SUMMARY FOR THE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

NOTE.—The figures published in this bulletin include the population of Jervis Bay but, in accordance with international usage, exclude the diplomatic representatives of foreign governments and the High Commissioners representing the governments of the members of the British Commonwealth, with their families and staffs. The number of people exempted in this way at the Census of 30th June, 1947, was approximately 230.

The figures in this bulletin are subject to revision on the completion of the detailed tabulation.
