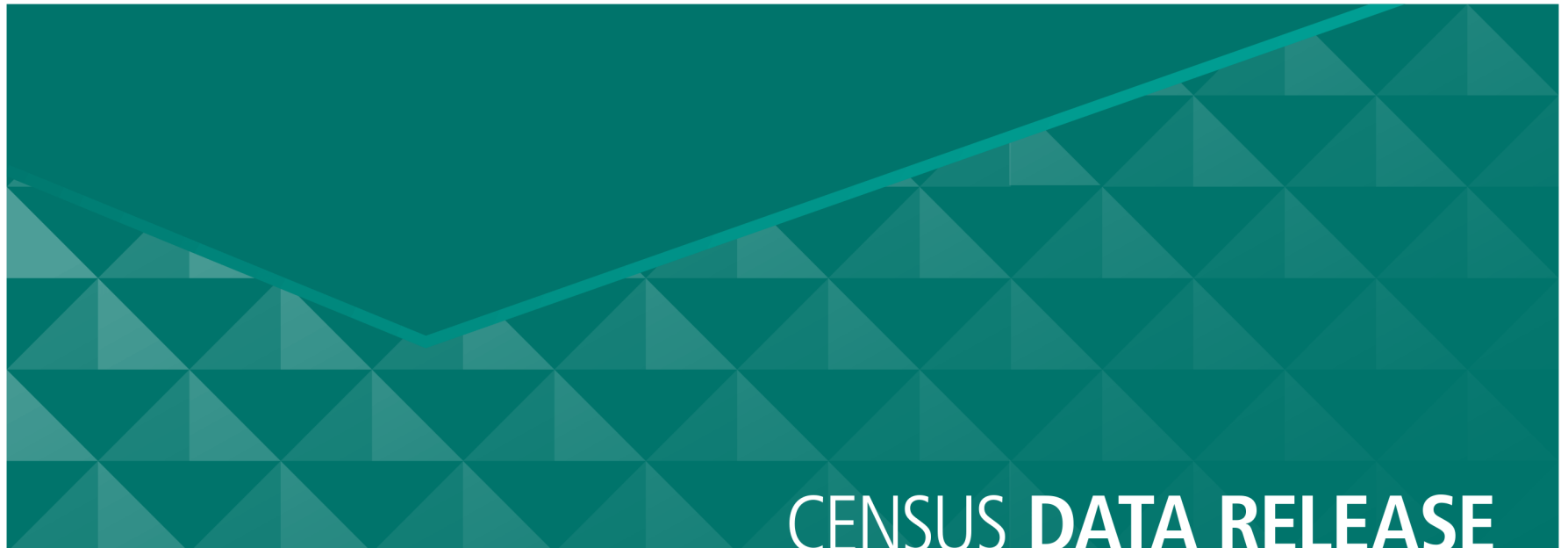

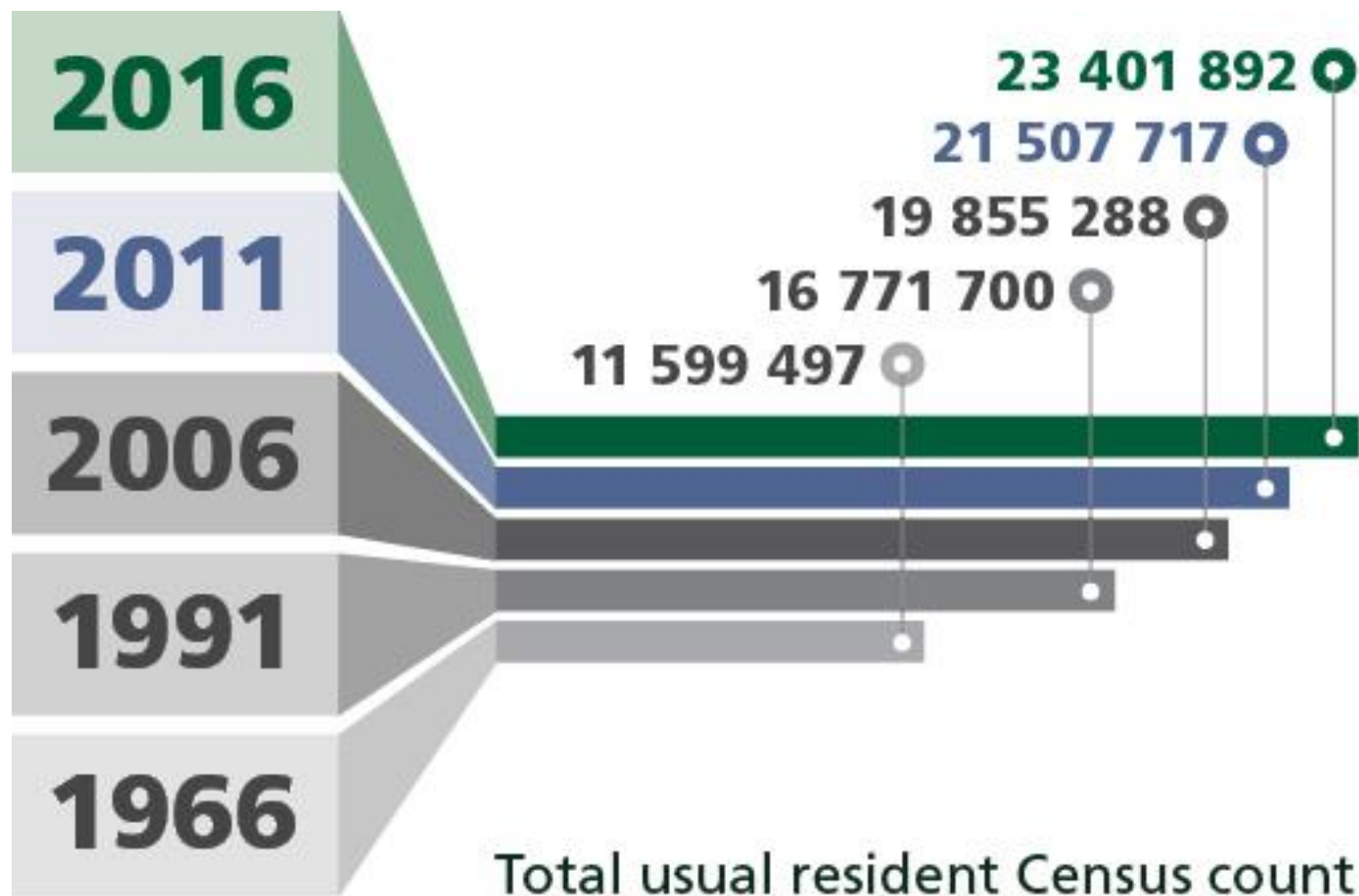

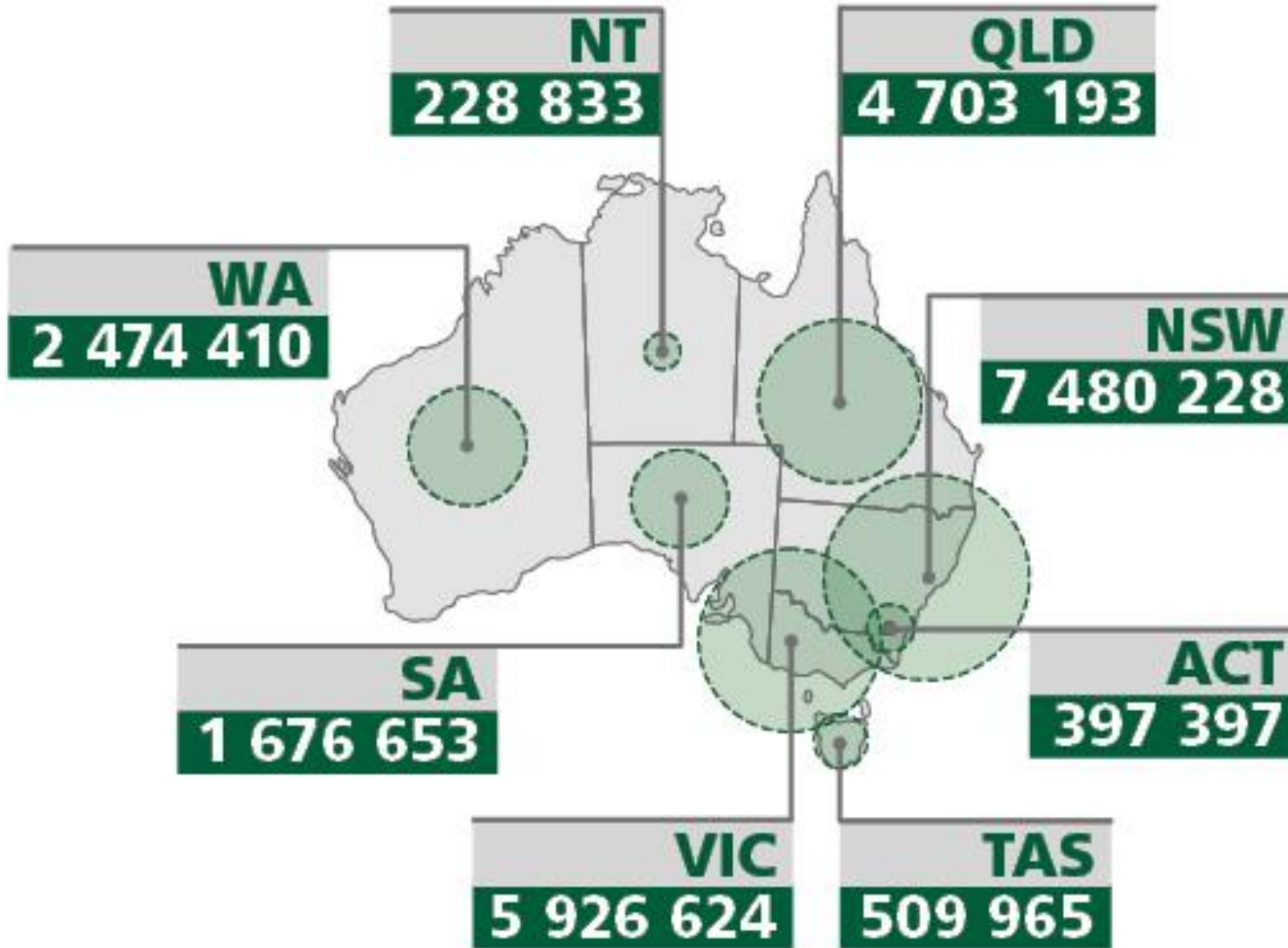

