KPDRT SATES OR COODS AUSTRETMA

A sample survey of retail establishments in Australis is oonducted by tha Commonvealth Bureau of Consus and Statistics each quarter. Sample estinetes dorveti fron a full response to that Gurvey, ghowing fon each Stete retail sales claesified by comodity groups, are published about three months after the end of each quartex. These estimates are subject to revision at a later stage when more procise infomation is available relating to trading by new businesses.
2. Preliminary ouanterly figures, which are published in less detail about seven or eight weeks after the end of each quarter, are compiled on the basis of a large response from the full quarterly sample. The movement over the corresponding quarter of the preceding year which is shom by the prelininary quarterly estimates of total value of retail sales in Austrelia (excluding motor vehicles, parts, petrel, etc.) normally differs by less than one per cent. from the corresponding movement shown by the estimates compiled from the full sample and published about three months aftex the end of the quarter.
3. Provisional monthly estimates, which are published about three to four weeks after the end of each month, relate only to the total value of retail sales in Australia (excluding motor vehicles, parts, petrol, etc.) and are based on monthly returns collected from a sub-sample of the establishments included in the quarterly sample. The sub-sample is designed to provide an estimate lying within a relatively small range above or below the true figure so as to give an early apuroximate indication of trend. Undue significance should not be attached to very small movements, or to the exact magnitude of any movements, shown by provisional estimates. These estimates are subsequently adjusted in accordance with quarterly estimates when the latter become available.
4. The provisional estimate for September, 1964 is published in this bulletin. Figures for earlier months are shown for purposes of comparison.
5. Further information relating to the basis of statistics of retail sales of goods is contained in Statistical Bulletin No. 49 of 12 th October, 1964.
