## SUMMARY OF ASCO CRITERIA

The structure of ASCO is based on kind of work, defined in terms of two broad criteria - skill level and skill specialisation.

#### SKILL LEVEL

The skill level of an occupation is a function of the range and complexity of the set of tasks involved.

It is measured by the amount of formal education, on-the-job training and previous experience usually necessary for the satisfactory performance of the set of tasks.

Formal education consists of three types – primary, secondary and tertiary education. Secondary education is measured as the combined total of years of primary and secondary schooling. Tertiary education is divided into categories consistent with those recognized by the Australian Council of Awards in Advanced Education and the Technical and Further Education Advisory Council.

On-the-job training is defined as training received after employment in the job and is measured in weeks, months or years.

Previous experience for a given occupation is defined as the number of years of experience gained in other occupations which contribute to the satisfactory performance of the set of tasks.

#### SKILL SPECIALISATION

This criterion is used to group occupations according to type, rather than level, of skill.

It is measured by:

- field of knowledge;
- tools or equipment used;
- . materials worked on;
- . goods or services produced.

#### (1) Field of knowledge

This variable indicates the subject matter which is essential to the tasks performed.

#### (2) Tools or equipment used

This variable indicates the plant, machinery or hand tools used in the performance of the tasks.

The terms 'plant', 'machinery' and 'hand tools' are defined as follows:

- plant mobile or stationary equipment, which is large in size, performs several related functions, and is usually controlled by an internally located operator;
- machinery usually stationary equipment, which is not as large as plant, performs one processing function and is usually controlled by an externally located operator;
- hand tools equipment which is small enough to be moved and operated by one person.

## SUMMARY OF ASCO CRITERIA

#### (3) Materials worked on

This variable indicates the materials which are processed, refined or fabricated as an essential part of the tasks performed.

#### (4) Goods or services produced

This variable indicates the goods or services which are produced as a result of the tasks performed.

## PROFILE OF THE ASCO STRUCTURE

#### LEVELS IN THE STRUCTURE

The structure of ASCO has four levels:

- major group
- minor group
- unit group
- occupation.

#### Major Groups are:

- the broadest level of the classification
- denoted by 1-digit codes
- distinguished from each other on the basis of skill level.

There are 8 Major Groups.

#### Minor Groups are:

- subdivisions of the major groups
- denoted by 2-digit codes (the relevant major group code, plus an additional digit)
- distinguished from other minor groups in the same major group on the basis of broadly stated skill specialisation

There are 52 Minor Groups.

#### Unit Groups are:

- subdivisions of the minor groups denoted by 4-digit codes (the relevant minor group code, plus 2 additional digits)
- distinguished from other unit groups in the same minor group on the basis of a finer degree of skill specialisation

There are 282 Unit Groups.

#### Occupations are:

- subdivisions of the unit groups;
- denoted by 6-digit codes (the relevant unit group code, plus a hyphen and . 2 additional digits);
- distinguished from other occupations in the same unit group on the basis of detailed skill level and specialisation
- sets of jobs which involve the performance of a common set of tasks.

There are 1079 Occupations.

The following example illustrates these conventions:

#### **RESERVED CODES**

Occupation and unit group codes in ASCO end in odd digits to allow for future expansion without need for substantial re-numbering.

Certain codes are reserved for residual categories and for supervisory and trainee occupations.

#### **Residual Categories**

A set of codes is reserved for residual categories at the minor group, unit group and occupation levels. These categories cover elements not included in substantive categories at various levels in the classification.

The reserved codes are:

- . M9uu-oo at minor group level
- . Mm99-oo at unit group level
- . Mmuu-99 at occupation level

(where Mmuu is the unit group code and Mmuu-oo the occupation code)

Most groups in ASCO contain a number of substantive subsets at the next lower level. Each subset was created by selecting occupations or groups of occupations which are similar in terms of the classification criteria. In many cases, however, some occupations remain which have nothing in common except that they all belong to the same broader group. As a result, the substantive subsets together do not correspond to the entire group. For example, not everything in the Minor Group

is covered by the substantive Unit Groups

- 8201 Farm Hands and Assistants
- 8203 Forestry Labourers and
- 8205 Nursery and Garden Labourers.

Consequently categories have been created to cover the remaining elements. These are called 'residual categories'. In the above example, the residual Unit Group

8299 Other Agricultural Labourers and Related Workers

was created to cover the balance of Minor Group 82.

