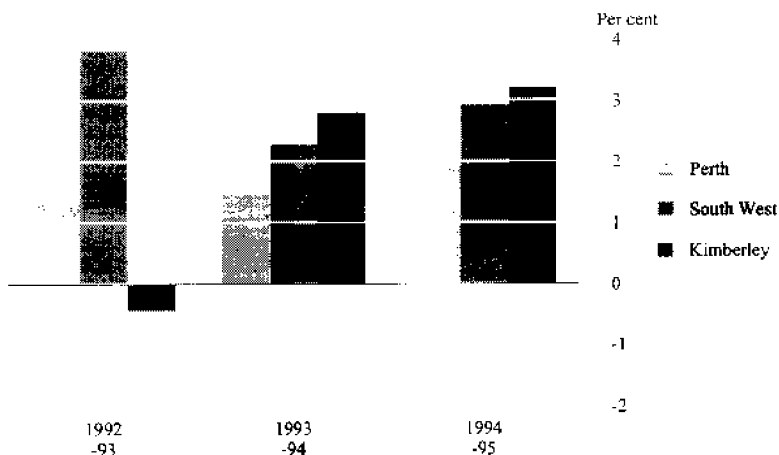

MAIN FEATURES

- The Estimated Resident Population (ERP) of Western Australia at 30 June 1995 was 1,731,723. This is an increase of 30,659 persons or 1.80% from 30 June 1994.
- The proportion of the State population residing in the Perth Statistical Division was 72.9% at 30 June 1995. This figure has fluctuated by less than one per cent since 1986 and prior to this had risen slowly from 68.2% in 1971.
- The South West Statistical Division has the second highest ERP after the Perth Statistical Division, and is followed by the Central and the South-Eastern Statistical Divisions.
- Since 30 June 1991 the South West Statistical Division has grown by 12.37%, compared with growth of 6.81% and 6.21% in the Kimberley and Perth Statistical Divisions, respectively.
- Over the past twelve months the Kimberley Statistical Division has grown by 3.21% compared with growth of 2.94% and 2.11% in the South West and South-Eastern Statistical Divisions, respectively.
- In the four years since 30 June 1991, the Pilbara and Upper Great Southern Statistical Divisions have fallen in population by 7.71% and 6.21%, respectively. In the past twelve months they have experienced falls of 1.15% and 1.90%, respectively.

1992-93 to 1994-95

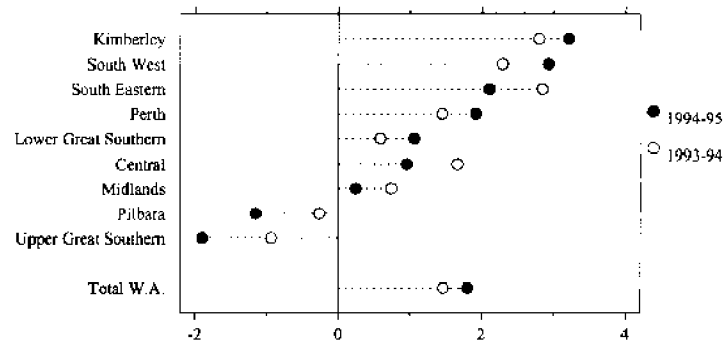


PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

- Between 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 the ERP of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 23,727 persons to 1,262,569 an increase of 1.92%.

- In the past twelve months the Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) of Perth (C) - Inner, Rockingham (C) and Serpentine-Jarrahdale (S) have experienced growth in excess of 5%. This is in contrast to the previous year when only the SLA of Perth (C) - Inner had growth in excess of 5%.
- In the four years since 30 June 1991, four SLAs experienced growth in excess of 15%. The City of Rockingham experienced the strongest growth, with a rate of 30.21%, and was followed by the Shire of Swan (23.24%), the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale (17.31%) and the City of Wanneroo (17.13%).
- During the year ended 30 June 1995, the City of Wanneroo became the first Local Government Area (LGA) in Western Australia to exceed a population of 200,000. The only other LGA with a population in excess of 100,000 is the City of Stirling with 179,704 residents. The third most populated LGA in the Perth Statistical Division is the City of Melville with 92,193 persons.