# Population growth

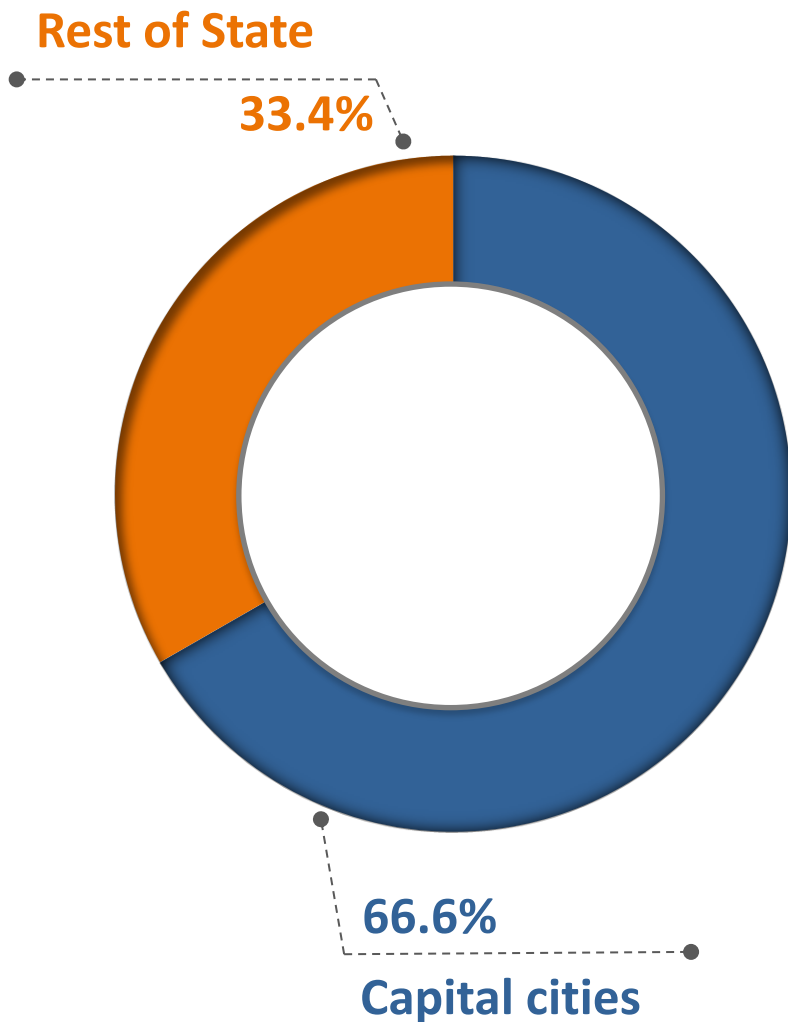


Total usual resident Census count

