoria at 30 June 1997 was 4,605,150, an increase of 44,990 (1.0%) since 30 June 1996. This compares with an average annual growth from 1991 to 1996 of 0.6%.

### MELBOURNE STATISTICAL DIVISION

The Melbourne Statistical Division (MSD) had an estimated resident population (preliminary) at 30 June 1997 of 3,321,670, an increase of 38,390 (1.2%) since June 1996, compared with an average annual growth of 0.8% from 1991 to 1996.

#### Highest Growth

The City of Melbourne has overtaken most of the rapidly growing outer areas of the Melbourne Statistical Division to have a growth rate of 6.1% for the year to 30 June 1997. Only the City of Melton on the western fringe of Melbourne, with 6.7% growth, had higher growth. The south-eastern fringe, which had the highest growth rates in the previous few years no longer dominated. The City of Casey, which had the highest growth in the state for the period 1991 to 1996, had the third highest growth with 3.1% in the period 1996 to 1997. This was followed by the cities of Wyndham (2.3%) in the south-west and Hume (2.1%) in the north.

#### Least Growth

No local government area (LGA) in the MSD showed a decline in population in the period June 1996 to June 1997, although only 0.1% growth was recorded in the cities of Maribyrnong and Monash. Other LGAs with little growth were in other well established areas and included the cities of Moreland (0.2%), Greater Dandenong (0.3%) and Manningham (0.4%).

### BALANCE OF VICTORIA

Outside the MSD, Victoria had an estimated resident population at 30 June 1997 of 1,283,480, an increase of 6,610 (0.5%) from June 1996, compared with an average growth of 0.2% from 1991 to 1996.

### INTRODUCTION

**1** This publication contains, for each Statistical Local Area (SLA), Statistical Division (SD), and Statistical Subdivision (SSD) in Victoria, and Local Government Area (LGA), the estimated resident population at 30 June 1986, 1991, 1996 and preliminary estimates for 30 June 1997, average annual growth rates from 1986 to 1991 and 1991 to 1996, and growth rates from 1996 to 1997.

### METHODOLOGY

**2** The estimated resident population is compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (Cat no. 3216.0).

**3** The estimated resident population as at 30 June for 1986, 1991 and 1996 for each SLA has been calculated by adjusting usual residence census counts for under-enumeration and adding the number of residents temporarily overseas at Census date. The population at 30 June was then obtained by adjusting for births and deaths between 30 June and Census date.

**4** For intercensal years, the estimated resident population for each SLA (at 30 June) is calculated using a linear regression model. The model establishes a mathematical relationship between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which the required data are available, i.e. 1991 to 1996. This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each SLA since the date of the last census, based on the change in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables used are occupied dwellings and Medicare enrolments.

**5** Other indicators of resident population movement have also been used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. These include the numbers of persons resident in prisons.

### AUSTRALIAN STANDARD GEOGRAPHICAL CLASSIFICATION

**6** The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) Edition 2.6* (Cat. no. 1216.0). Readers are urged to familiarise themselves with this publication for a full description of the boundary changes.

### CHANGES TO STATISTICAL BOUNDARIES

**7** The boundaries of SLAs used in determining the population are those in existence at 30 June 1996. The population estimates for previous years have been adjusted where appropriate so that they reflect the population changes for each area had the June 1996 boundaries existed then.

**8** In the period from May 1993 to February 1995 the Victorian Government undertook a series of amalgamations of Local Government Areas (LGAs). A special information paper, *Victorian Local Government Amalgamations 1994-95: Changes to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification* (Cat. no. 1257.0) is available. This paper details the new classifications used in Victoria following the boundary changes and is recommended for use in conjunction with this publication.

### ROUNDING OF FIGURES

**9** Population estimates have been published without rounding in order that year to year fluctuations in the estimates for SLAs can be shown more accurately. It should not be implied that the estimates are accurate to the degree shown.

### AVERAGE ANNUAL GROWTH RATE

**10** The average annual rates of population growth from 1991 to 1996 in this publication have been calculated by the following formula and then expressed as a percentage:

$$r = (P_{96} / P_{91})^{1/5} - 1$$

where  $P_{96}$  and  $P_{91}$  are the estimated resident population for 1996 and 1991 respectively and  $r$  represents a compound interest annual rate of growth throughout the period. This reflects an average rate between 1991 and 1996 and not between the individual intercensal years.

### AGE AND SEX DATA BY SLA

**11** Estimated resident populations classified by age and sex by SLA for 30 June 1986-1996 are available on floppy disk. (Cat. no. 3227.2). Order forms can be obtained from the Victorian Office by contacting the Bookshop on (03) 9615 7000. Data for each of 1988-1996 are also available in a hard copy publication (Cat. no. 3235.2 for 1996, Cat. no. 3207.2 for previous years).

**12** Estimated resident populations classified by age and sex by SLA for 30 June 1997 will be available in approximately July 1998. These data will supplant the preliminary data in this publication.
