### NOTES.

1. *Definition of Dwelling*.—For the purpose of the Census a "dwelling" is defined as a collection of rooms occupied by a household group living together as a family unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a house or other building (including temporary structures). In a number of cases where private houses were shared by several family units, only one Householder's Schedule was returned for the whole of the house, instead of separate schedules for each portion occupied separately. These are shown in the tables as "Private Houses (shared by several families)" and represent not "occupied dwellings" as defined for Census purposes, but "houses" occupied by more than one family. In the case of the remaining private houses shared by more than one family separate schedules were furnished for each portion occupied, and these portions are shown correctly in the tables as "dwellings" under the heading "Share of Private House." The term "family" used in the headings to the tables means household group living together as a family unit.

The number of dwellings being built relates substantially to unoccupied dwellings of all types being built at 30th June, 1947, and is not identical with the number of houses under construction in the various States at the time of the Census.

2. *Changes in Local Government Areas*.—The boundaries of local government areas for the purpose of the 1947 Census were those of 30th September, 1946. In some cases these boundaries differ considerably from those of the 1933 Census. In making comparisons with 1933 the possibility of such change should not be overlooked.

From 30th September, 1946, to 31st January, 1948, the principal changes of local government areas were as follows:—

*New South Wales*—1st January, 1947—Gosford Municipality and Erina and Woy Woy Shires divided into Gosford and Wyong Shires; 1st January, 1947—Murwillumbah Municipality and Tweed Shire united and united area constituted as Tweed Shire; 23rd May, 1947—Homebush and Strathfield Municipalities united and united area constituted as Strathfield Municipality; 24th September, 1947—Illawarra North Municipality, Wollongong Municipality, Bulli Shire and Illawarra Central Shire combined to form Greater Wollongong Municipality; 1st October, 1947—Katoomba Municipality, Blackheath Municipality and Blue Mountains Shire combined to form Blue Mountains Municipality; 1st January, 1948—Uralla Municipality and Gostwyck Shire combined to form Uralla Shire.

*Victoria*—24th September, 1947—Yallourn town area (under control of Yallourn Town Advisory Council) created by severance from Shire of Morwell and Shire of Narracan.

*Queensland*—Shire of Woothakata changed to Shire of Mareeba.

3. *Urban and Rural Divisions* (Table 1).—Metropolitan Divisions relate to the capital cities of the States and adjoining urban municipal areas within boundaries used for Census purposes. At the 1947 Census the Metropolitan Division of Victoria included areas (with a population of 30,490 persons) not included in that Division at the 1933 Census. No changes occurred in boundaries of Metropolitan Divisions in other States.

Urban Provincial Divisions comprise the capital cities of the Territories and, in States other than Tasmania, cities and towns outside the Metropolitan Divisions which are separately incorporated. In Tasmania, where most of the towns included are not separately incorporated, boundaries were determined for Census purposes. In New South Wales a number of towns which in 1933 were separately incorporated have since been included in shires.

Rural Divisions comprise the remaining portion of each Territory and State and are affected by the intercensal changes in the areas of the Metropolitan and Urban Provincial Divisions. Figures for Rural Divisions represent therefore only a broad general classification based on administration principles rather than geographical. For instance, in New South Wales most of the increase in population shown for "Rural Division" was due to abolition of municipalities which in 1933 were classified as Urban Provincial; in Victoria a large part of the decrease in population shown for "Rural Division" was due to transfer in 1947 to the Metropolitan Division of adjoining urban parts of shire areas.

4. *Preliminary Figures*.—The figures published in this bulletin are subject to revision on the completion of the detailed tabulation.
