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Main Features

- The total number of people counted in Tasmania on census night, 6 August 1991, was 452,834. This represents a 3.8% increase in the census count since the 1986 Census.
- Launceston (C)-Part B was the most populated statistical local area (SLA) in the State, with a census count of 59,135 people or 13.1% of the total State population. Clarence (C) was next, with a census count of 46,280 people or 10.2% of the total.
- 40.2% of the total State population was counted in the Greater Hobart Statistical Division. Northern Statistical Division was next, with 28.1% of the total.
- The census count for the Western Statistical Subdivision declined by 23.3% from the 1986 Census to the 1991 Census. Three of the four SLAs in the subdivision declined by more than 10% in the period.
- 15.9% of the people counted in Tasmania in 1991 were aged in the 5-14 years age group. 54.6% of the people counted were aged less than 35 years. The proportion aged 65 years and over was 11.5%.
- The number of occupied private dwellings counted by the census in Tasmania increased by 9.1% since the 1986 Census. The greatest increase was in Southern Statistical Division, 14.7%, followed by Northern Statistical Division with a 9.8% increase, Greater Hobart Statistical Division with 8.9%, and Mersey-Lyell Statistical Division with 6.7%.
- At the time of the 1991 Census, 72.7% of the population of Tasmania lived in urban areas (major urban and other urban Sections of State).
- Legal local government areas (LGAs) with the largest percentage increases in population from the 1986 Census to the 1991 Census were Westbury with 33% and Sorell with 24.9%.

LGAs with the largest percentage decreases in population in the period were Waratah with 40.4% and Zeehan with 30.5%.
- Legal local government areas (LGAs) with the largest percentage increases in the number of occupied private dwellings from the 1986 Census to the 1991 Census were Westbury with 41.0% and Sorell with 31.9%.

LGAs with the largest percentage decreases in the number of occupied private dwellings in the period were Waratah with 35.9% and Zeehan with 16.4%.
- 5.0% of Tasmania's urban centres and localities (UCLs) had a 1991 Census count of more than 10,000 people; 66% of UCLs had less than 1,000 people.

About this publication

This publication contains final data from the 1991 Census of Population and Housing.

The census counts are provided for statistical local areas (SLAs), statistical subdivisions (SSDs) and statistical divisions (SDs); legal local government areas (LGAs); and urban centres/localities (UC/Ls). Totals at Section of State level are provided in Table 3. Some 1986 Census data are included.

The counts are on a place of enumeration basis, which provides a count of people where they were located on census night, 6 August 1991, which may not be where they usually live.

Census Counts for Small Areas is produced for each State and Territory.

Scope and coverage

The 1991 Census of Population and Housing was held on 6 August 1991. The purpose of the census was to count every person who spent census night in Australia. This included people in private dwellings, occupied non-private dwellings, camping out, on vessels in or between Australian ports and on board overnight transport.

People were counted where they were located on census night, which may not have been where they usually live.

Visitors to Australia were counted regardless of how long ago they arrived, or how long they planned to stay. Australian residents out of the country on census night were excluded.

All private dwellings were counted, whether occupied or unoccupied. Occupied non-private dwellings, such as hospitals, gaols, etc. were also counted.

Diplomatic personnel and their families were excluded from the census, as were diplomatic residences.

Data limitations

The census is subject to a number of errors, although the effect of such errors on overall census results is generally insignificant.

Underenumeration

Although the census aims to count each person, there are some people who are missed. Underenumeration in the 1991 Census is estimated to be 1.9% for Australia. The data in this publication are not adjusted for underenumeration.

Respondent error

Because processing procedures cannot detect all errors made by people in completing the census form, some remain in final data.

Processing error

Some processing errors may occur, although stringent quality control measures have been used to minimise them.

Random adjustment

Random error is added to census data to ensure confidentiality. This means that small cells are randomly adjusted to avoid releasing information about particular individuals, families, households or dwellings. As a result, component cells may not add to their totals. These differences are statistically insignificant and do not impair the usefulness of the tables.

