NOTE.—The Metropolitan Division relates to the capital city and adjoining urban municipal areas within boundaries used for Census purposes. At the 1947 Census it included areas (with a population of approximately 30,000 persons) which at the 1933 Census were mainly in the Rural Division.

The Urban Provincial Division comprises cities and towns outside the Metropolitan Division which are separately incorporated.

The Rural Division comprises the balance of the State and is affected by the inter-censal changes in the areas of the Metropolitan and Urban-Provincial Divisions.

In view of the foregoing the figures for the Urban-Provincial and Rural Divisions represent only a broad general classification based on administrative principles rather than geographical.
