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## Main Features

- The total number of people counted in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) and Jervis Bay Territory on census night, 6 August 1991, was 280,095. This represents a 12.3% increase in the census count since the 1986 Census.
- The census count for the Tuggeranong Statistical Subdivision increased by 44.7% since the 1986 Census. Four new statistical local areas in this statistical subdivision have been established since the 1986 Census. They are Bonython, Gordon, Greenway and Theodore. The total census count for these statistical local areas was 7,084 people.  
  
Calwell had only six people at the time of the 1986 Census but increased to 5,349 people by the 1991 Census. Isabella Plains showed a similar increase, from 728 people to 4,283 people, as did Gilmore, from 696 to 3,158. Other statistical local areas in the statistical subdivision to increase by more than 10% were Chisholm (32.3%), Oxley (37.9%), Monash (18.3%) and Fadden (13.2%).
- The census count for the Woden Valley Statistical Subdivision increased by 6.3% since the 1986 Census. Only four statistical local areas in this statistical subdivision have increased since the 1986 Census. They are Isaacs, from nil to 2,426 people; O'Malley, from 161 to 535 people; Phillip, from 416 to 1,066 people; and Mawson, from 2,862 to 2,901 people.
- The census count for the Central Canberra Statistical Subdivision increased by 6.0% since the 1986 Census. The City Statistical Local Area increased from 123 people in 1986 to 297 people in 1991, and in Acton the increase was from 1,367 to 2,330 people.
- The census count for the Belconnen Statistical Subdivision increased by 5.2% since the 1986 Census. The Florey Statistical Local Area increased from 2,143 people in 1986 to 5,440 people in 1991, and in Bruce the increase was from 951 to 2,045 people.
- The census count for the Weston Creek Statistical Subdivision decreased by 4.7% since the 1986 Census. Every statistical local area in the statistical subdivision recorded a decrease for the inter-censal period.
- 60.0% of the people counted in the ACT on census night were aged less than 35 years. 6.1% were aged 65 years and over. 34.1% of 0-14 year olds were counted in the Tuggeranong Statistical Subdivision, and 32.3% in the Belconnen Statistical Subdivision.
- The number of dwellings counted by the 1991 Census in the ACT and Jervis Bay Territory increased by 15.7% from the 1986 Census to the 1991 Census. The total number of dwellings in the Tuggeranong Statistical Subdivision increased by 49.6%, in Belconnen by 9.5%, in Woden Valley by 14.1%, in Central Canberra by 5.5%, and in Weston Creek by 4.9%.



## About this publication

This publication contains final data from the 1991 Census of Population and Housing.

The census counts are provided for statistical local areas (SLAs), statistical subdivisions (SSDs) and statistical divisions (SDs) and urban centres/localities (UC/Ls).

The counts are on a place of enumeration basis, which provides a count of people where they were located on census night, 6 August 1991, which may not be where they usually live. Some 1986 Census data are included.

*Census Counts for Small Areas* is produced for each State and Territory.

## Scope and coverage

The 1991 Census of Population and Housing was held on 6 August 1991. The purpose of the census was to count every person who spent census night in Australia. This included people in private dwellings, occupied non-private dwellings, camping out, on vessels in or between Australian ports and on board overnight transport.

People were counted where they were located on census night, which may not have been where they usually live.

Visitors to Australia were counted regardless of how long ago they arrived, or how long they planned to stay. Australian residents out of the country on census night were excluded.

All private dwellings were counted, whether occupied or unoccupied. Occupied non-private dwellings, such as hospitals, gaols, etc. were also counted.

Diplomatic personnel and their families were excluded from the census, as were diplomatic residences.

## Data limitations

The census is subject to a number of errors, although the effect of such errors on overall census results is generally insignificant.

### Underenumeration

Although the census aims to count each person, there are some people who are missed. Underenumeration in the 1991 Census is estimated to be 1.9% for Australia. The data in this publication are not adjusted for underenumeration.

### Respondent error

Because processing procedures cannot detect all errors made by people in completing the census form, some remain in final data.

### Processing error

Some processing errors may occur, although stringent quality control measures have been used to minimise them.

