- Transport by car continues to be the most reported method of travel to work. Almost two thirds (65.5%) of employed persons aged 15 years and over reported that they travelled to work by car (either as driver or a passenger) on 9 August 2011.
- The number of those who walked to work has grown slightly from 367,169 in 2006 to 377,043 in 2011. However, the proportion of persons who walked to work has declined from 4.0% in 2006 to 3.7% in 2011 (reflecting a slower rate of growth compared to other forms of travel).