Further information on data quality will be provided in *Census Update* and in the 1991 Census data quality papers.

1986 Census data

1986 Census data have been provided in this publication. Where a legal local government area (LGA) or a statistical local area (SLA) boundary has changed, 1986 Census data have been adjusted to match the 1991 Census boundaries. 1986 data for urban centre/localities (UC/Ls) are not adjusted.

1986 Census occupied private dwelling data in this publication include occupied caravans in parks. These data have been adjusted to provide comparability with the 1991 Census data for occupied private dwellings.

The 1986 data were originally published in *Census 86 - Persons and Dwellings in Legal Local Government Areas, Statistical Local Areas and Urban Centres/(Rural) Localities, Tasmania (2467.0)*.

Census variables in this publication

Age

Age has been collected in all Australian censuses. For the 1991 Census, age was self-coded.

Sex

The census forms asks the sex of each person.

Dwellings

The census collector recorded each dwelling as either private or non-private. Private dwellings are either occupied or unoccupied. Only occupied non-private dwellings were included in the census. Non-private dwellings include occupied motels, gaols, welfare institutions, hospitals, retirement villages, boarding schools etc. Occupied caravans in parks are counted as occupied private dwellings.

The geographic areas

The codes and names of geographic areas used in this publication are defined by the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC).

The ASGC codes are included to enable users to cross-reference geographic areas in this publication with areas in other census products which use codes only, such as some maps and some electronic products.

Definitions of ASGC areas in this publication are provided below. More detailed definitions and lists of codes and names of the geographic areas are contained in the publications *1991 Census Geographic Areas (2905.0)*, *1991 Census Urban centres/Localities Code List (2909.0)* and *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) (1216.0)*, edition 2.1.

Statistical Local Area (SLA)

Statistical local areas (SLAs) must consist of one or more whole collection districts (CDs) and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps. They are the key intermediate spatial units for the dissemination of census data.

SLAs correspond in most cases to legal local government areas (LGAs). The main exceptions are:

- where the boundaries of one or more statistical subdivisions (SSDs) cut across a legal LGA, the legal LGA is split into two or more parts, each of which falls within the relevant SSD.
- where a particular legal LGA is substantially different from other equivalent legal LGAs in terms of size and economic significance, the legal LGAs can be split into sub-areas. For example, the city of Brisbane covers a large area and is split into 165 SLAs.

Where an area is **unincorporated**, that is, not part of an LGA, an SLA is created.

In the ASGC, oil rigs and other artificial platforms are formed into Off-Shore Areas. For census purposes, people on board vessels in or between Australian ports, or on board long-distance trains, buses or aircraft are classified as being migratory. The two groups are combined to form an **Off-Shore Areas and Migratory SLA** for each State and the Northern Territory for the census.

For the 1991 Census, Australian residents temporarily in Antarctica were within the scope of the census and included in Tasmania's Off-Shore Areas and Migratory SLA.

Statistical Subdivision (SSD)

Statistical subdivisions (SSDs) are the smaller of two ASGC general purpose regional type spatial units, the other is the statistical division (SD). SSDs are defined in most States on the same basis as SDs.

SSDs consist of one or more statistical local areas (SLAs) and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps.

Statistical Division (SD)

Statistical divisions (SDs) are the larger of the two ASGC general purpose regional type spatial units, the smaller one is the statistical subdivision (SSD).

SDs consist of one or more SSDs and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps. They do not cross State or Territory boundaries.

SDs are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic links between the inhabitants and the economic units in the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

Capital city SDs are predominantly urban in character and the boundaries are delineated to contain the anticipated urban development of the capital cities (and associated urban centres) for a period of at least twenty years.

Legal Local Government Area (LGA)

Legal local government areas (LGAs) are spatial units which represent the whole undivided geographical area of responsibility of either:

- an incorporated local government council, or
- an incorporated community government council (CGC) where the CGC is of sufficient size and statistical significance.