### Random adjustment

Random error is added to census data to ensure confidentiality. This means that small cells are randomly adjusted to avoid releasing information about particular individuals, families or households. As a result, component cells may not add to their totals. These differences are statistically insignificant and do not impair the usefulness of the tables.

Further information on data quality will be provided in *Census Update* and in the 1991 Census data quality papers.

## 1986 Census data

1986 Census data have been provided in this publication. Where a statistical local area (SLA) boundary has changed, 1986 Census data have been adjusted to match the 1991 Census boundaries. 1986 data for urban centre/localities (UC/Ls) are not adjusted.

1986 Census occupied private dwelling data in this publication include occupied caravans in parks. These data have been adjusted to provide comparability with the 1991 Census data for occupied private dwellings.

The 1986 data were originally published in *Census 86 - Persons and Dwellings in Statistical Local Areas, Australian Capital Territory (2469.0)*.

## Census variables in this publication

### Age

Age has been collected in all Australian censuses. For the 1991 Census, age was self-coded.

### Sex

The census forms asks the sex of each person.

### Dwellings

The census collector recorded each dwelling as either private or non-private. Private dwellings are either occupied or unoccupied. Only occupied non-private dwellings were included in the census. Non-private dwellings include occupied motels, gaols, welfare institutions, hospitals, retirement villages, boarding schools etc. Occupied caravans in parks are counted as occupied private dwellings.

## The geographic areas

The codes and names of geographic areas used in this publication are defined by the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC).

The ASGC codes are included to enable users to cross-reference geographic areas in this publication with areas in other census products which use codes only, such as some maps and some electronic products.

Definitions of ASGC areas in this publication are provided below. More detailed definitions and lists of codes and names of the geographic areas are contained in the publications *1991 Census Geographic Areas (2905.0)*, *1991 Census Urban Centres/Localities Code List (2909.0)* and *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) (1216.0)*, edition 2.1.

### Statistical Local Area (SLA)

Statistical local areas (SLAs) must consist of one or more whole collection districts (CDs) and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps. They are the key intermediate spatial units for the dissemination of census data.

### Statistical Subdivision (SSD)

Statistical subdivisions (SSDs) are the smaller of two ASGC general purpose regional type spatial units; the other is the statistical division (SD). SSDs are defined in most States on the same basis as SDs.

SSDs consist of one or more statistical local areas (SLAs) and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps.

### Statistical Division (SD)

Statistical divisions (SDs) are the larger of the two ASGC general purpose regional type spatial units; the smaller one is the statistical subdivision (SSD).

SDs consist of one or more SSDs and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Australia without gaps or overlaps. They do not cross State or Territory boundaries.

SDs are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic links between the inhabitants and the economic units in the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

Capital city SDs are predominantly urban in character and the boundaries are delineated to contain the anticipated urban development of the capital cities (and associated urban centres) for a period of at least twenty years.

### Urban Centre/Locality (UC/L)

Broadly an Urban Centre is a population cluster of 1,000 or more people. A Locality is a population cluster of between 200 and 999 people. People living in Urban Centres are classified as urban for statistical purposes while those in



Localities are classified as rural. The criteria for delimiting UC/Ls are based on the Linge criteria.

Details of these criteria as applied for the 1991 Census, and the codes and names of the 1991 Census UC/Ls, are available in the publication *1991 Census - Urban Centres/Localities Code List (2909.0)*.

### Treatment of Jervis Bay Territory

All standard national products produced from the 1991 Census will *include* data for the Jervis Bay Territory with the Australian Capital Territory. Publications produced by the Office of the Statistician, ACT, will *exclude* data for the Jervis Bay Territory. Customised data can be produced either way, as specified.

From 1 July 1993, Jervis Bay Territory will be treated as a separate entity from the ACT in the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC).

### Changes to geographic areas between censuses

Changes occur in the period between censuses, for example, when State governments review legal local government areas (LGAs). The ABS makes an annual review of the ASGC to incorporate these changes. Statistics from the 1991 Census relate to the areas defined by the ASGC at 1 January 1991. Details of the changes made since the 1986 Census are provided in this publication.

### ABS population estimates

Official ABS population estimates (estimated resident population) are based on census counts that have been adjusted to:

- include people who were in Australia on census night but were missed in the census;
- include Australian residents who were temporarily overseas on census night (these people were not within the scope of the census); and
- exclude overseas visitors counted in the census who are not usual residents of Australia.