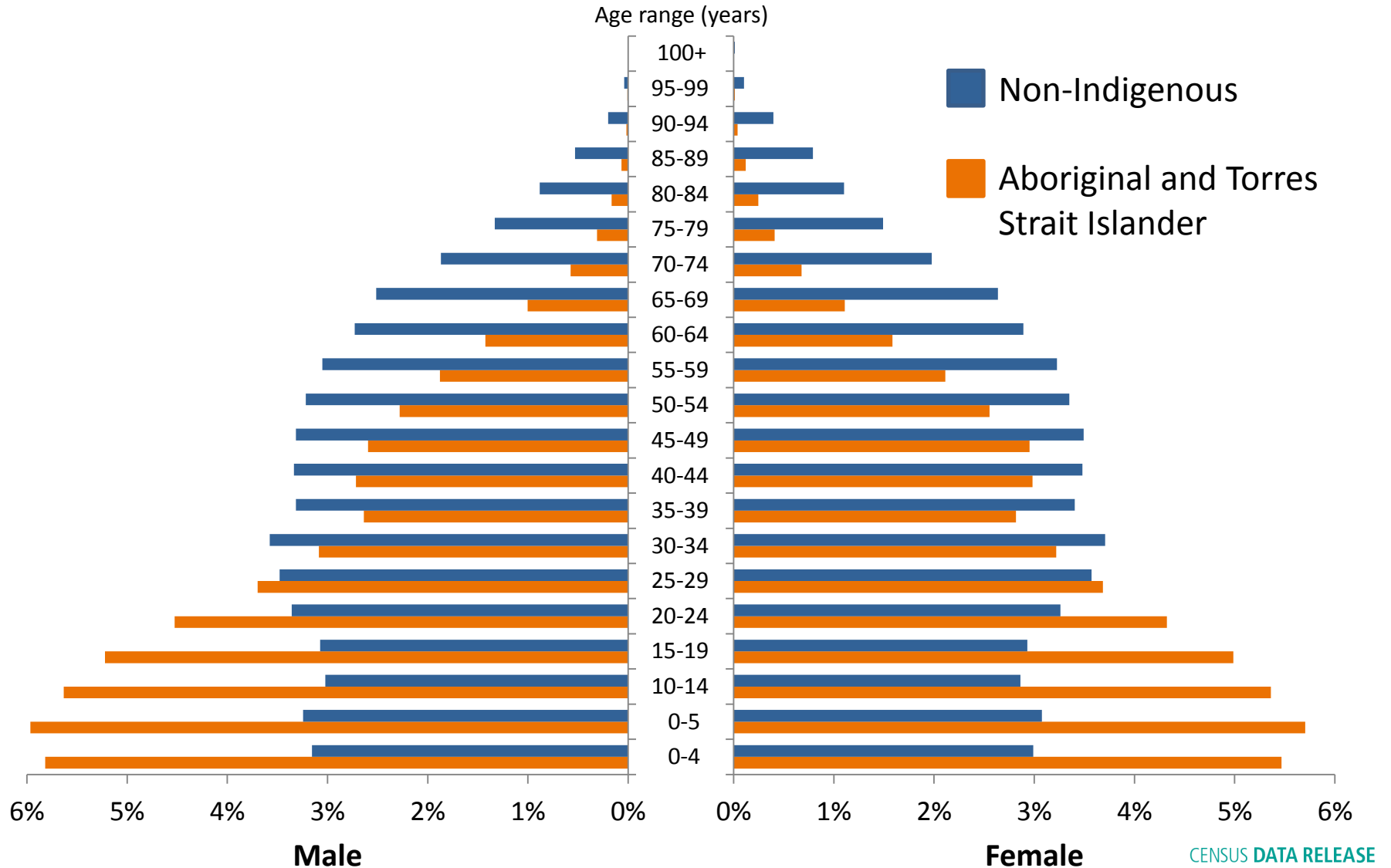

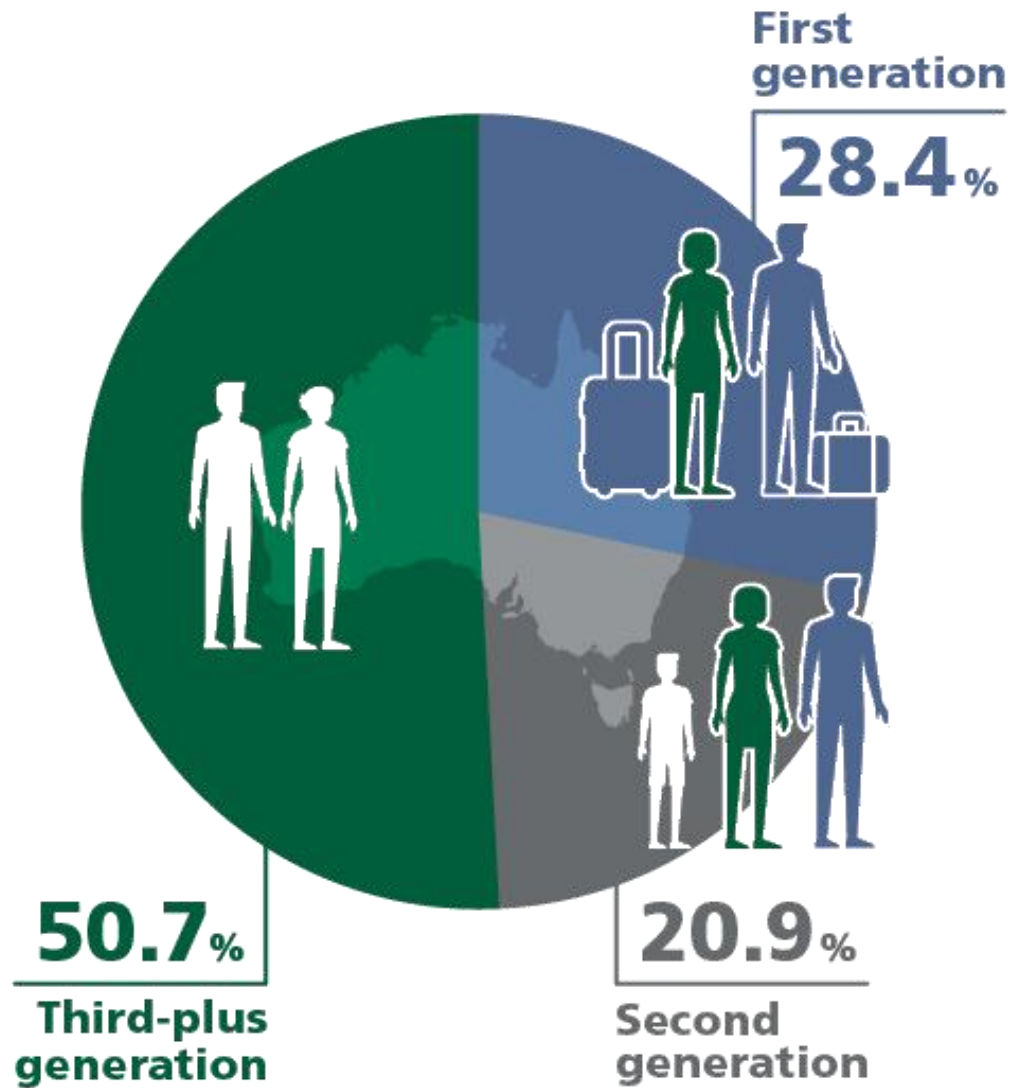




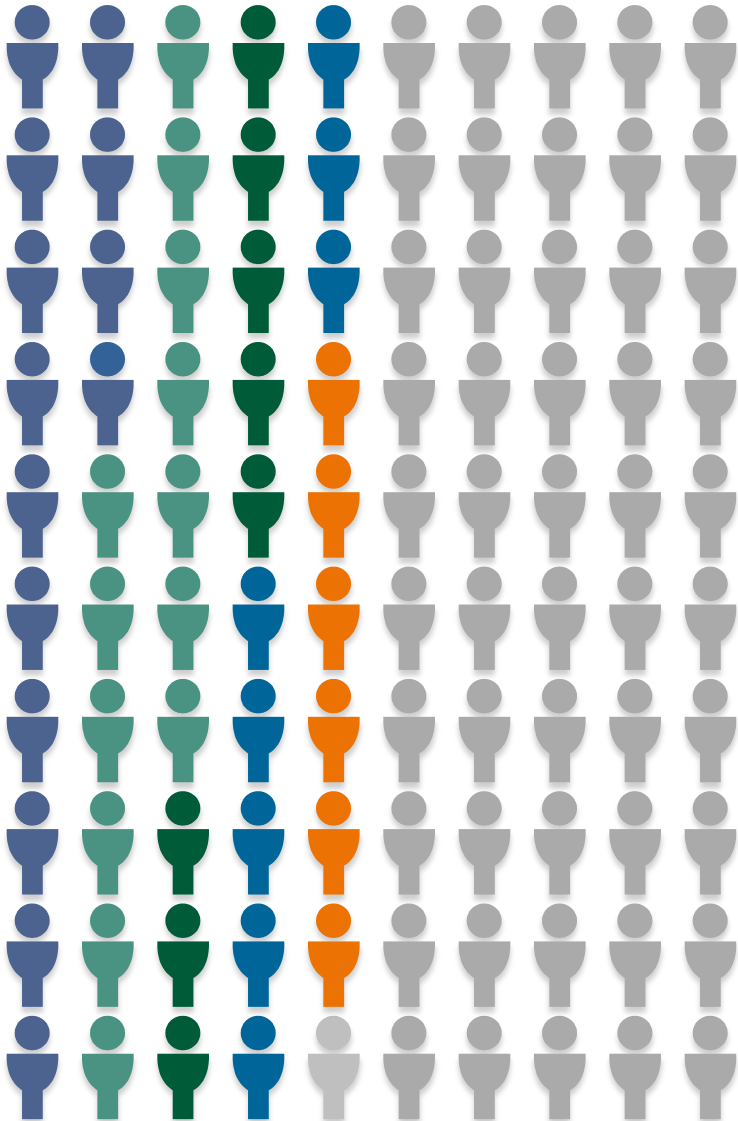

