# **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

# Introduction

This bulletin contains results, for Australia and each State and Territory of the quarterly surveys of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the 3 months ended 30 June 1978.

#### Tourist accommodation establishment

2. There is no generally accepted definition of a tourist accommodation establishment, but for the purpose of the surveys, a tourist accommodation establishment has been defined as an establishment which provides accommodation of a predominantly short term nature (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public.

### Scope of the survey

- 3. The scope of the survey may vary from time to time depending upon the needs of users of the statistics and on the ABS resources available to undertake the surveys. The types of establishments currently included in the survey are:
  - (i) Licensed hotel with facilities A tourist accommodation establishment which is licensed to operate a public bar, provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, and has breakfast available for guests.

- (ii) Licensed or unlicensed motel, private hotel or guest house with facilities A tourist accommodation establishment which provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms and has breakfast available for guests but is not licensed to operate a public bar. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with meals.
- (iii) Caravan park A tourist accommodation establishment which provides powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

#### **Definitions**

4. Number of establishments refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the survey which operated during the survey period. Establishments comprising more than 1 type of accommodation activity referred to in paragraph 3 above (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as 2 separate establishments. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter because of seasonal reasons.

Guest rooms refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc. available for accommodating paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period.

Bed spaces refers to the maximum number of guests that could be accommodated in beds normally in place (excluding cots) at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period. Threequarter beds are classified as single beds; double beds are counted as 2 bed spaces.

Powered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.

Unpowered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply, which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

Cabins, flats, etc. refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units and villas available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

Total caravan park capacity refers to the maximum number of on-site vans, other powered sites, unpowered sites and cabins, flats, etc. available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

Room occupancy rate refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of guest rooms available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

Bed occupancy rate refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of bed spaces available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

Site occupancy rate refers to the proportion of sites occupied in caravan parks to the total caravan park capacity available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

Guest nights refers to the number of paying guests accommodated in caravan parks each night tallied for the survey period. In some cases it has been necessary to estimate this figure.

Takings from accommodation refers to revenue received from the provision of short term and long term

the tourist accommodation at accommodation establishment. Where meals and accommodation are a combined charge an estimate of takings from meals was excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. In the case of some establishments payments may be made in advance of, or may be received after the provision of accommodation to guests and therefore the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

Employment refers to the number of persons working at tourist accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) at the end of the quarter and includes working proprietors or partners and salaried directors as well as employees on the payroll for the last pay period of the quarter. Employees absent on paid sick leave, holidays or long service leave are included while unpaid helpers and those who, during the whole of the last pay period, were stood down, or absent because of an industrial dispute are excluded. For establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity, which have been treated as 2 separate establishments, the employment is allocated to the employee's predominant activity.

## Related publications

5. Publications for Australia, and each State and Territory, are released by the respective offices of the ABS. Past quarters tourist accommodation statistics are available in earlier publications commencing with the September quarter 1975. These and some unpublished statistics for certain small areas within States are available (e.g. local government areas or combinations of local government areas) upon request.

All publications produced by the ABS are listed in *Catalogue of Publications* (1101.0) which is available free of charge from any ABS office.
