NOTE.—The Metropolitan Division relates to the capital city and adjoining urban municipal areas within boundaries used for Census purposes. In 1933 and 1947 these were identical.

The Urban Provincial Division comprises cities and towns outside the Metropolitan Division which are separately incorporated. A number of towns which in 1933 were separately incorporated have since been included in shires.

The Rural Division comprises the balance of the State and is affected by the inter-censal changes in the area of the Urban-Provincial Division.

In view of the foregoing the figures for the Urban-Provincial and Rural Divisions represent only a broad general classification based on administration principles rather than geographical.