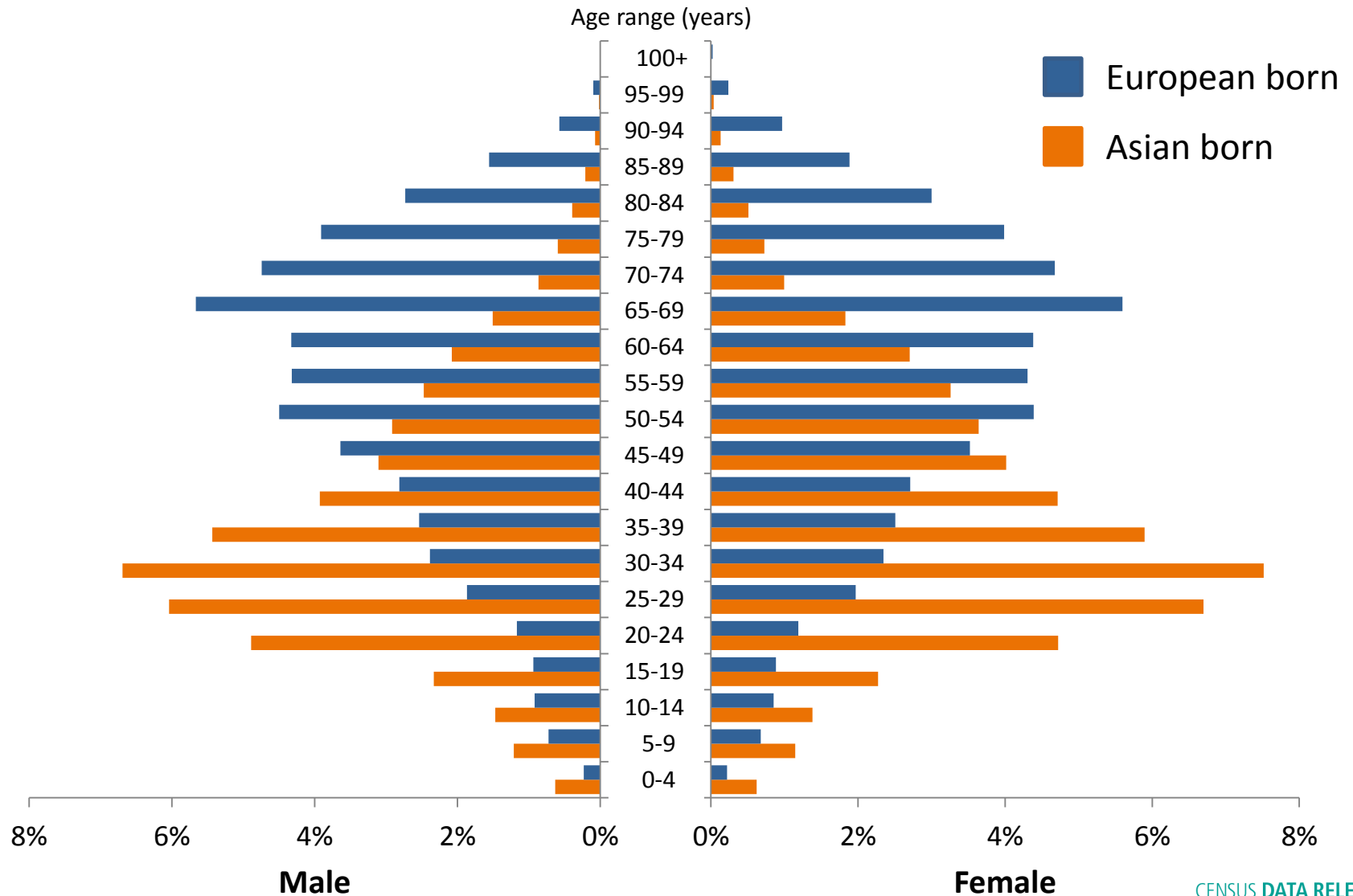

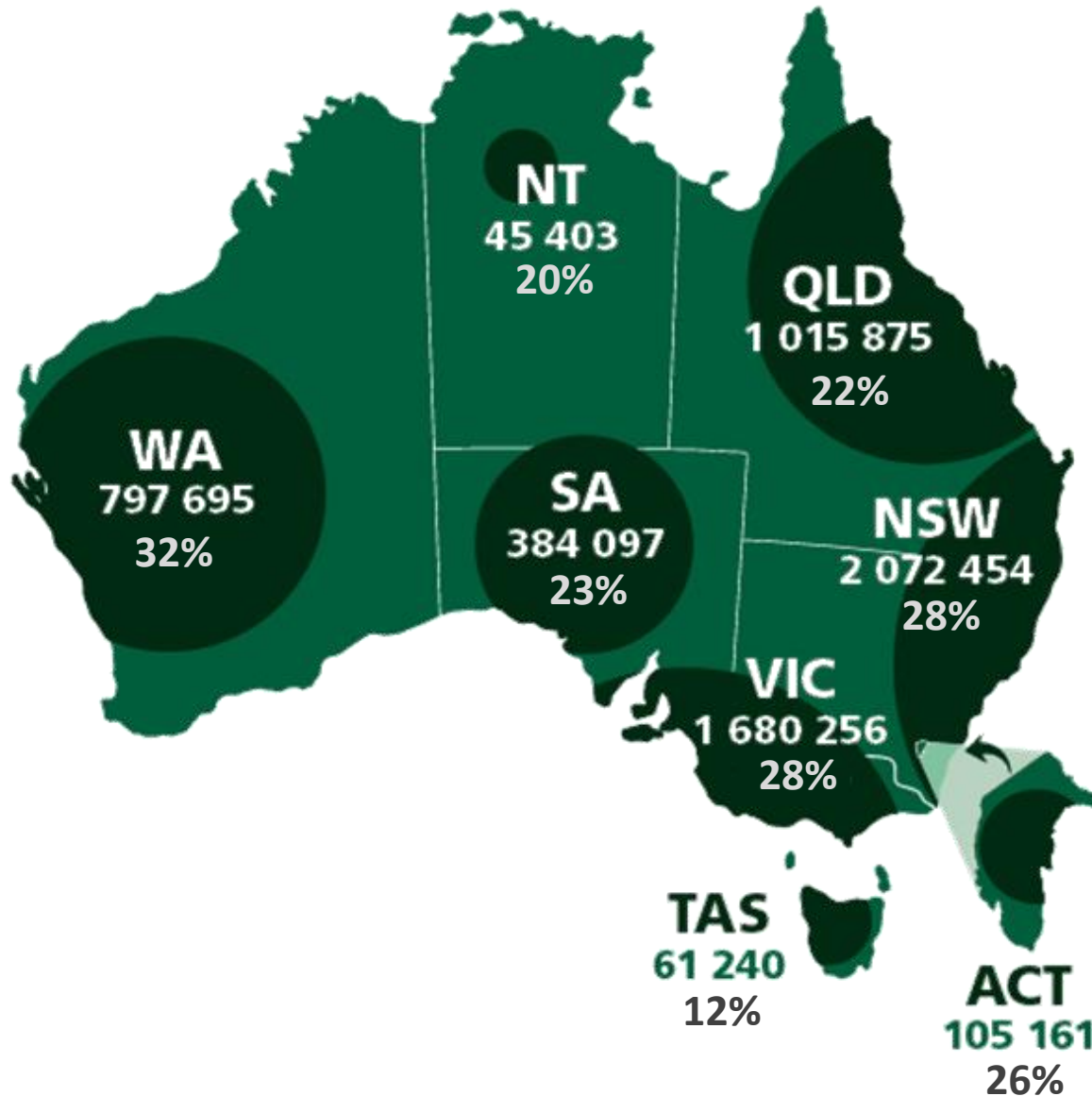

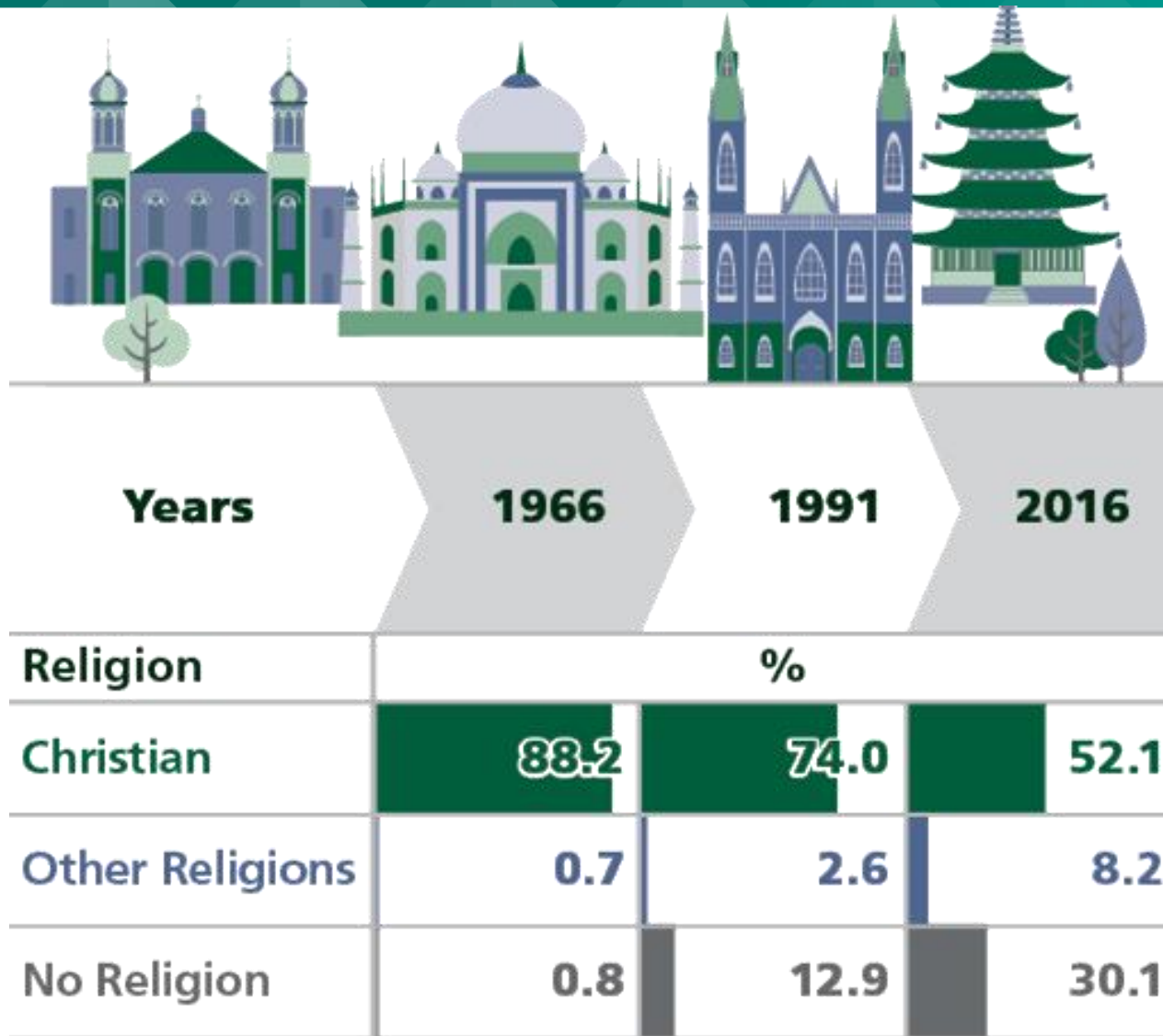
