



Given the nature of this survey (and its connection to Labour Force) data from this option would not be available until June (collection period May) at the earliest. We believe there is still value in implementing this option given that the data produced would be more robust than the RAPID survey (bigger sample) and would be able to draw on the more detailed labour force questions for analytical purposes. Who knows what will be happening by June, but again this sounds sensible.




