MAIN FEATURES

From September quarter 1991 to September quarter 1992: HOTELS, MOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES

- Rooms available increased by 3.0 per cent overall to 165,128 although Northern Territory and Australian Capital Territory recorded small decreases.
- Room nights occupied increased by 2.9 per cent to 7.84m with all States and Territories except Tasmania and N.T. recording increases.
- Thus, the room occupancy rate overall decreased by 0.4 percentage points to 51.7 per cent. Only Queensland and A.C.T. recorded occupancy rate increases.
- Takings from accommodation increased by 2.0 per cent to \$620.9m. Average takings per room night occupied decreased from \$80 to \$79. The CPI rose by 0.8 per cent over this period.

CARAVAN PARKS (SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM)

- Sites available increased by 0.3 per cent to 287,182.
- Of the total September quarter 1992 capacity available, 48,705 sites etc. (17.0 per cent) were occupied by long-term residents, 40,766 sites (14.2 per cent) were permanently reserved but only casually occupied by their tenants and an average 32,655 sites (11.4 per cent) were occupied by other short-term guests.
- Accommodation takings rose by 6.6 per cent to \$98.8m.


HOLIDAY FLATS, UNITS AND HOUSES

- The number of units available for short term letting increased by 1.0 per cent to 33,232, while unit nights occupied at 1.64m were virtually unchanged.
- The unit occupancy rate consequently decreased from 54.4 per cent to 53.7 per cent. Accommodation takings increased by 1.4 per cent to \$92.6m.


VISITOR HOSTELS

- There were 24,411 bed spaces available in September quarter 1992 and 975,188 guest nights were sold. Accommodation takings were \$11.2m at an average \$12 per guest night.
- The bed occupancy rate increased from 42.4 per cent in September quarter 1991 to 43.7 per cent in September quarter 1992.



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains data, for Australia and each State and Territory, from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the three months ended 30 September 1992.

Scope and Coverage

- 2. Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:
- (a) Establishments providing predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than two months) to the general public. These include:
 - (i) Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities. Hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest-houses all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests.
 - (ii) Holiday flats, units and houses (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least 5 flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.
 - (iii) Visitor hostels which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.
- (b) Caravan parks providing either predominantly shortterm (i.e. for periods of less than two months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of two months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.
- 3. Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.
- 4. Establishments providing more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.

Definitions

5. Number of establishments. For hotels, motels etc., caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.

- 6. Number of letting entities. For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.
- 7. Capacity in terms of Guest rooms, Bed spaces, Holiday units or Caravan park sites etc. is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period. Capacity closed temporarily for seasonal reasons is included.
- 8. Bed spaces. Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Excludes cots.
- 9. Total caravan park capacity includes On-site vans, Other powered sites, Unpowered sites and Cabins, etc.
- 10. Room nights available. The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. Includes operating period only for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period.
- 11. Occupancy in terms of *Room nights*, *Unit nights* or *Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, holiday unit or caravan park site etc. was occupied during the survey period.

NOTE: From September quarter 1992, caravan park sites etc. permanently reserved for 2 months or more at the end of the survey period but only casually occupied by their tenants have been recorded continuously as Site Nights occupied irrespective of whether the tenants of individual sites were in residence on any particular night. (See also paragraph 14 below). Previously, usage of these sites was recorded as Site Nights occupied only when their tenants were in the park. Total site occupancy rates from September quarter 1992 are therefore not comparable with those from previous quarters.

- 12. Occupancy in terms of *Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.
- 13. Sites occupied by long-term guests. The total number of sites etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.
- 14. Other sites permanently reserved. The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for 2 months or more by the end of the survey period to tenants who only occupy the sites on a casual or sporadic basis. Separate data for this item are available only from September quarter 1992.
- 15. Occupancy rates represent occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period e.g.

Room occupancy rate (%) for the period =

Room nights occupied
(Guest rooms) x (No. of days in the period) x 100

16. Guest arrivals. The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment.

- 17. Unit lettings. The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.
- 18. Average length of stay is expressed in number of days and calculated:
- for hotels and motels etc. and visitor hostels, by dividing Guest nights by Guest arrivals; and
- (b) for holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing Unit nights occupied by Unit lettings.
- 19. Takings from accommodation. Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.
- 20. Star grading. The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication Accommodation Australia, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).
- 21. Employment. The number of persons working at accommodation establishments at the end of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working on other than accommodation activities). Where unpublished, employment data may be available upon request from the ABS.

Unpublished Statistics

22. The ABS may make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics, including employment statistics. A charge may be made for this information.
