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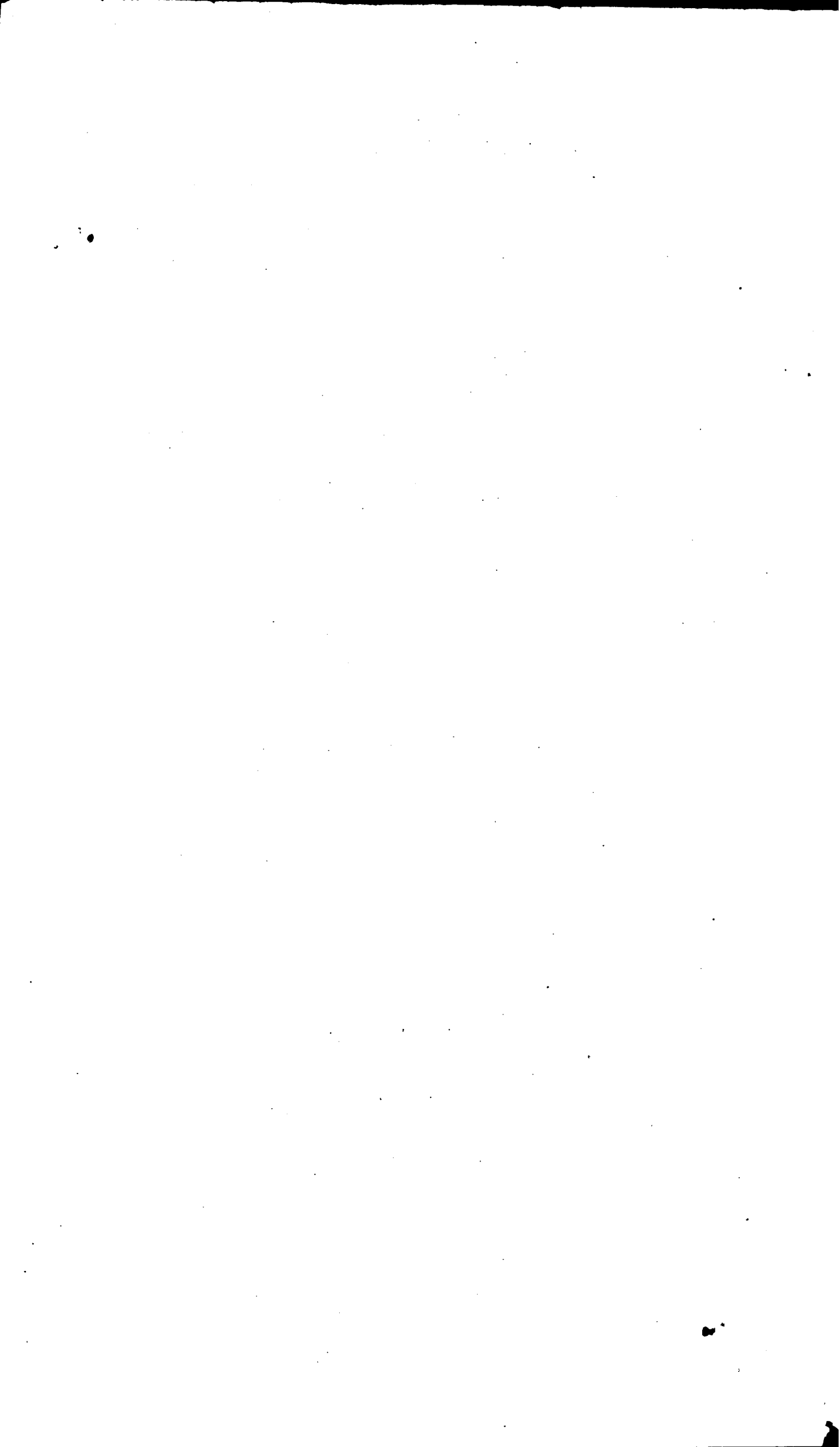

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INTRODUCTION.

The particulars given in the following tables relate to the quarter ended 30th June, 1908, with the exception of Tables No. 1 and 2, containing Summaries of Births; No. 6, Summary of Marriages; No. 12 and 13, Summaries of Deaths; and No. 17, Causes of Death, in which it has been thought advisable to shew particulars for each month.

Particulars relating to the Northern Territory are not included in the South Australian figures, and will be shewn only in the summary for the year.

Marine Births and Deaths are not included.

The mean population of the States and of the Commonwealth during the second quarter of 1908—on which the rates in Table No. 27 are worked out—was as follows:—
