(industry codes 7000–7103, 7105, 7200 (part)). In practice, all index entries for codes 110–119 go to 110, to be allocated to individual codes 110–119, by computer on the basis of industry as set out in the table below.

However, if a person states his occupation as a profession or trade even though he exercises managerial or administrative functions he is to be coded to his profession or trade and not to codes 100–109, or 110–119. For example, pharmaceutical chemist, barrister and solicitor, master plumber, panel beater.

The following are 'managerial' and 'administrative' occupations in private enterprise which go to code 110, to be allocated to codes 110–119. Evidence has shown that the majority of managers are covered by this list or variations of it.