# Where do migrants live?



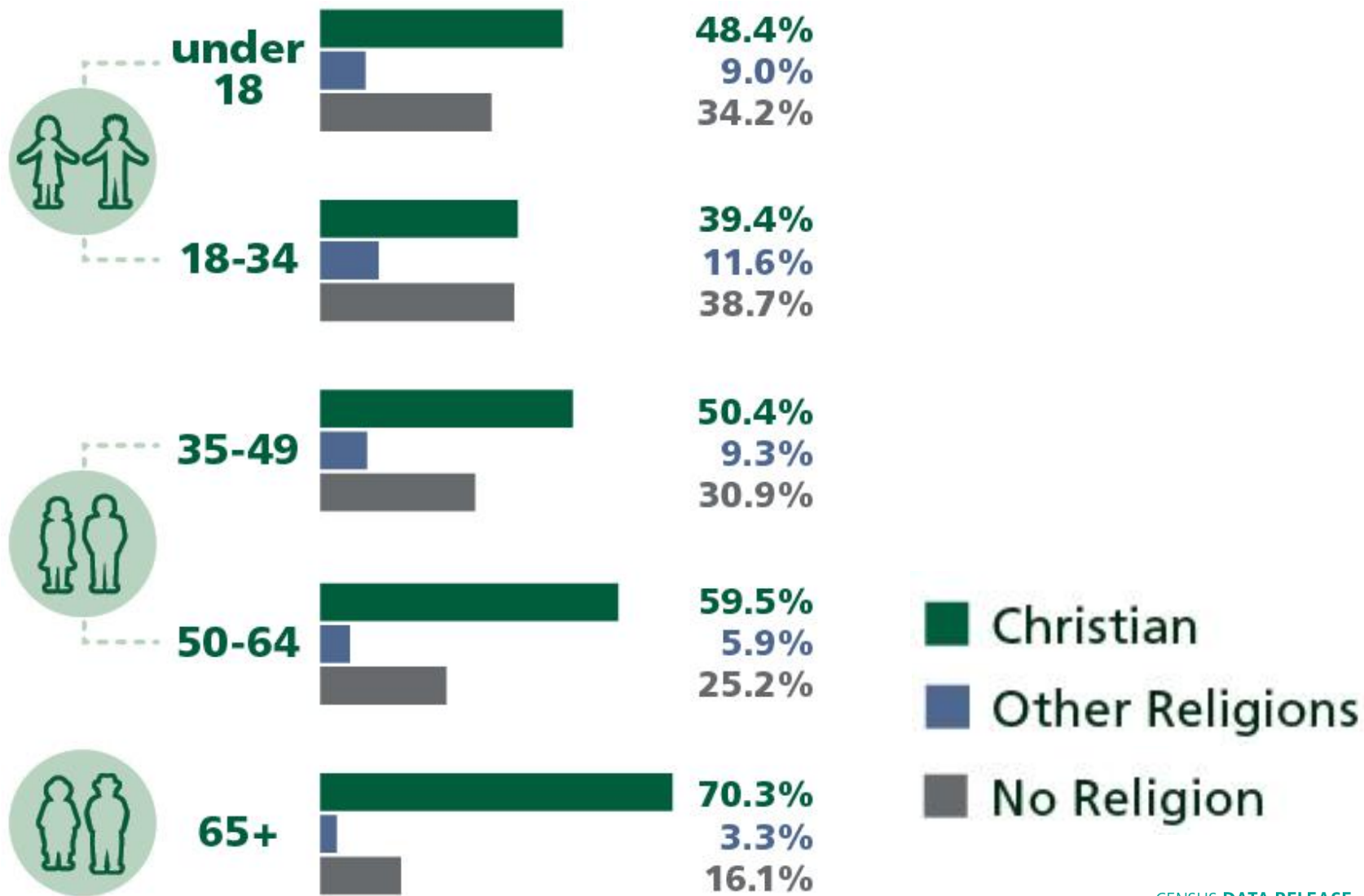
Count of people born overseas living in each state