There are 832 legal LGAs in Australia at the time of the 1991 Census which collectively cover only a part of Australia. The major areas not covered by legal LGAs (**unincorporated areas**, see SLAs) are the large northern parts of South Australia, most of the Northern Territory and all of the Australian Capital Territory.

The number of LGAs and their boundaries change over time. They are the responsibility of the State/Territory governments.

Section of State

Within a State or Territory each Section of State represents an aggregation of non-contiguous geographical areas of a particular type. They are defined for each census at the time of the census.

The Sections of State are:

- Major Urban: all urban centres with a population of 100,000 and over
- Other Urban: all urban centres with a population of 1,000 to 99,999
- Locality: all localities with a population of 200 to 999
- Rural Balance: the remainder of the State/Territory
- Migratory: Off-Shore Areas and Migratory.

Urban Centre/Locality (UC/L)

Broadly an Urban Centre is a population cluster of 1,000 or more people. A Locality is a population cluster of between 200 and 999 people. People living in Urban Centres are classified as urban for statistical purposes while those in Localities are classified as rural. The criteria for delimiting UC/Ls are based on the Linge criteria.

Details of these criteria as applied for the 1991 Census, and the codes and names of the 1991 Census UC/Ls, are available in the publication *1991 Census - Urban Centres/Localities Code List* (2909.0).

Changes to geographic areas between censuses

Changes occur in the period between censuses, for example, when State governments review legal local government areas (LGAs). The ABS makes an annual review of the ASGC to incorporate these changes. Statistics from the 1991 Census relate to the areas defined by the ASGC at 1 January 1991. Details of the changes made since the 1986 Census are provided in this publication.

ABS population estimates

Official ABS population estimates (estimated resident population) are based on census counts that have been adjusted to:

- include people who were in Australia on census night but were missed in the census;
- include Australian residents who were temporarily overseas on census night (these people were not within the scope of the census); and
- exclude overseas visitors counted in the census who are not usual residents of Australia.

The adjusted census count is then updated quarterly using demographic statistics. These are statistics on births, deaths, and overseas and internal migration.

ABS population estimates are published in *Australian Demographic Statistics* (3101.0), produced quarterly, and in *Estimated Resident Population by Sex and Age: States and Territories of Australia* (3201.0), produced annually.

