NOTE.—The boundaries of local government areas for the purpose of the 1947 Census were those of 30th September, 1946. In some cases these boundaries differ considerably from those of the 1933 Census. In making comparisons with 1933 the possibility of such change should not be overlooked.

From 30th September, 1946, to 31st January, 1948, the principal changes of local government areas were as follows:—

New South Wales—1st January, 1947—Gosford Municipality and Erina and Woy Woy Shires divided into Gosford and Wyong Shires; 1st January, 1947—Murwillumbah Municipality and Tweed Shire united and united area constituted as Tweed Shire; 23rd May, 1947—Homebush and Strathfield Municipalities united and united area constituted as Strathfield Municipality; 24th September, 1947—Illawarra North Municipality, Wollongong Municipality, Bulli Shire and Illawarra Central Shire combined to form Greater Wollongong Municipality; 1st October, 1947—Katoomba Municipality, Blackheath Municipality and Blue Mountains Shire combined to form Blue Mountains Municipality; 1st January, 1948—Uralla Municipality and Gostwyck Shire combined to form Uralla Shire.

Victoria—24th September, 1947—Yallourn town area (under control of Yallourn Town Advisory Council) created by severance from Shire of Morwell and Shire of Narracan.

Queensland—Shire of Woothakata changed to Shire of Mareeba.