Proportion of overseas population in each state

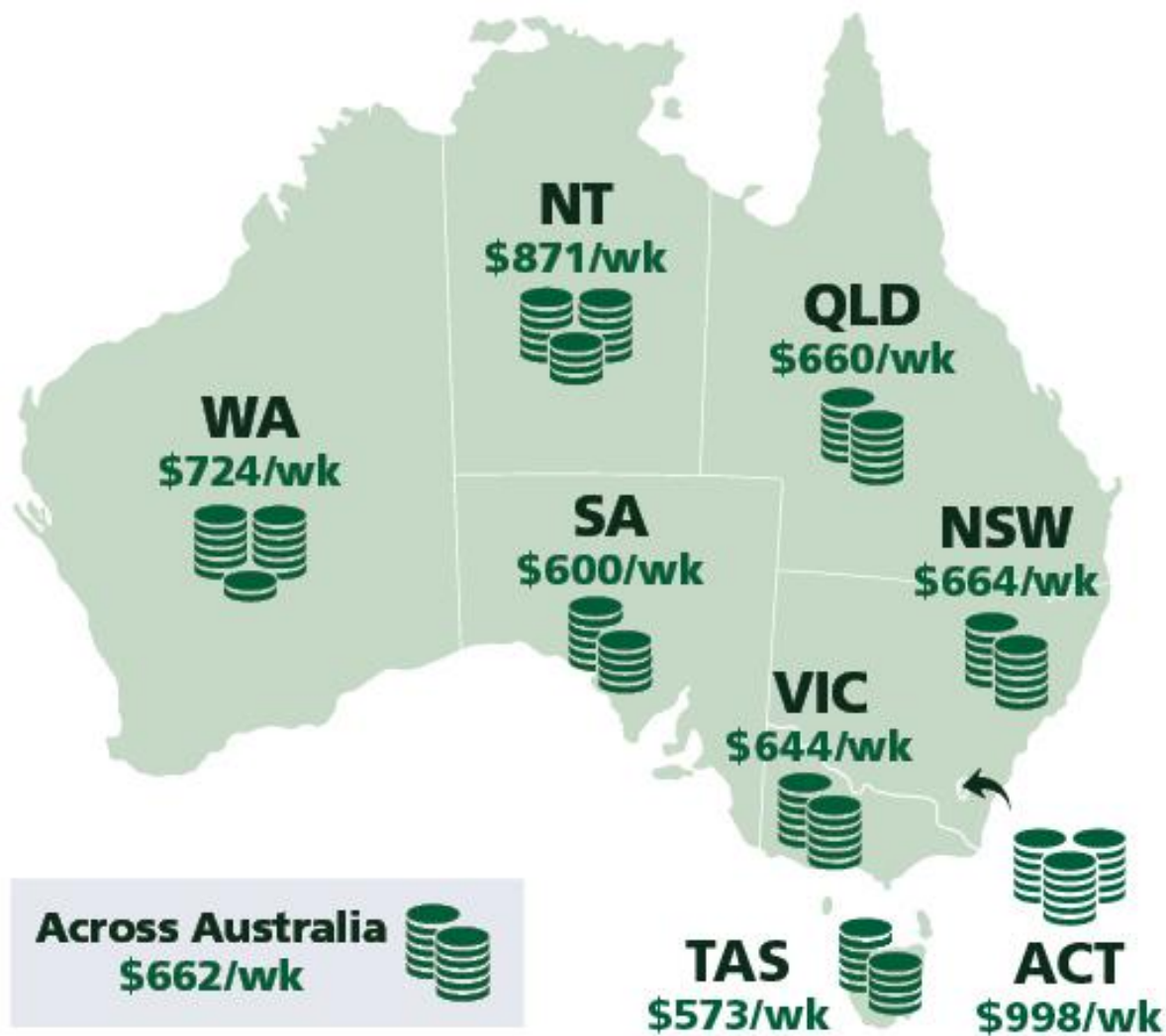
# Religion – change over time

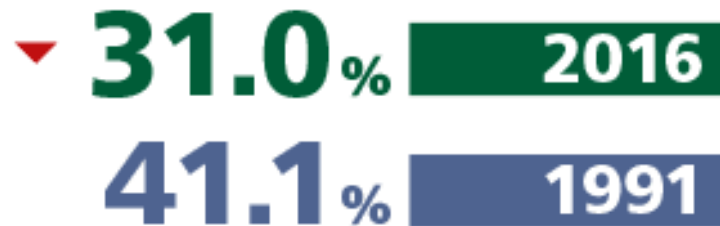

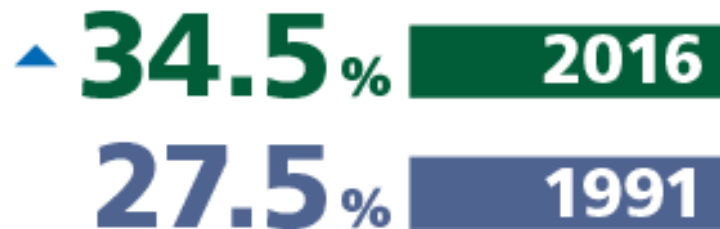