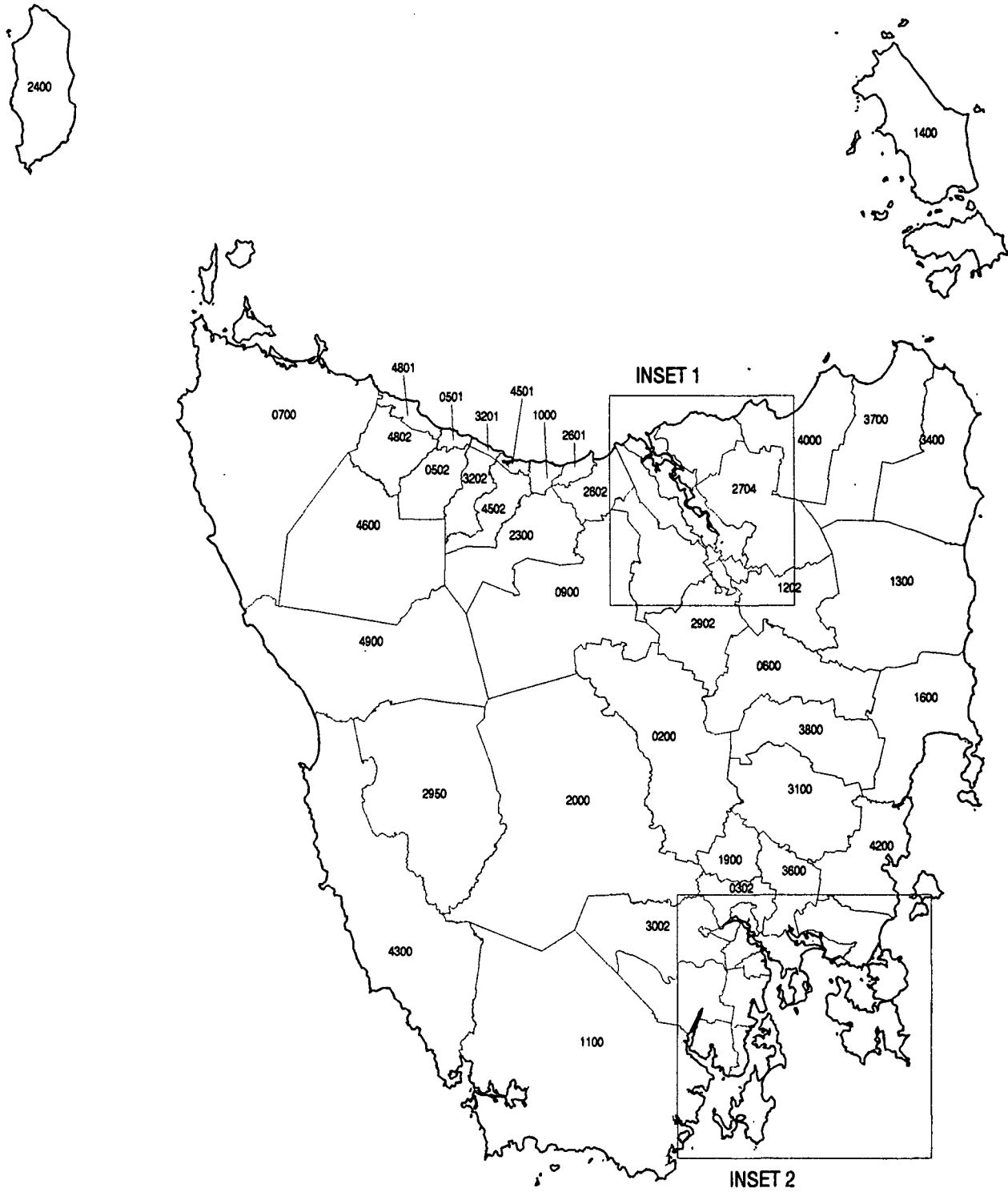

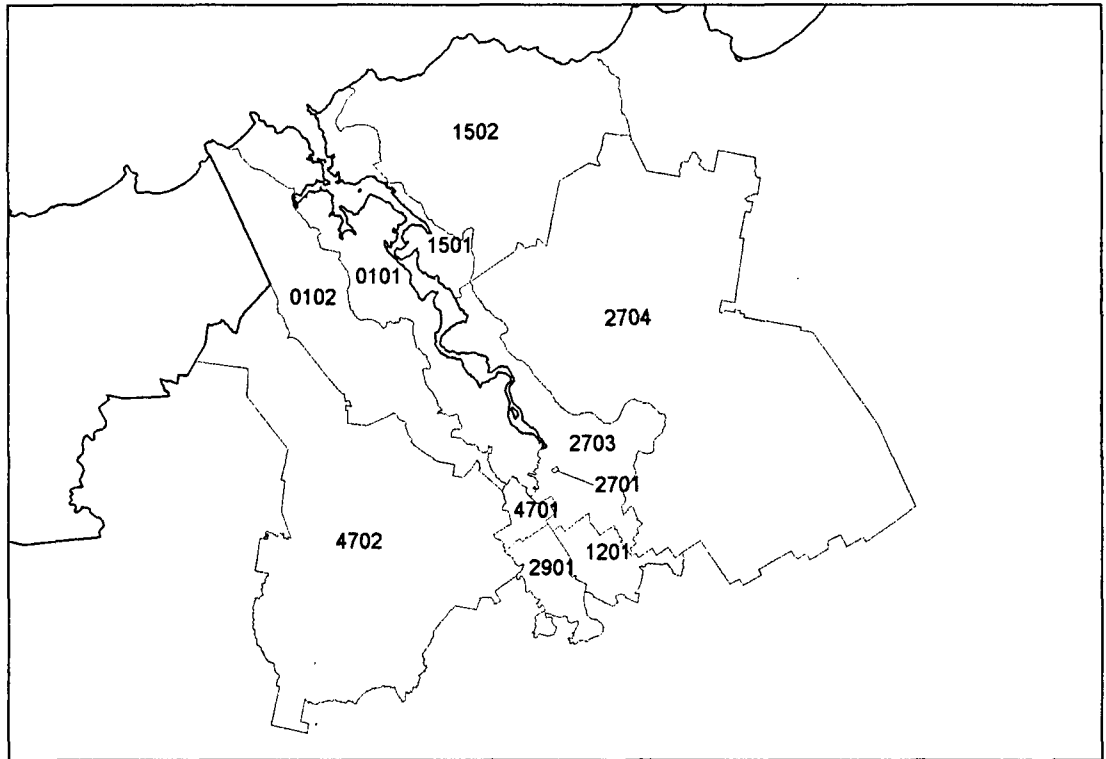
1991 Census - Statistical Local Areas, Tasmania