1993-94 and 1994-95**

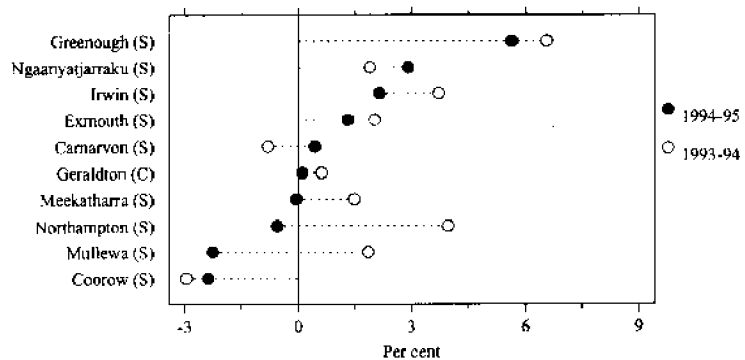


REST OF THE STATE

- Between 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 the ERP of the Rest of the State increased by 6,932 to 469,154, an increase of 1.50%.
- The South West Statistical Division continues to remain the dominant statistical division outside the Perth Statistical Division. In the twelve months to 30 June 1995 its population increased by 4,676 to 163,764, an increase of 2.94%. Since 30 June 1991 its population has grown from 145,730 to 163,764, an increase of 18,034 persons or 12.37%.
- In the past twelve months six SLAs has experienced growth in excess of 5%. The Shire of Busselton's population increased by 6.60%, and was followed by the Shires of Greenough (5.64%), Mandurah (5.63%), Toodyay (5.50%), Menzies (5.22%) and Broome (5.06%).

- In the four years from 30 June 1991, three SLAs have exceeded growth of 20%, with the Shire of Greenough increasing by 30.81%, followed by the Shire of Mandurah with 28.83% and the Shire of Toodyay with 23.83%. Six other SLAs outside the Perth Statistical Division have experienced growth in excess of 15%: Chittering (19.99%), Busselton (19.61%), Dardanup (18.50%), Augusta-Margaret River (18.27%), Denmark (17.52%) and Shark Bay (15.78%).