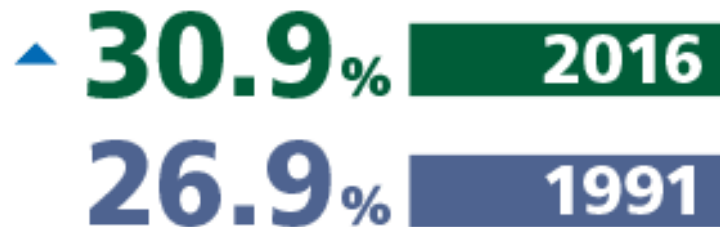

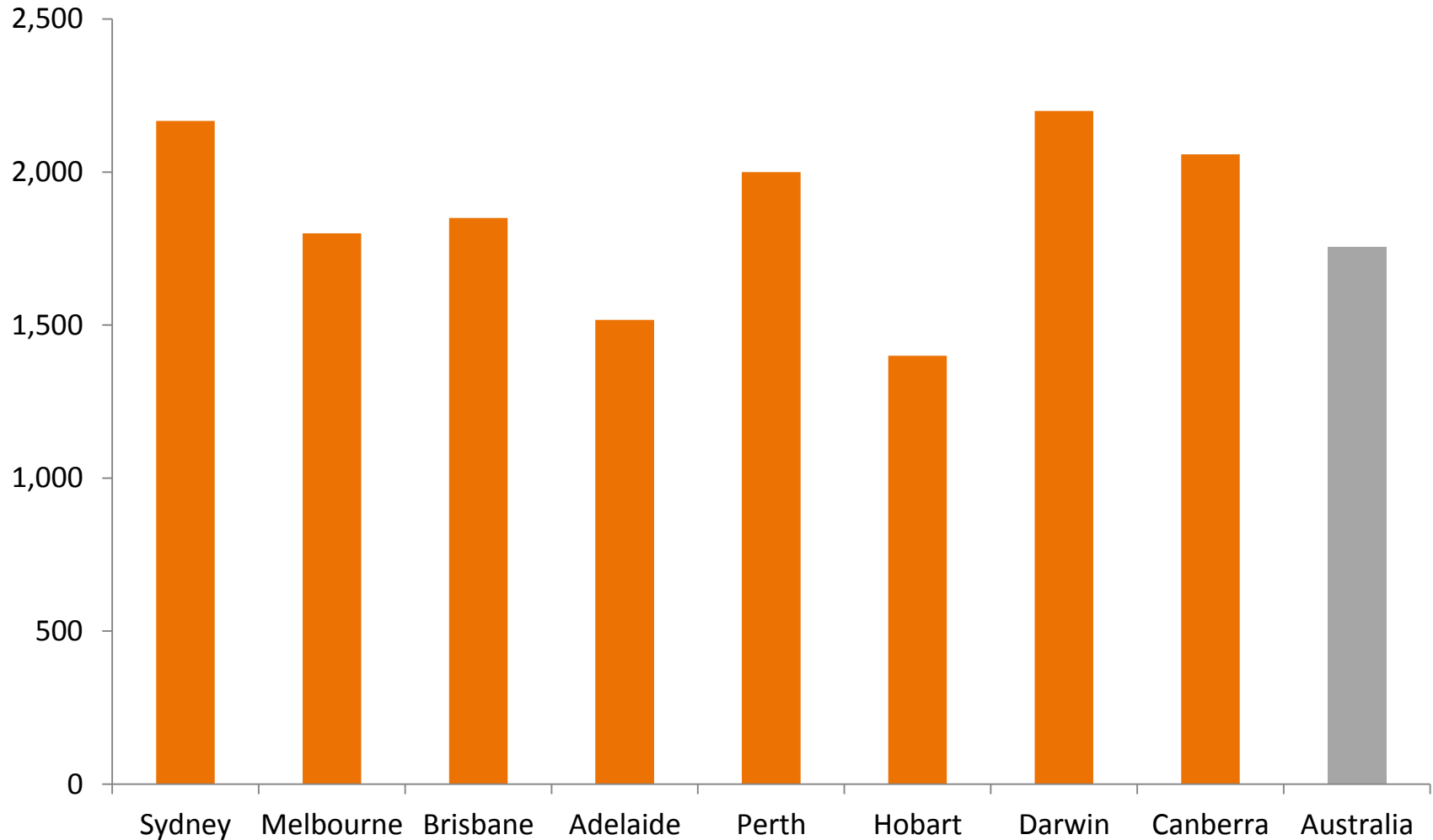

\$ per month

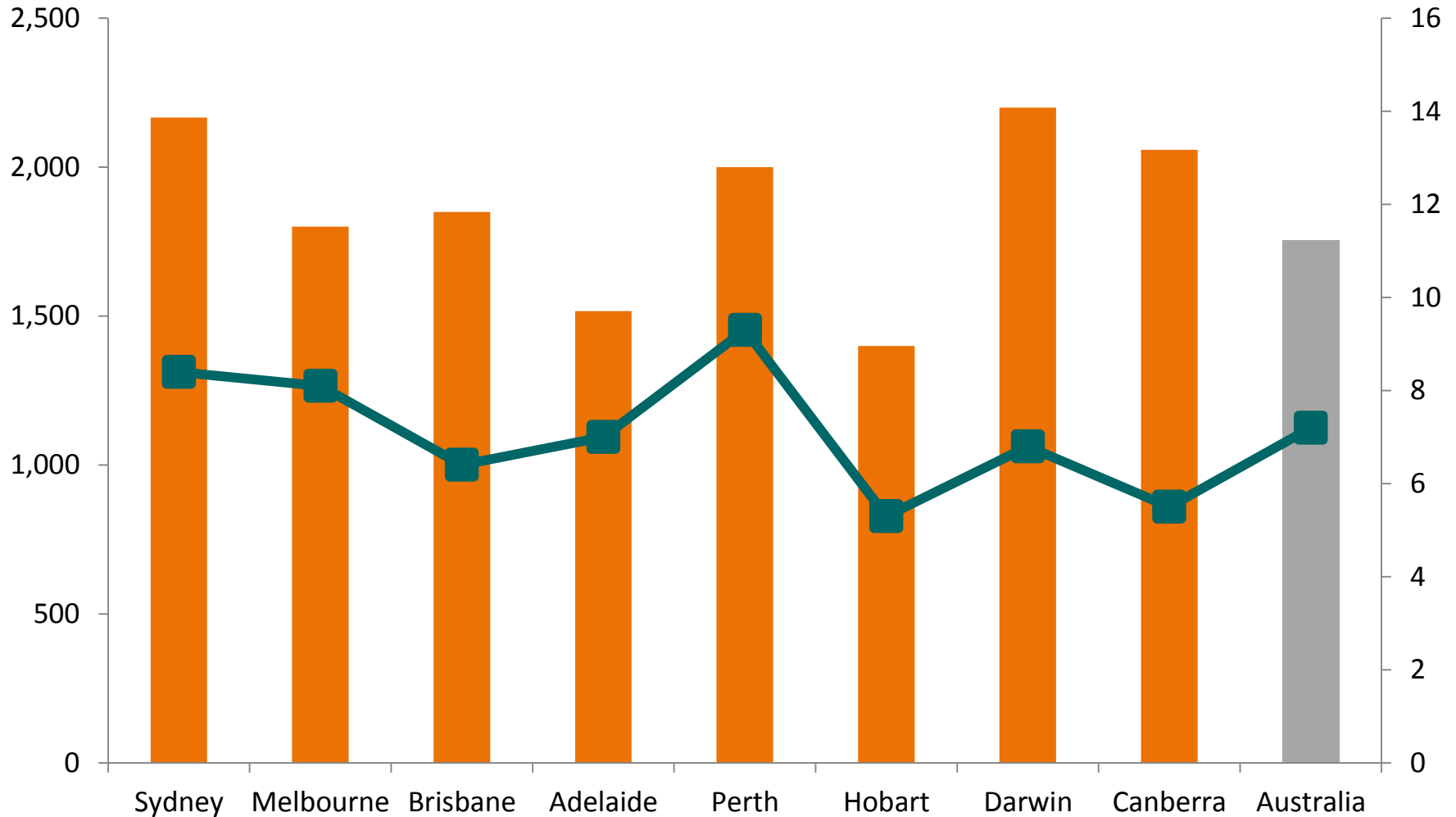


# Households paying >30% income (Mortgage)



\$ per month

