Note: As advised in paragraph 10.10 of the Information Paper *Implementation of Revised International Standards in the Australian National Accounts* (5251.0), the usual annual publication *Australian National Accounts: National Income, Expenditure and Product* (5204.0) will not be published for reference period 1996-97. This decision was taken in order to give priority to work on implementing the SNA93 changes in Australia's national accounts and to the integration of the national income, expenditure and product (NIEP) accounts with the Input-Output tables. Also, as a consequence of changes to the compilation methodology associated with the integration of the NIEP accounts and the Input-Output tables, future annual publications will be consistent with the June quarter NIEP accounts each year, rather than the December quarter accounts. Consequently, the 1996-97 issue of 5204.0 would have had a shorter shelf life than normal.

As an interim measure for this year only, all of the summary tables and most of the supplementary tables from 5204.0 have been compiled and are being made available through this special data service (5204.0.40.002). These tables are consistent with the December quarter 1997 NIEP accounts. Data from these tables will also be available on PC AUSSTATS. Explanatory notes are available in the 1995-96 issue of 5204.0, or on request.

It is planned to publish the 1997-98 issue of 5204.0 on an SNA93 basis in February 1999. The 1998-99 issue is scheduled for release in November 1999, and subsequent issues will be released each November.
