## JUNE KEY POINTS

## TREND ESTIMATES

- The trend for total new motor vehicle registrations has risen this month by $2.3 \%$. Registrations of passenger vehicles in June 1998 rose by $2.6 \%$ and other vehicles rose by $1.0 \%$ compared with last month.


## TAKE CARE

Trend estimates are revised as new monthly data become available.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED ESTIMATES

- Seasonally adjusted total new motor vehicle registrations for June 1998 increased by $16.9 \%$ compared with last month. Passenger vehicle registrations increased by $17.9 \%$ to reach the highest level ever.


## ORIGINAL ESTIMATES

- Total registrations of new motor vehicles for June 1998 increased by 35.4\% compared with May 1998. June 1998 registrations are the highest level ever reported. Passenger vehicles rose by $35.1 \%$ and other vehicles rose by $36.9 \%$. High registrations in June can be mainly attributed to sales promotions and end of financial year discounting.

Table 4 now presents the top 7 passenger vehicle makes in order of total registrations. Within each make the top 3 models are shown.

The most recent trend estimates are likely to be revised when new seasonally adjusted estimates become available.

The graph below presents the effect of two possible scenarios on the previous trend estimates:

1 The July seasonally adjusted estimate for total vehicle registrations is higher than the June seasonally adjusted estimate by $4.5 \%$.

2 The July seasonally adjusted estimate for total vehicle registrations is lower than the June seasonally adjusted estimate by $-4.5 \%$.

The percentage change of $4.5 \%$ was chosen because the average absolute percentage change, based on the last 11 years, has been $4.5 \%$.

The trend has risen consecutively over the past 5 months. It is now $8.4 \%$ above the January 1998 low and $35.6 \%$ above the low recorded in October 1995.


Since the November 1996 low, the trend for other motor vehicle registrations has risen consecutively over the past 19 months. The current trend is still $9.2 \%$ below the October 1989 high despite the recent rise.


The trend for total new motor vehicle registrations has risen consecutively over the past 21 months. The current trend level is the highest ever reported.

## EXPLANATORYNOTES

INTRODUCTION

SCOPE AND COVERAGE

SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT

1 This publication presents monthly data for registrations of new motor vehicles.

2 The statistics in this publication use the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN), adopted by the State and Territory motor vehicle registration authorities. The information contained in the VIN allows more accurate classification of vehicles. In the case of some States, data processed using the VIN system are not strictly comparable with data processed prior to December 1990.

3 Motor vehicle registration statistics are obtained from State and Territory motor vehicle registration authorities. The statistics reflect information recorded in registration documents. With the exception of Queensland, the statistics do not depart significantly from actual registrations during the period. In the case of Queensland, a number of registrations processed in a month actually relate to vehicles registered prior to that month.
4 New motor vehicle registrations are obtained from New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland and Western Australia registration authorities on a weekly basis. Other registries provide data for each calendar month. The ABS processes the weekly registration data provided for the above-mentioned States and includes data for the relevant month in this publication. Data referring to the next month are withheld and included in the next month's publication. In some months, the ABS processes five weeks of data for the above States, while other months include four weeks of data. In months where five weeks of data are processed and depending on the actual pattern of registration processing, it is possible that there will be a greater number of registrations recorded because the carry forward from the previous month is likely to be greater than the carry over to the next month.

5 The scope of the statistics:

- includes:
passenger vehicles
light commercial vehicles
trucks
buses
motorcycles (note: not included in totals)
vehicles with diplomatic and consular plates
State and Commonwealth owned vehicles
- excludes:
vehicles belonging to the defence forces
recreation vehicles such as trail bikes and sand dune buggies (in those States where registration is required).

6 Seasonal adjustment is a means of removing the estimated effects of normal seasonal variation from the series so that the effects of other influences can be more clearly recognised.

7 Seasonal adjustment does not remove from the series the effect of irregular or non-seasonal influences (e.g. the introduction of new models, processing delays, industrial disputes).

## EXPLANATORYNOTES

SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT continued

8 Irregular influences that are highly volatile can make it difficult to interpret the series even after adjustment for seasonal variation.

9 Extreme care should be exercised in using the seasonally adjusted series for new motor vehicle registrations in Tasmania, the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory. The small numbers and volatile nature of these data makes reliable estimation of the seasonal pattern very difficult.

10 Seasonally adjusted series are calculated for the 'Passenger vehicles', 'Other vehicles' and 'Total vehicles' series for each State and Territory and are aggregated to obtain the total for Australia.

11 Seasonal adjustment factors are analysed and revised as necessary annually.
12 The smoothing of seasonally adjusted series to create trend estimates reduces the impact of the irregular component of the seasonally adjusted series. The trend estimates are derived by applying a 13-term Henderson-weighted moving average to the respective seasonally adjusted series. These trend series are used to analyse the underlying behaviour of the series over time.

13 While this smoothing technique enables trend estimates to be produced for the latest month, it does result in revisions to the trend estimates for the most recent months as data for subsequent months become available. Generally subsequent revisions become smaller and after three months, usually have a negligible impact on the series. Changes in the original data and re-estimation of seasonal factors may also lead to revisions to the trend.