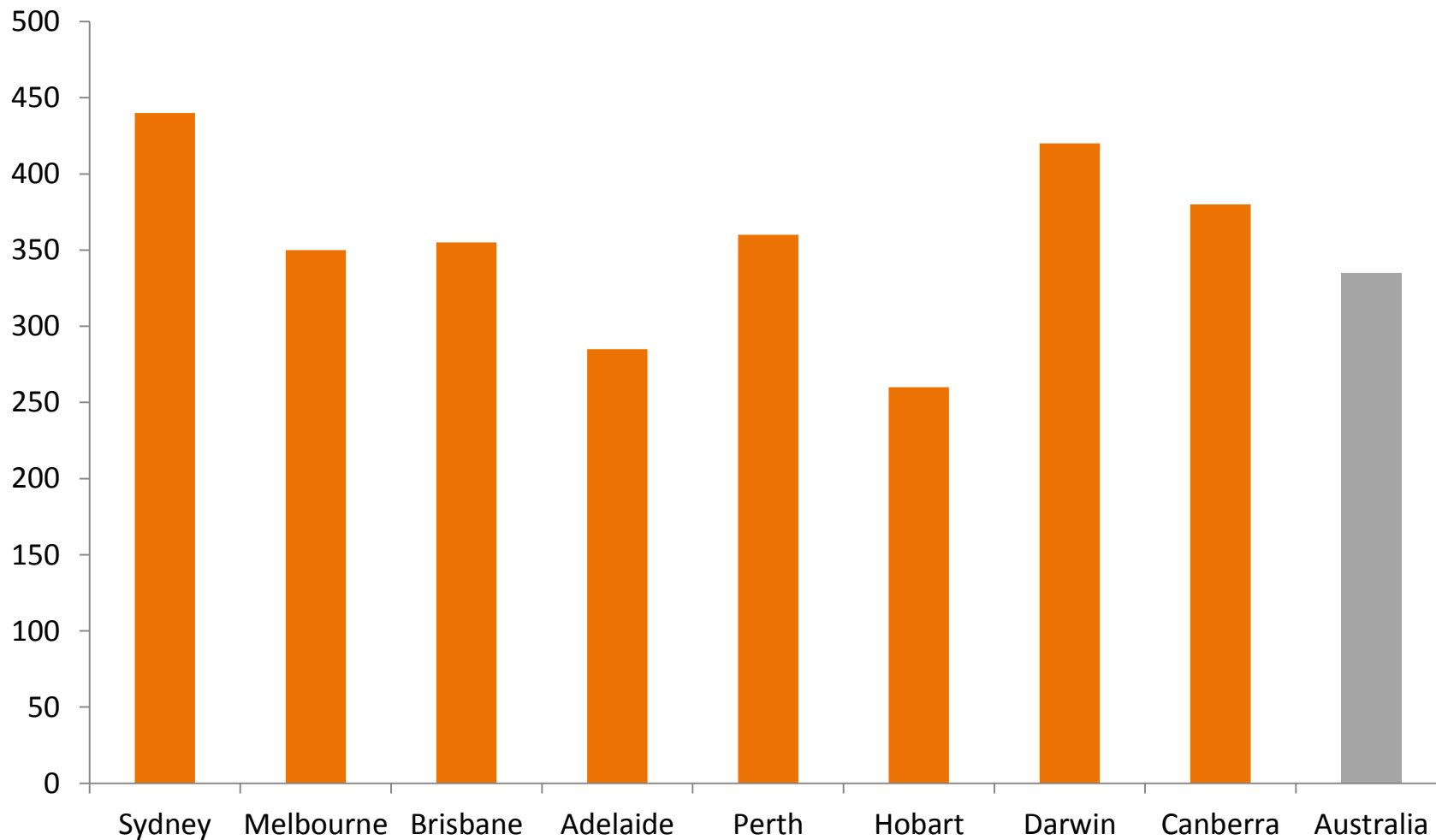
■ % of households paying >30% monthly income

\$ per week

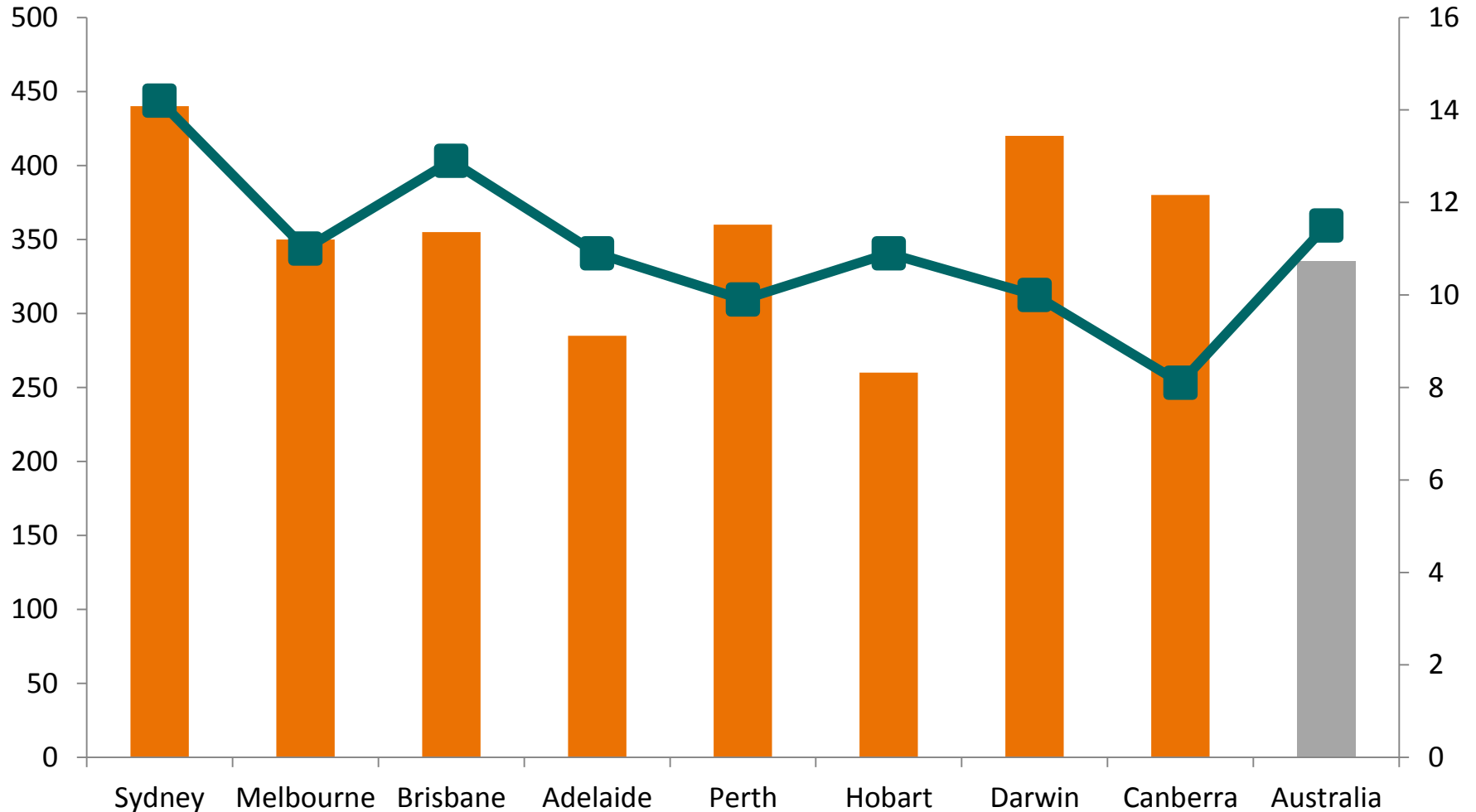


# Households paying >30% income (Rent)