ASCO uses several terms to indicate residual categories - 'miscellaneous' at the minor group level, 'other' at the unit group level, and 'nec' (for 'not elsewhere classified') at the occupation level.

Residual categories are less homogeneous than other groups at the same level, but are required to ensure that the structure is exhaustive at all levels.

#### **Reserved Codes at Occupation Level**

At the occupation level there are two sets of reserved codes - those for supervisors, and those for trainees.

Supervisory codes have a zero in the first column following the hyphen. They range from Mmuu-01 to Mmuu-09.

The term 'supervisor' covers foremen/women, superintendents, overseers and other workers who both supervise and participate in the work of a team of Clerks, Salespersons and Personal Service Workers, Tradespersons, Plant and Machine Operators and Drivers and/or Labourers and Related Workers.

Trainee codes have a nine in the first column following the hyphen. They range from Mmuu-91 to Mmuu-97.

The term 'trainee' covers employed persons undertaking a period of on-the-job training, whether or not in conjunction with formal study for a particular occupation. They may or may not be apprenticed or otherwise indentured.

#### SUPPLEMENTARY CODES

Supplementary codes are used to process inadequately described responses in statistical collections. The codes are of two types - those commencing with '9' and those ending with one or more zeros.

Codes commencing with '9' are used to process responses which do not provide sufficient information to be coded to any level of the structure. They may also be used to process responses which are not covered by the current definition of the labour force (as defined by the International Labour Office) and are thus not contained within the structure, for example, 'housewife', 'pensioner' and 'student'.

Codes ending in one or more zeros are used to process responses which do not provide sufficiently detailed information to be coded to the level of the structure adopted for the collection, but which do provide enough information to be coded to a higher level of the structure. Thus, for example, responses which are codable only at the major or minor group levels can be processed within a collection coded at the unit group level. The following table details the use of these codes for relevant levels of the structure.

(Where M is a major group code, Mm is a minor group code, and Mmuu is a unit group code.)

#### NAMING CONVENTIONS

1. Titles at all levels are designed to illustrate the mutually exclusive nature of the groups and occupations. For this reason most titles are unique to one group or occupation. However, there are some groups which contain only one subset, and therefore possess exactly the same title as that subset.

2. All substantive terms in ASCO titles appear as nouns rather than adjectives.

3. At major, minor and unit group levels titles are in plural form, but occupation titles, including alternative and specialisation titles, are in singular form.

4. ASCO uses three terms to indicate residual categories: 'miscellaneous' at the minor group level, 'other' at the unit group level, and 'nec' (for 'not elsewhere classified') at the occupation level.

Residual categories always occur at the end of lists and their codes end in '9' as described above in the section, Reserved Codes.

5. Gender-neutral terms have been used in all titles, with the exception of some titles used by the Defence Forces.

6. Some commonly-used terms have restricted meanings in ASCO. These are defined above in Summary of ASCO Criteria, and in specific group definitions.



STRUCTURE AND GROUP DEFINITIONS



#### FORMAT OF DEFINITIONS

The format of major, minor and unit group definitions varies slightly between levels, but they all contain similar elements. These elements are:

- . statement of the boundaries of the group;
- . information on skill level;
- . list of principal or indicative tasks;
- . list of lower level groups or occupations contained in the group.

The major and minor group definitions have separate paragraphs dealing with each of the above elements. They also contain paragraphs dealing with special inclusions and exclusions in cases where the reason may not be obvious.

The unit group definitions are presented in the following format:

UNIT GROUP CODE and TITLE

A lead statement specifying the boundaries of the group in terms of broadly stated tasks.

Under the heading SKILL LEVEL is a statement specifying the skill level for the unit group, expressed in terms of formal education, previous experience and on-the-job training. Special requirements, such as licensing, are also indicated under this heading.

Under the heading TASKS INCLUDE is a list of primary tasks performed in the occupations included in the unit group.

Under the heading OCCUPATIONS is a list of occupation titles included in the unit group.

There are three categories of occupation titles:

**Principal Titles** are the official titles used to designate occupations in ASCO. They are printed in bold type and accompanied by the occupation level code.

Alternative Titles are commonly used synonyms of the Principal Title. They are designated by (a).

**Specialisation Titles** are commonly occurring titles referring to a subset of jobs belonging to the occupation designated by the Principal Title. These jobs involve the performance of specialised tasks rather than the broader range of tasks usually performed in the occupation. They are designated by (s).

Under the heading RELATED OCCUPATIONS is a list of related occupations contained in other unit groups.

Under the heading COMMENTS are items of relevant information not given elsewhere.