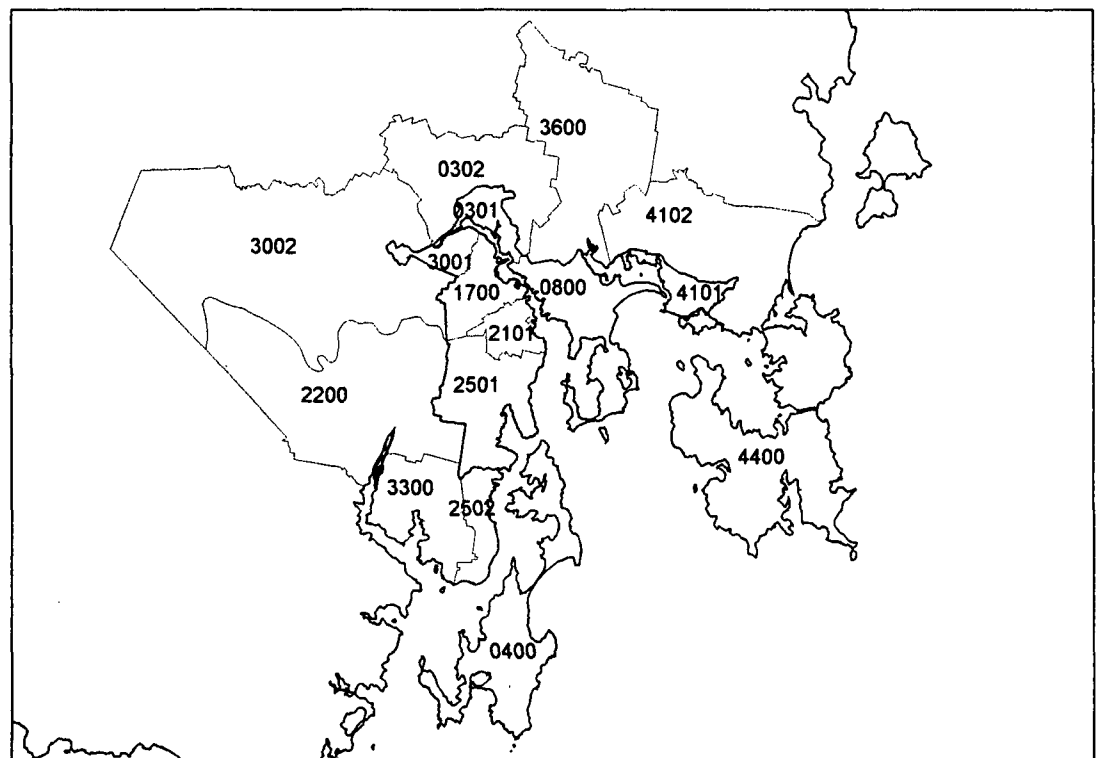
