INTRODUCTION

For the four quarters of 2000, the scope of the Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA) has been expanded. Over this period the following accommodation sectors will be covered:

- hotels, motels, guest houses and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms;
- holiday flats, units and houses operated by owners, managers or real estate agents who
 have sole letting rights to at least 15 flats, units or houses for short term letting;
- caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites, cabins, etc; and
- visitor hostels with 25 or more bed spaces.

DATA NOTES

ABS statistical series are being impacted to varying degrees as a result of The New Tax System (TNTS), introduced in Australia from 1 July 2000. TNTS included the removal of Wholesale Sales Tax and the introduction of a Goods and Services Tax (GST), and as a result, a wide range of ABS data series will reflect significant immediate and subsequent impacts.

In this publication, and in future issues, accommodation takings will be on a GST inclusive basis.

HISTORICAL COMPARISONS Statistics for hotels, motels, guest houses, serviced apartments, caravan parks and visitor hostels are presented for the last 6 quarters to allow for comparison over time. However, data for holiday flats, units and houses are compared with the corresponding period in 1997.

INTRODUCTION

SCOPE

DEFINITIONS OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS

- **1** This data service contains data for Northern Territory from the ABS quarterly Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA). The STA is a mailout collection that completely enumerates all in-scope accommodation establishments. Survey results for all States and Territories and Australia are published in *Tourist Accommodation*, *Australia* (Cat. no. 8635.0)
- **2** From the March quarter 1998, the scope and collection strategy for the STA was changed to include only significant accommodation establishments. Data series presented in this publication which relate to the 1997 calendar year have been recompiled on the basis of the new scope.
- **3** On a quarterly basis, the STA includes hotels, motels, guest houses and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms.
- **4** Every third year beginning with 2000, the STA has been expanded to also include:
- holiday flats, units and houses of letting entities with 15 or more rooms or units;
- caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites;
- visitor hostels with 25 or more beds spaces.
- **5** The short-term non-residential accommodation which is in scope of this survey is accommodation which is not let out on a lease basis, and which is let out to guests who would generally, although not necessarily, stay for periods of less than two months.
- **6** Some establishments included in the survey such as caravan parks also provide long-term residential accommodation. For hotels, motels and guest houses, the amount of such activity is considered to be insignificant and is included in the data presented in this publication. For serviced apartments, only short-term non-residential accommodation is included.
- **7** The STA includes the following categories of establishments which provide predominantly short-term non-residential accommodation to the general public:
- hotels and resorts with facilities establishments with 15 or more rooms which are licensed to operate a public bar and which provide accommodation on a room/suite basis, with a bath/shower and toilet in most guest rooms, but which do not have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave) in most guest rooms;
- motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities establishments with 15 or more rooms which are not licensed to operate a public bar, and which provide accommodation on a room/suite basis, with a bath/shower and toilet in most guest rooms, but which do not have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave) in most guest rooms;
- serviced apartments establishments with 15 or more units which mostly comprise self-contained units at the same location, and which are available on a unit/apartment basis to the general public for a minimum of one night; the units should have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave), refrigerator and bath/shower and toilet facilities; all bed linen and towels should be provided, and daily servicing (i.e. cleaning and bed making) must be available through the on-site management, although this service may not necessarily be used.

- holiday flats, units and houses (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time-share basis) which are operated by owners, managers or real estate agents who have sole letting rights to at least 15 flats, units or houses for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities. Data for holiday flats units or houses include short-term owner operation as well as paying guest occupation.
- caravan parks establishments with 40 or more powered sites and cabins, etc. which provide either short-term or long-term accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.
- visitor hostels establishments with 25 or more bed spaces which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.

CLASSIFICATION CHANGES

8 As a result of the separate classification of serviced apartments from the March quarter 1998, there have been several changes to definitions of accommodation units. Some units, which were formerly in categories such as hotels, motels or holiday flats, units and houses are now classified as serviced apartments. A small number of establishments which were previously classified as motels have been reclassified as holiday flats, units and houses and are therefore no longer in scope of the quarterly STA, except as described in paragraph 4.

COVERAGE

9 Coverage is comprehensive and from the September quarter 1999, has been obtained from the Australian Automobile Association accommodation guide, which is updated twice yearly. This is supplemented by notification of new tourism developments and their likely opening dates in selected guides, major tourism journals and periodicals and newspapers. Periodic comparison to lists of accommodation establishments provided by the various Tourism Commissions and Industry Associations is also undertaken.

