EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This bulletin contains results for Australia (excluding Northern Territory) of the quarterly survey of Tourist Accommodation Establishments. The period covered by the survey was the three months ended 31 March 1976. Results for previous quarters were published in the bulletins Tourist Accommodation – September Quarter 1975 and Tourist Accommodation – December Quarter 1975 (both Reference No. 11.48) which were released on 20 February 1976 and 2 April 1976 respectively. More detailed statistics for individual States will be published in separate bulletins to be released by the respective State offices of the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

Background

2. Census of **Tourist** Accommodation Establishments was conducted for the year ended 30 June 1974, to identify and measure the amount, type and location of tourist accommodation available throughout Australia. For statistics from the census, reference should be made to the bulletin Census of Tourist Accommodation Establishments, Australia and Australian Capital Territory, Year Ended 30 June 1974 (Reference No. 11.50) and also the separate bulletins released by the State Offices of the Bureau. To support these statistics it is useful to have a measure of the utilisation of this accommodation, which can adequately be judged from statistics on occupancy rates.

3. The Australian Bureau of Statistics has accordingly commenced regular quarterly Accommodation Surveys, in order to satisfy the needs of various Government Departments as well as private bodies, who are concerned with the development and promotion of tourism in Australia.

Tourist accommodation establishment

4. There is no generally accepted definition of a tourist accommodation establishment. For the purpose of the surveys, tourist accommodation establishments have been defined as: hotels, motels and guest houses, which provide short term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than two months) available to the general public and which provide breakfast.

Scope

The scope of the Surveys is identical to the 5. scope of the 1973-74 Tourist Accommodation Census except for the omission of caravan parks and holiday flats. Therefore all accommodation establishments (except caravan parks) in classes 9212 and 9213 of the Australian Standard Industrial Classification which reported in the Census or by separate communication that they provide accommodation to short term visitors are included in the Survey. As there had been no check on the scope since the 1973-74 Tourist Accommodation Census, additional questions were included on the March Quarter Survey form to confirm whether establishments were still within the scope of the Surveys. This check has resulted in a slight reduction in the number of establishments which are now considered to be within the scope of the Survey and a reclassification of some other establishments according to the facilities they provide.

Type of establishment

- 6. The various types of accommodation establishments have been regrouped in the Survey to represent three establishment categories as follows:
 - (i) Licensed hotel with facilities an establishment which provides tourist accommodation, is licensed to operate a public bar and provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms.
 - (ii) Licensed or unlicensed motel, private hotel or guest house with facilities an establishment which provides tourist accommodation and,

provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, but is not licensed to operate a public bar. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with meals.

(iii) Licensed hotel, private hotel or guest house without facilities — an establishment which provides tourist accommodation but which does not provide bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms.

Definitions

7. Number of establishments refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the Survey which operated during the three months ended 31 March 1976. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter.

Guest Rooms refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc. available for accommodating paying guests during the three months ended 31 March 1976.

Bed Spaces refers to the maximum number of guests that could be accommodated in beds normally in place at the accommodation establishment during the three months ended 31 March 1976. Three quarter beds were classified as single beds; double beds were counted as two bed spaces.

Room Occupancy Rate refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied to the number of guest rooms available expressed as a percentage.

Bed Occupancy Rate refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied to the number of bed spaces available expressed as a percentage.

Takings from Accommodation refers to revenue received from the provision of accommodation during the three months ended 31 March 1976. Where meals and accommodation are a combined charge an estimate of takings from meals was excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. In the case of some establishments, payments may be made in advance of, or may be received after the provision of accommodation to guests and therefore the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month.

Employment refers to the number of persons working at tourist accommodation establishments at 31 March 1976 and includes working proprietors or partners and salaried directors as well as employees on the payroll for the last pay period in March 1976. Employees absent on paid sick leave, holidays or long service leave are included while unpaid helpers and those who, during the whole of the last pay period, were stood down, or absent because of an industrial dispute are excluded.