The adjusted census count is then updated quarterly using demographic statistics. These are statistics on births, deaths, and overseas and internal migration.

ABS population estimates are published in *Australian Demographic Statistics (3101.0)*, produced quarterly, and in *Estimated Resident Population by Sex and Age: States and Territories of Australia (3201.0)*, produced annually.

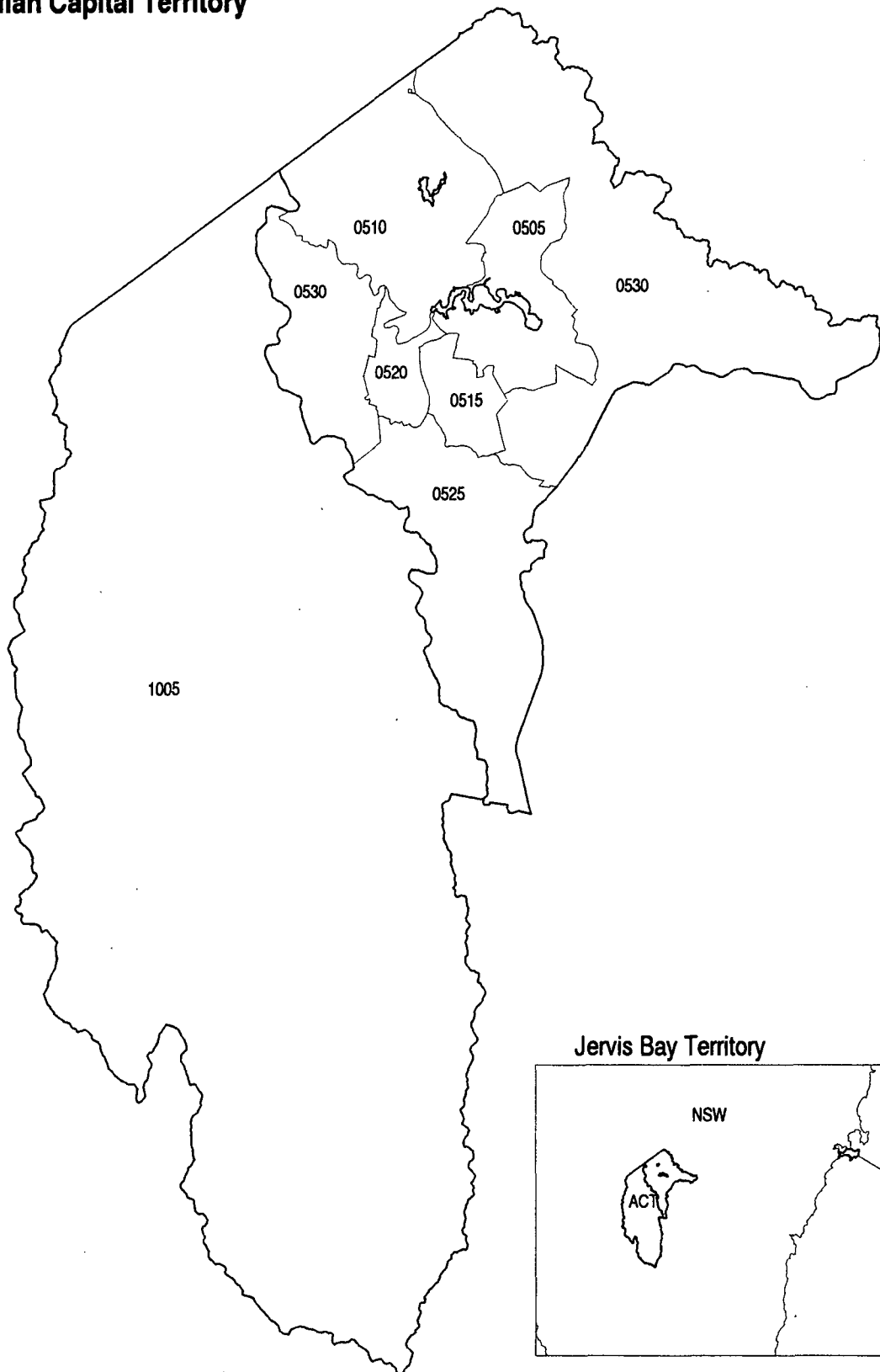

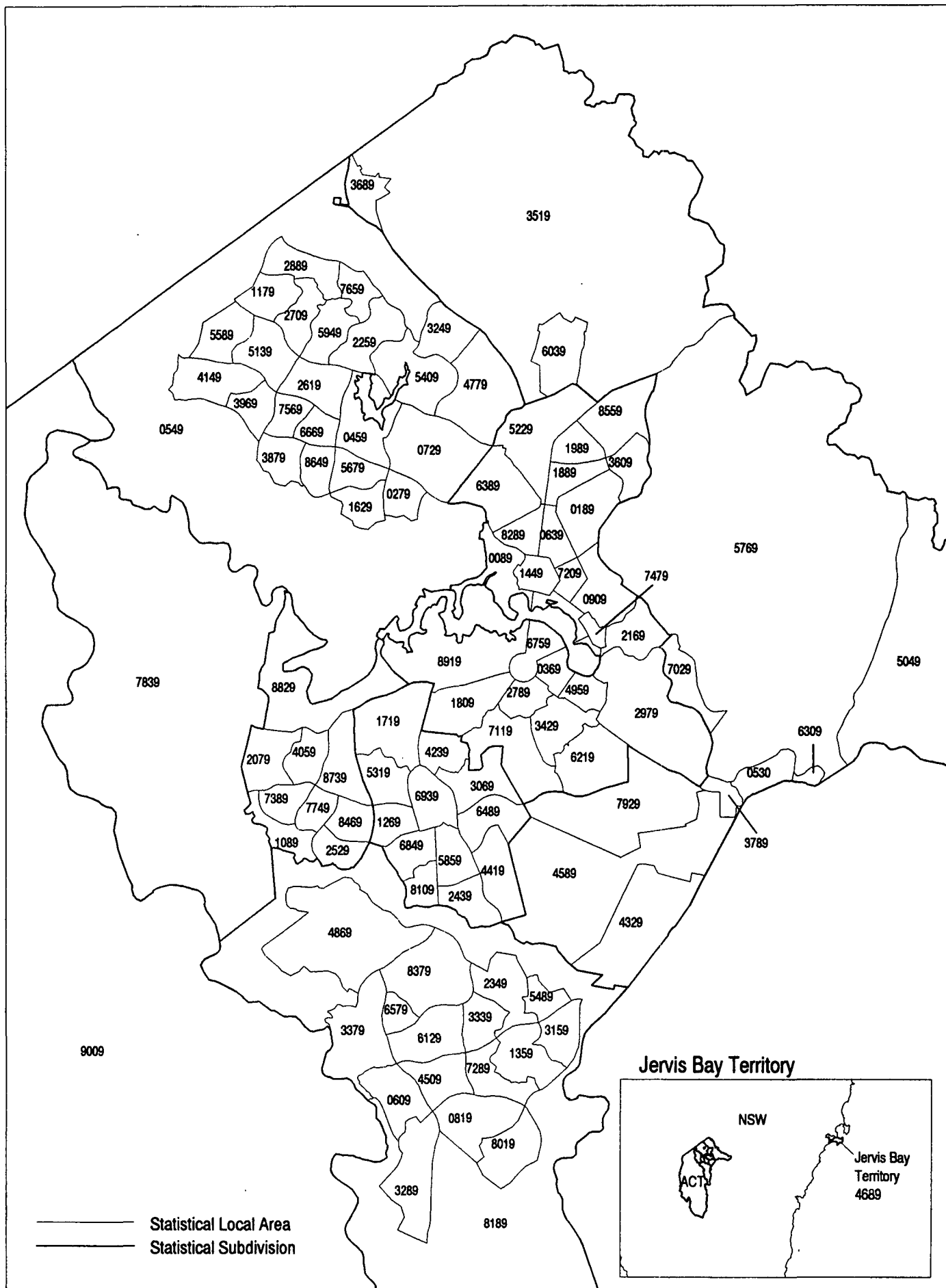
## 1991 Census - Statistical Divisions and Statistical Subdivisions, Australian Capital Territory