1994-95**

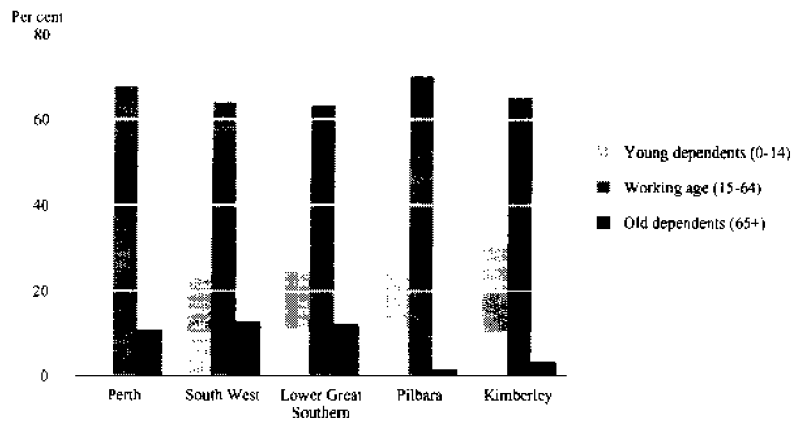


AGE AND SEX OF ERP IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

- There were 869,737 males and 861,986 females in Western Australia as at 30 June 1995.
- Males outnumber females in all Statistical Divisions except Perth where there are 11,647 more females.
- The Statistical Divisions which have the greatest percentage of males are the mining areas of Pilbara (55.52%) and South Eastern (53.90%).
- Females outnumber males in all age groups over 64 years of age and make up 55.85% of the population aged 65 years and over.
- The median age of Western Australia's population has gradually increased from 30.09 years in 1986 to 32.87 years as at 30 June 1995. The median age of males was 32.34 years and females, 33.40 years
- As at 30 June 1995 there are 1,165,358 persons of working age (15 - 64) in Western Australia, and 858,438 of them reside in the Perth Statistical Division. Males account for 50.75% of the population of working age.
- There are 566,365 persons of dependent age (0 - 14 and 65+) in Western Australia, comprising 386,820 aged between 0 and 14 and 179,545 aged 65 and over.

- The Pilbara and Kimberley Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of "young dependents", with 28.37% and 31.49%, respectively. They also have the lowest proportion of "old dependents", with 1.42% and 3.29%, respectively.
- The South West and Lower Great Southern Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of "old dependents", with 12.67% and 12.10%, respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1995. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1994 are included for comparison.

METHODOLOGY

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

3 The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1991 for each SLA is based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

4 For intercensal years, the estimated resident population at 30 June 1994 and 30 June 1995 for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1986 and 1991). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1991), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

5 Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

AREA STATISTICS

6 ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, Edition 2.5* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle and Stirling are comprised of a number of SLAs. However estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

7 SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1995.

BOUNDARY AND NAME CHANGES

8 From 1 July 1994 the City of Perth became four separate local government areas. One area retained the name Perth and the others were named the Towns of Cambridge, Victoria Park and Vincent. The estimated resident population for each of the four local government areas has been calculated for the years 1991 to 1994.

REVISIONS

9 The estimates for 30 June 1991 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1994 and 1995 are preliminary and subject to revision.

RELIABILITY

10 Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

12 From 1 January 1988 most ABS products and services became chargeable. All publications produced by the ABS are listed in *Catalogue of Publications and Products* (1101.0) which is available from any ABS Office for a charge of \$5.

13 The ABS has available estimates of the resident population by age and sex from June 1991 to June 1994 based on 1991 postcode areas. There are also estimates available by census collection districts (CDs) and SLAs based on the 1991 census boundaries. Prices start from \$75 for 1 year and depend on the level of detail requested.

14 Population projections data at the CD, SLA or postcode level are available on a standard or customised basis. Standard projections are by sex and 5-year age groups and project to the year 2012. Prices commence at \$100 per SLA or postcode based region with large discounts for multiple regions. Customised projections can project to the year 2041 and prices range from \$300 to \$500 per region, depending on the level of detail requested. Large discounts also apply for multiple regions.

