INTRODUCTION

The particulars given in the following tables relate to the quarter ended 30th June, 1911, with the exception of tables Nos. 1 and 2, containing Summaries of Births; No. 6, Summary of Marriages; Nos. 12 and 13, Summaries of Deaths; and No. 17, Causes of Death, in which it has been thought advisable to shew particulars for each month.

Marine Births and Deaths are not included.