DATA QUALITY

- **10** The survey does not have a sample component and the data are not subject to sampling variability. However, other inaccuracies collectively referred to as non-sampling error may affect the data. These non-sampling errors may arise from a number of sources, including:
- errors in the reporting of data by respondents;
- errors in the process of capturing data;
- estimation for missing data; and
- definition and classification errors.

Every effort has been made to reduce non-sampling error to a minimum by careful design and testing of questionnaires, and efficient operating procedures and systems used to compile statistics.

- **11** The September quarter 2000 response rates were:
- 96% licensed hotels, motels and guest houses, serviced apartments.
- 100% holiday flats, units and houses.
- 87% caravan parks.
- 83% visitor hostels.

REGIONAL DATA

12 Survey results are aggregated to Tourism Regions as defined by relevant State and Territory Tourist Commissions or equivalent organisations. Details of the composition of Tourism Regions, including a map, follow. Small geographic area data presented in this data service have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 1999 (Effective from 1 July 1999).

ANNUAL CAPACITY DATA

- **13** ABS releases counts of accommodation establishments and their capacity as at the end of December each year in respect of the pre-1998 scope of the survey (but recognising serviced apartments separately) as follows:
- hotels, motels and guest houses and serviced apartments with facilities and having five or more rooms;
- holiday flats, units and houses (other than those included with serviced apartments) which are operated by owners, managers or real estate agents who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses for short term letting;
- all caravan parks regardless of size; and
- all visitor hostels regardless of size.
- **14** As a result of classification changes applied from March quarter 1998 onward, data will not be comparable with that previously published for particular accommodation types.
- **15** These counts are published annually in a quarterly issue of Tourism Indicators, Australia (Cat. no. 8634.0). Counts in respect of December 1999 were published in the June quarter 2000 edition of that publication.

UNPUBLISHED STATISTICS

16 The ABS may make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics, including statistics for past quarters and for specific areas and more detailed information for specific data items. For example, detailed employment statistics showing the number of full-time, part-time or casual employees august be available.

Bed spaces

Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Cots are excluded.

Capacity

Capacity in terms of *Guest rooms, serviced apartment units, visitor bostel bed spaces, holiday units* or *caravan park sites* is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period. Capacity closed temporarily for seasonal reasons is included.

Caravan park sites

Includes On-site vans, Other powered sites, Unpowered sites and Cabins, etc.

Establishments

For hotels, motels and guest houses and serviced apartments, caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.

Guest arrivals

The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment during the survey period.

Guest rooms

The maximum number of rooms available at each establishment during the survey period for accommodating short-term paying guests. Units and apartments within serviced apartments are treated as rooms in these survey results.

Letting entities

For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.

Long-term caravan parks

Caravan parks where the majority of paying guests occupied sites for periods of more than two months.

Occupancy

Occupancy in terms of *Room nights, Unit nights* or *Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, serviced apartment unit, holiday unit or caravan park site was occupied during the survey period.

Occupancy in terms of *Guest nights* refers to the total number of paying guests counted on each night they stayed at the accommodation establishment during the survey period.

Occupancy rates

Occupancy rates represent occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period, e.g. for the period

Room occupancy rate (%) = $\frac{Room \ nights \ occupied}{(Guest \ rooms) \times (No. \ of \ days \ in \ the \ period)} \times 100$

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

Other sites permanently

reserved

The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for two months or more of the survey period to tenants who

occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis.

Persons employed The total number of persons working at each accommodation establishment at

the end of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working

on other than accommodation activities).

The number of guest rooms/units available multiplied by the number of days for Room nights available

> which they were available during the survey period. For establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during this period, operating

periods only are included.

Caravan parks where the majority of paying guests occupy sites for periods of Short-term caravan parks

less than two months.

Sites occupied by long-term The total number of sites, etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests

who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.

guests Star grading The grading of hotels, motels and guest houses with facilities and serviced

> apartments based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication Accommodation Australia, or the individual State guides. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings

are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

From the September quarter 1999, some (very few) large establishments not star graded by the AAA have been allocated a star grade by the ABS for Survey of

Tourist Accommodation statistical tabulation purposes.

Takings from accommodation Gross revenue (including GST) from the provision of accommodation, including

> bed taxes. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation august not

necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated

during the month.


Unit lettings The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new

tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.