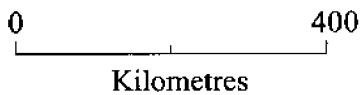

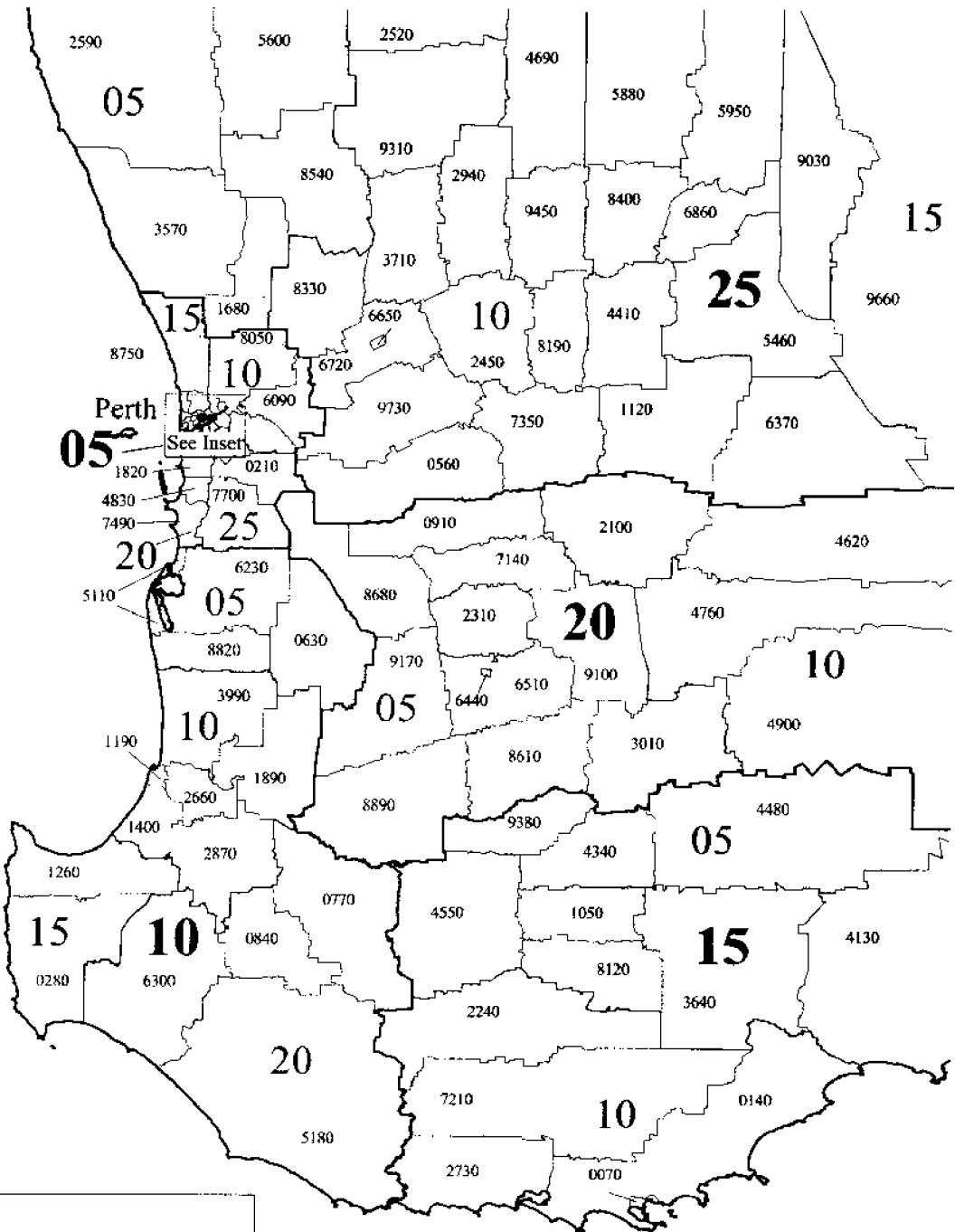

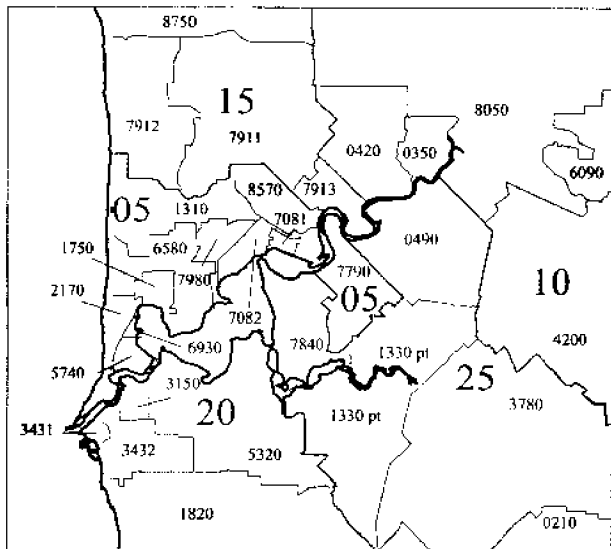


Western Australia - Enlargement

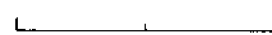
